Beghelli BAND PLUS SOS Bracelet User Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Beghelli BAND PLUS is a comfortable and easy-to-wear bracelet designed for personal safety, featuring a large SOS button for emergency calls. This device is intended to provide quick assistance by connecting to a compatible Beghelli phone, which then initiates calls and sends SMS messages to pre-configured emergency contacts or a dedicated tele-assistance center.

The BAND PLUS is built to withstand daily use, being water-resistant (IP67 rated), allowing it to be worn during normal activities without concern. Its versatile design also allows the main unit to be detached from the bracelet and used with the included multi-purpose lanyard.

Key Features:

- Comfortable Design: Ergonomically designed bracelet for extended wear.
- Large SOS Button: Easy to locate and activate in emergencies.
- Emergency Call Functionality: Connects to compatible Beghelli phones to initiate calls and send SMS to preset SOS numbers or a tele-assistance service.
- Water-Resistant (IP67): Protected against dust and temporary immersion in water.

- Versatile Use: Can be worn as a bracelet or with the included multi-purpose lanyard.
- Long Battery Life: Powered by a CR2032 battery with an autonomy of up to 5 years.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

3. SETUP AND PAIRING

The Beghelli BAND PLUS bracelet functions exclusively when connected to a compatible Beghelli phone. Ensure your Beghelli phone is within radio range of the bracelet for proper operation.

Compatible Beghelli Phones:

- Salvalavita SLV30-GPS Plus
- Salvalavita SLV20 Plus

- Salvalavita SLV30-GPS Altavoce
- Salvalavita Smartphone 55 (Model 9207)

Pairing Procedure:

- 1. Ensure your compatible Beghelli phone is powered on and in pairing mode (refer to your Beghelli phone's manual for specific instructions on enabling pairing mode).
- 2. Activate the Beghelli BAND PLUS bracelet. The bracelet is typically active upon receipt, indicated by a small LED light (refer to the LED indicator section for details).
- 3. Follow the pairing instructions on your Beghelli phone to detect and connect to the BAND PLUS bracelet. The bracelet will appear as a discoverable device.
- 4. Once paired, test the connection by briefly pressing the SOS button (do not hold it down for an emergency call during testing). The phone should acknowledge the connection.

Note: For detailed pairing instructions, always consult the user manual of your specific Beghelli phone model.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the SOS Function:

In an emergency situation, the SOS button on your Beghelli BAND PLUS bracelet allows you to quickly alert your pre-configured contacts or the tele-assistance center.

- 1. **Activate SOS:** Press and hold the large "Salvalavita" SOS button located on the center of the bracelet unit for a prolonged period (typically 3-5 seconds).
- 2. Connection to Phone: The bracelet will send a signal to your paired Beghelli phone.
- 3. **Emergency Protocol:** Your Beghelli phone will then automatically initiate calls and send pre-programmed SMS messages to the emergency numbers you have previously configured. If subscribed to the Salvalavita

center service, it will also alert them.

Important: Ensure your Beghelli phone is charged, powered on, and within radio range of the bracelet for the SOS function to work correctly.

Wearing Options:

- Wristband: Wear the device comfortably on your wrist like a watch.
- Lanyard: The main unit can be detached from the wristband. Attach the multi-purpose lanyard to the unit and wear it around your neck or attach it to clothing for convenient access.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Battery Information:

The Beghelli BAND PLUS is powered by a CR2032 battery, offering an autonomy of up to 5 years under normal usage conditions. When the battery is low, your paired Beghelli phone may provide an alert. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified technician or by following specific instructions provided by Beghelli to maintain the device's water resistance.

Caution: Do not attempt to replace the battery yourself unless specifically instructed by Beghelli, as this may compromise the device's water resistance and void the warranty.

Water Resistance (IP67):

The device is rated IP67, meaning it is protected from dust ingress and can withstand temporary immersion in water up to 1 meter for 30 minutes. This makes it suitable for daily activities such as showering or being caught in the rain. However, it is not designed for prolonged submersion or high-pressure water activities like swimming or diving.

- Do not intentionally submerge the device for extended periods.
- Avoid exposing the device to salt water or other liquids besides fresh water.
- If the device gets wet, dry it thoroughly with a soft, clean cloth before charging or attempting to open any compartments.

Cleaning:

Clean the bracelet unit and wristband with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these may damage the device's surface or internal components.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bracelet not connecting to phone.	 Out of radio range. Phone not powered on or in pairing mode. Bracelet battery low. 	 Move the bracelet closer to the Beghelli phone. Ensure the phone is on and pairing mode is active. Check the phone's battery level. If the bracelet battery is low, contact support for replacement.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
SOS function not activating.	 SOS button not held long enough. Bracelet not paired with phone. Phone not configured with SOS numbers. 	 Press and hold the SOS button for 3-5 seconds. Refer to Section 3: Setup and Pairing. Configure SOS numbers in your Beghelli phone settings (refer to phone manual).
Bracelet LED indicator not lighting up.	Battery depleted.Device malfunction.	 The battery has a long life (up to 5 years), but if it's depleted, contact Beghelli support for battery replacement. If the device is not responding, contact Beghelli customer support.






