1. Safety Information

For the safety of all users, especially children, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Use appropriate mattress thicknesses for both upper and lower bunks.
- Adhere strictly to the maximum weight capacity for each bunk. Overloading can compromise structural integrity.
- Ensure proper assembly of all components as per the instructions. Regularly check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight.
- Full-length guardrails on the upper bunk are designed to prevent accidental falls. Do not remove or modify them.
- Children should be supervised when using the bunk bed, especially the upper bunk and ladder.
- Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, e.g., hooks, ropes, or belts, as they may pose a strangulation hazard.

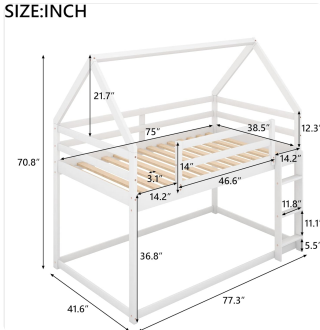

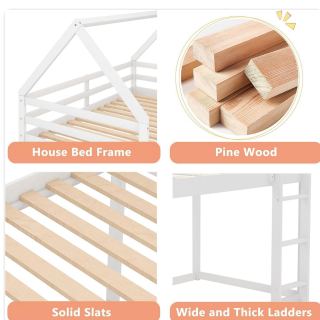


Front view of the Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed, showcasing its unique house-shaped frame and white finish, set in a decorated child's room.

3. Setup and Assembly

The Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed requires assembly. Please follow these general steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and verify against the included parts list.
2. **Identify Hardware:** Separate and identify all screws, bolts, and other hardware.
3. **Follow Instructions:** Refer to the detailed assembly manual provided in the product packaging. Each step is illustrated to guide you through the process.
4. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by assembling the main frame components, ensuring all connections are secure but not overtightened initially.
5. **Install Slats and Guardrails:** Attach the bed slats to both bunks and secure the full-length guardrails on the upper bunk.
6. **Attach Ladder:** Securely fasten the ladder to the designated position.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, go back and fully tighten all bolts and screws.
8. **Safety Check:** Before use, perform a thorough safety check to ensure the bed is stable and all parts are correctly installed.

Assembly typically takes 2-3 hours with two people. It is recommended to have an extra person for assistance during certain steps.

4. Operation

The Bellemave Twin Over Twin House Bunk Bed is designed for sleeping and can also serve as a creative play space for children. The low-profile design of the bottom bunk makes it easily accessible for younger children.

- **Sleeping:** Place twin-size mattresses on both the upper and lower bunks. Ensure the mattress on the upper bunk is not too thick, allowing sufficient guardrail height for safety.
- **Accessing Upper Bunk:** Use the built-in ladder to safely access the upper bunk. Always climb facing the ladder and use both hands.
- **Creative Play:** The house-shaped frame can be decorated with string lights, fabric, or other child-safe accessories to create a personalized play area.

5. Care and Maintenance

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your bunk bed:

- **Cleaning:** For general cleaning, wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish. The manufacturer specifies "Dry Clean Only" for certain components, which typically refers to fabric parts if any are included, but for the wood frame, a damp cloth is suitable.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the bed frame with a soft, dry cloth.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Loose hardware can lead to instability and safety hazards. Tighten as necessary.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Protect the wood from prolonged exposure to moisture or extreme temperature changes.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight for extended periods, as this can cause fading or damage to the finish.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your bunk bed, consider the following:

- **Bed Wobbles:** This is often due to loose connections. Re-tighten all bolts and screws, ensuring the bed is on a level surface. Check that all dowels are properly seated during assembly.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking can result from loose hardware or friction between wood parts. Tighten all connections. Applying a small amount of furniture wax or silicone spray to contact points (avoiding areas that bear weight) might help.
- **Parts Missing/Damaged:** If you find any parts missing or damaged upon unboxing, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support immediately for replacement parts.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Review the assembly instructions carefully. Ensure you are using the correct hardware for each step. If still struggling, consider seeking assistance from another person.
