INTRODUCTION

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning, maintenance, or moving.
- Do not insert fingers or any objects into the fan grille when it is operating.
- Ensure the fan is placed on a stable, flat surface to prevent tipping.
- Keep the fan away from water and high humidity environments.
- Do not use the fan if the power cord or plug is damaged. Contact qualified personnel for repair.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental

capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

- Fan Head Assembly (Motor, Blades, Grilles)
- Adjustable Stand Pole
- Round Base
- Remote Control
- User Manual (this document)
- Mounting Screws/Hardware (if applicable)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Cecotec Pedestal Fan:

1. **Attach the Base:** Place the adjustable stand pole into the round base. Secure it firmly using the provided screws or locking mechanism.
2. **Mount the Fan Head:** Carefully attach the fan head assembly to the top of the adjustable stand pole. Ensure it clicks securely into place or is fastened with the designated screws.
3. **Adjust Height:** Loosen the height adjustment knob on the stand pole, extend or retract the pole to your desired height, and then tighten the knob firmly.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the fan's power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

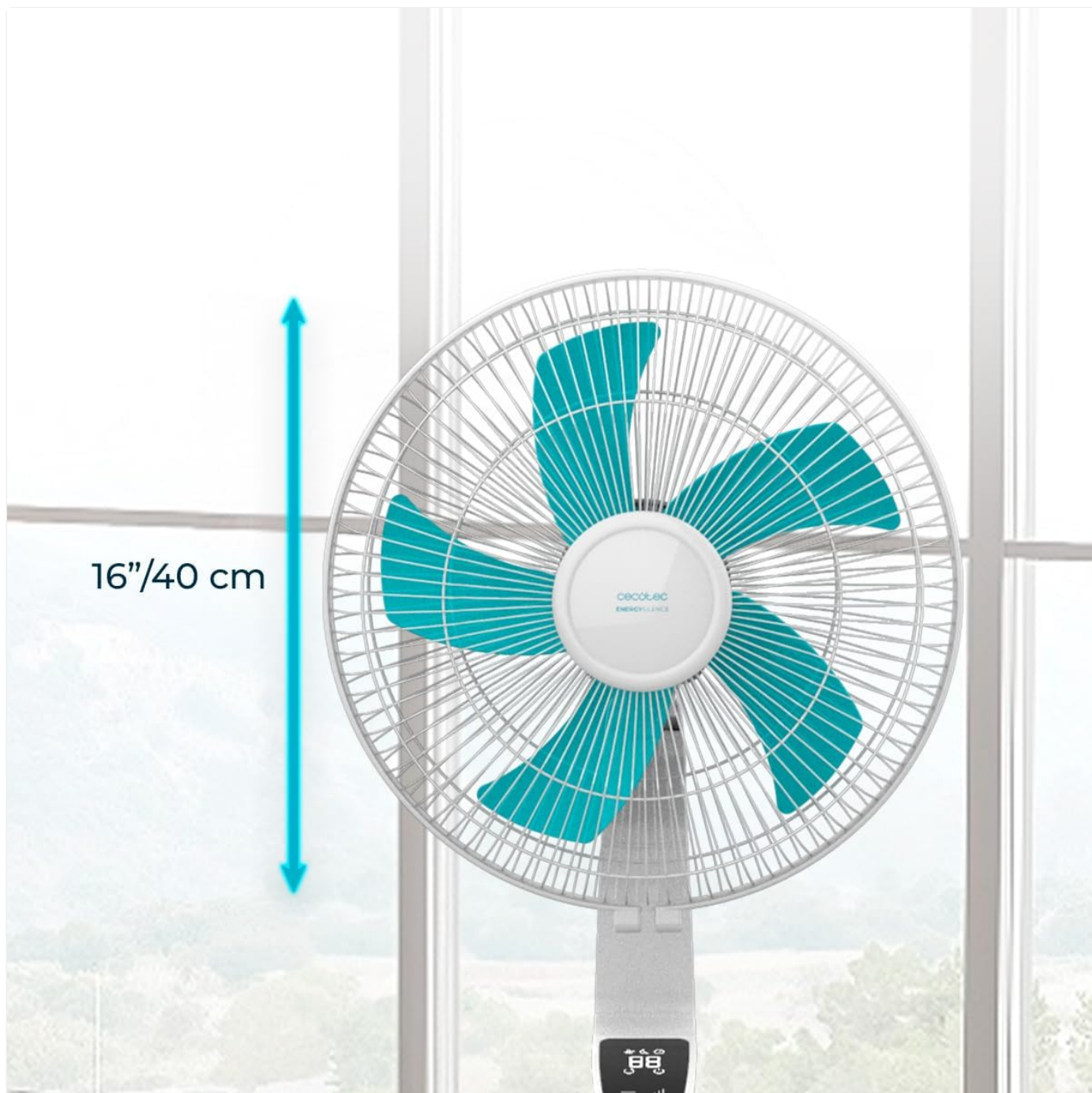


Image: Illustration showing the 16-inch (40 cm) diameter of the fan, indicating its size and potential for powerful airflow.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Cecotec fan offers convenient control via its touch panel and remote control.

Control Panel and LED Display

The integrated touch panel allows direct control of all fan functions, with settings displayed on the LED screen.

Remote Control

For added convenience, use the remote control to operate the fan from a distance. Ensure batteries are correctly inserted (not included).

Speed Settings

The fan features 3 adjustable speeds to suit your cooling needs:

- **Low:** Gentle airflow for quiet environments.
- **Medium:** Balanced airflow for general use.
- **High:** Powerful airflow for maximum cooling.

