INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your myPhone 2240 LTE 4G button phone. This device is designed for simplicity and ease of use, making it ideal for seniors or anyone seeking a straightforward mobile communication experience. It features a clear, easy-to-read display, long-lasting battery life, and supports VoLTE technology for high-quality calls. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new phone.

SETUP

1. What's in the Box

Upon unboxing your myPhone 2240 LTE, please ensure all components are present:

- myPhone 2240 LTE 4G Button Phone
- USB Cable (for charging)

- Warranty Card
- Instructions (English language)

2. Battery Installation and Charging

The myPhone 2240 LTE comes with a 1000mAh battery, designed for long-lasting performance.

1. Carefully remove the back cover of the phone.
2. Insert the battery into its compartment, ensuring the gold contacts align with the phone's terminals.
3. Replace the back cover until it clicks securely into place.
4. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port at the bottom of the phone and the other end to a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a computer.
5. Allow the phone to charge fully before first use. A full charge can last up to 6 days depending on usage.

3. SIM Card Installation

Your myPhone 2240 LTE requires a SIM card to connect to a mobile network. This phone is unlocked for all carriers.

1. With the back cover and battery removed, locate the SIM card slot(s).
2. Insert your SIM card(s) into the designated slot(s) with the gold contacts facing down and the cut corner aligned correctly.
3. Ensure the SIM card is fully seated.
4. Reinstall the battery and back cover.

4. Initial Power On

Press and hold the Power/End Call button (red button) until the screen illuminates. Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup,

such as language selection.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Call Functions

- **Making a Call:** Enter the phone number using the keypad and press the Call button (green button).
- **Receiving a Call:** When the phone rings, press the Call button (green button) to answer.
- **Ending a Call:** Press the End Call button (red button) to terminate a call.
- **VoLTE Technology:** The myPhone 2240 LTE utilizes VoLTE (Voice over LTE) technology, ensuring clear and high-quality voice calls over the 4G network.

2. Messaging (SMS)

To send and receive text messages:

1. Navigate to the "Messages" menu from the main screen.
2. Select "New Message" to compose a new SMS.
3. Enter the recipient's number and type your message using the keypad.
4. Press the "Send" option.

3. Display and Keypad

The phone features a clear 1.77-inch display, designed for easy readability of messages and menus. The large, tactile buttons on the keypad ensure comfortable and accurate dialing and navigation.

4. Additional Features

- **FM Radio:** The phone includes an integrated FM radio. Connect headphones (not included) to use them as an antenna.
- **MP3 Playback:** If an SD card is inserted, you can play MP3 audio files.
- **Flashlight:** The phone is equipped with a built-in flashlight for convenience.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's screen and body. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Care:** To maximize battery lifespan, avoid exposing the phone to extreme temperatures. Charge the phone regularly, but avoid leaving it fully discharged for extended periods.
- **Storage:** If storing the phone for a long time, charge the battery to about 50% and store it in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Phone does not turn on	Battery is discharged or not properly installed.	Ensure battery is correctly installed and fully charged.
Cannot make/receive calls	No SIM card, SIM card not properly installed, or no network signal.	Check SIM card installation. Move to an area with better network coverage. Contact your service provider.
Poor call quality	Weak network signal or interference.	Move to an area with better signal. Ensure no obstructions are blocking the phone's antenna.
Battery not charging	Faulty charger/cable or charging port issue.	Try a different USB-C cable and power adapter. Ensure the charging port is clean and free of debris.
