1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the LEGO City Tow Truck and Sports Car Repair set is designed to be straightforward, especially for young builders. The set includes a LEGO Starter Brick element and a pictorial building guide to facilitate the process.

2.1. Preparing for Assembly

- Unpack all LEGO elements from their numbered bags.
- Locate the pictorial building guide. This guide uses clear, step-by-step illustrations.
- Ensure you have a clean, flat surface for building.

2.2. Building the Tow Truck

Begin by assembling the base of the tow truck using the provided Starter Brick element. This large, pre-formed piece provides a solid foundation, making the initial steps of construction quicker and simpler.

Follow the pictorial guide to add the cab, engine details, and the functional hoist mechanism. The pieces are designed for easy handling, ensuring a smooth building experience.

2.3. Building the Sports Car

The sports car assembly also utilizes a simplified approach, allowing for quick construction. Attach the wheels, chassis, and body elements as shown in the instructions.

2.4. Assembling Minifigures

Assemble the truck driver and motorist minifigures. These figures are essential for role-playing scenarios and come with accessories like a wrench and a phone.

3. OPERATING AND PLAY FEATURES

Once assembled, the LEGO City Tow Truck and Sports Car set provides numerous opportunities for imaginative play. The primary feature is the tow truck's working hoist, allowing children to simulate vehicle recovery scenarios.

3.1. Using the Tow Hoist

To use the tow hoist, position the tow truck behind the sports car. Lower the hoist arm and attach the hook to the sports car's rear. Once secured, raise the hoist arm to lift the front wheels of the sports car off the ground, ready for towing.

3.2. Role-Playing Scenarios

Encourage children to create various scenarios, such as a sports car breaking down and the tow truck coming to its rescue. The minifigures can be placed in the vehicles or used outside for additional storytelling. The included accessories like the wrench and phone add to the realism of repair and communication.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and cleanliness of your LEGO set.

4.1. Cleaning

To clean LEGO bricks, use a mild soap solution and lukewarm water. Gently scrub the bricks with a soft brush or cloth. Rinse thoroughly with clear water and allow them to air dry completely before reassembling or storing. Avoid using hot

water, harsh chemicals, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the plastic.

4.2. Storage

Store the LEGO set in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keeping the pieces in their original box or a dedicated storage container will help prevent loss and damage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

While LEGO sets are generally robust, minor issues can sometimes arise during or after assembly.

5.1. Missing Pieces

If you find any missing pieces, first double-check all packaging and the building area. Sometimes small pieces can be overlooked. If a piece is genuinely missing, please refer to the Warranty & Support section for information on how to contact LEGO customer service for replacement parts.

5.2. Assembly Difficulties

If you encounter difficulties during assembly, carefully review the pictorial building guide. Ensure that each step is followed precisely and that the correct pieces are used. Sometimes, a small misplacement can affect subsequent steps. Disassemble the problematic section and re-attempt the steps.