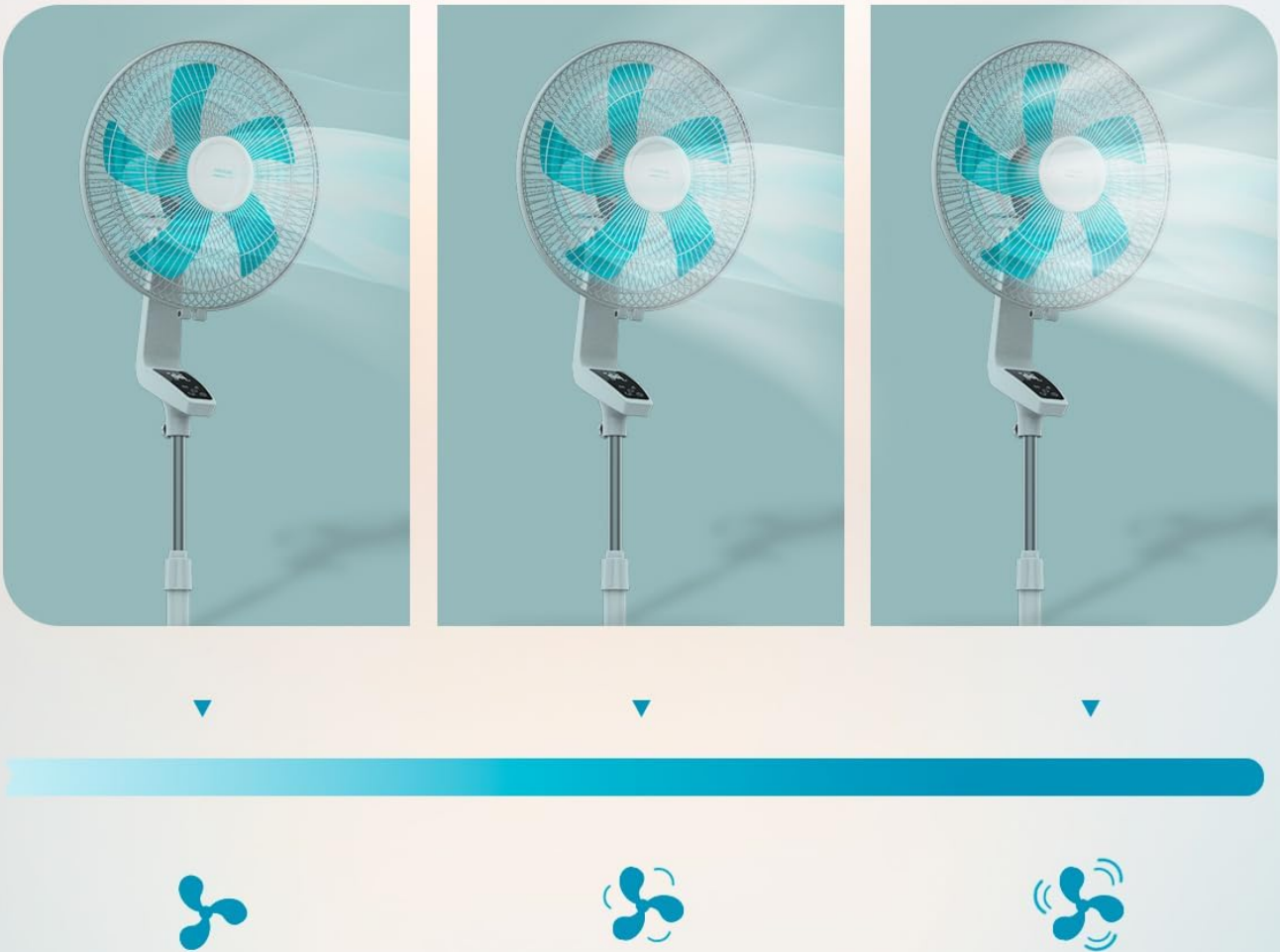


Image: Visual representation of the fan's three speed settings (Low, Medium, High), showing varying airflow intensity.

Operating Modes

Select from two specialized operating modes:

- **Nature Mode:** Simulates natural breeze by varying fan speed.
- **Sleep Mode:** Operates at a lower, quieter speed for undisturbed rest.

Timer Function

Set the fan to automatically turn off after a specified period, up to 12 hours.

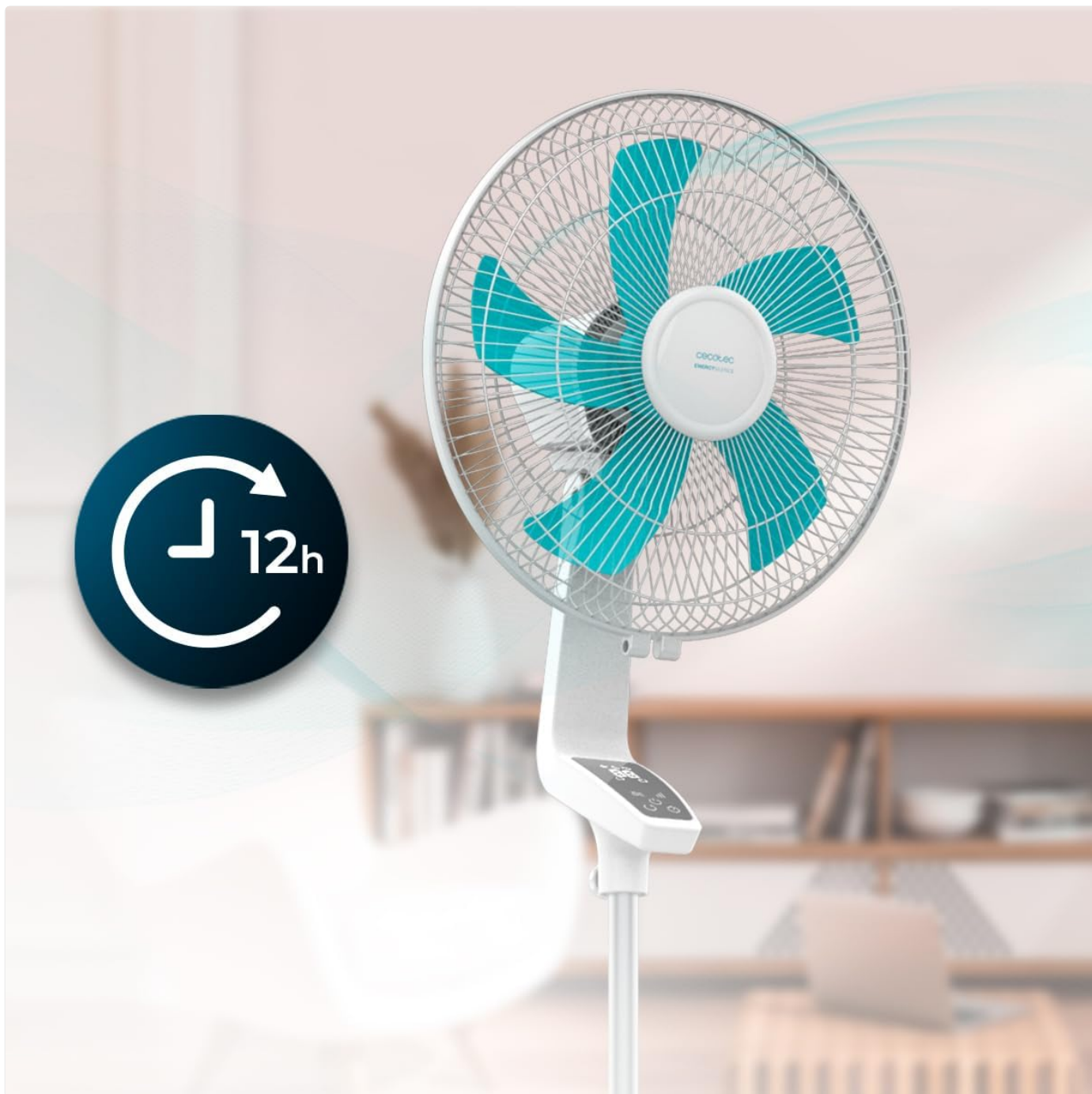


Image: The fan with a "12h" timer icon, indicating its programmable shutdown feature.

Activate automatic oscillation to distribute airflow across a wider area in the room.

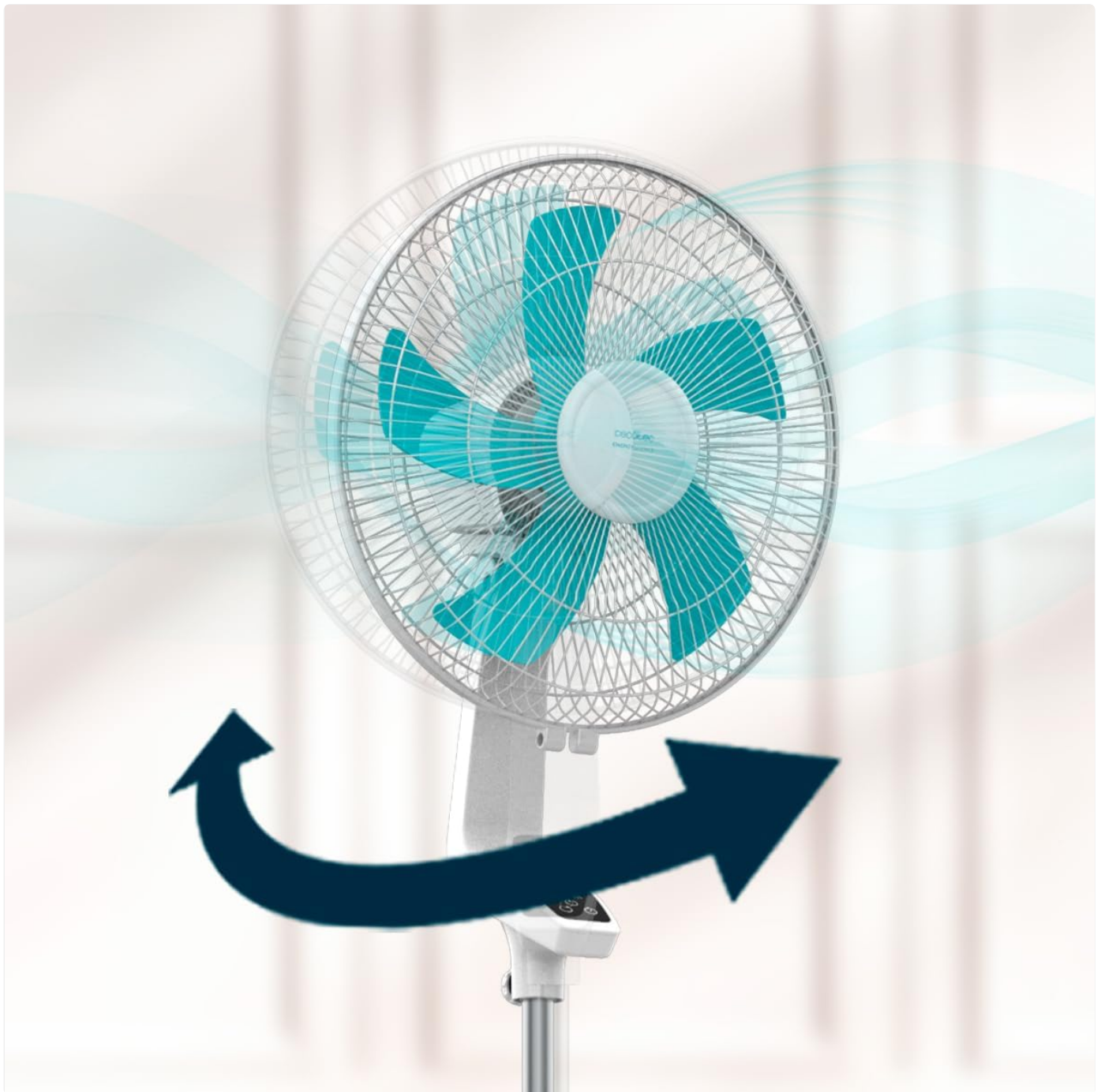


Image: An arrow indicating the fan's automatic oscillation movement, showing how it distributes air.

MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Cleaning the Grilles and Blades:** Periodically remove dust and debris from the front and rear grilles, and the fan blades. You may use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment or a soft, dry cloth. For thorough cleaning, the grilles may need to be disassembled (refer to assembly instructions in reverse).
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, unplug the fan, clean it, and store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power supply; Power cord not plugged in; Remote control batteries dead.	Check power outlet; Ensure power cord is securely plugged in; Replace remote control batteries.
Weak airflow.	Fan speed set too low; Grilles or blades are dirty.	Increase fan speed; Clean the grilles and blades.
Fan makes unusual noise.	Loose parts; Obstruction in blades; Fan not on a stable surface.	Check for loose components and tighten; Remove any obstructions; Place fan on a flat, stable surface.
Remote control not working.	Dead batteries; Obstruction between remote and fan; Remote not pointed correctly.	Replace batteries; Remove obstructions; Point remote directly at the fan's receiver.

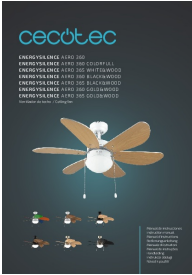
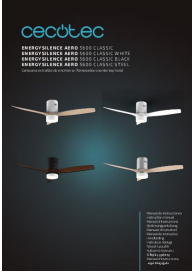


Image: The fan with a "50W" power indicator, highlighting its strong ventilation capability.
