1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your new Whirlpool 192 L 5 Star Icemagic Powercool Inverter Direct-Cool Single Door Refrigerator. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Important Safety Instructions:

- Ensure the refrigerator is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Do not block ventilation openings in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments of the appliance, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- Always unplug the refrigerator before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Keep children away from packaging materials to prevent suffocation.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Check the refrigerator for any damage incurred during transit. The

package includes: 1 Refrigerator, 1 Egg Tray, 1 Ice Tray, 1 Instruction Manual, and 1 Key.

3.2 Placement

Place the refrigerator in a well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate space around the appliance for proper air circulation. The dimensions of the refrigerator are approximately 62 cm (Depth) x 54.3 cm (Width) x 136 cm (Height). The weight is 38.4 kg. This is a freestanding unit.

3.3 Electrical Connection

Connect the refrigerator to a dedicated power outlet. This model supports stabilizer-free operations within a voltage range of 130V to 300V. The nominal voltage is 215 Volts.

3.4 Door Orientation

The door of this refrigerator is oriented to open from the left side.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator features manual temperature control. Adjust the thermostat dial inside the refrigerator to set the desired cooling level. Refer to the markings on the dial for colder or warmer settings.

4.2 Cooling Features

- **Insulated Capillary Technology:** This technology surrounds the capillary (which carries refrigerant from the compressor to the freezer) with super cold gas. This design enhances compressor efficiency, provides faster cooling, and ensures up to 9 hours of cooling retention during power cuts.

- **Fast Ice Making:** The freezer compartment is designed for rapid ice production.

- **Auto Connect to Home Inverter:** In the event of a power outage, the refrigerator automatically connects to your home inverter (if connected to a >2.5 KVA inverter) to maintain consistent cooling and long-lasting freshness.

- **Laminar Airflow:** Meticulously designed cooling vents at the back of the freezer regulate airflow for

uniform cooling throughout the refrigerator compartment.

4.3 Storage

The refrigerator offers a total capacity of 192 liters, with 177.7 liters for fresh food and 14.3 liters for the freezer. It includes 2 toughened glass shelves and 1 drawer.

- **Toughened Glass Shelves:** The shelves are made of toughened glass, designed to bear the load of everyday items, including heavy pots and containers.

- **Large Vegetable Crisper:** A spacious crisper drawer is provided for storing vegetables, featuring Honey Comb Lock In Technology to maintain optimal moisture levels and keep produce fresh longer.

- **Jumbo Storage:** The door bins are designed to accommodate large bottles, including 2-liter and 3-liter bottles.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

Regularly clean the interior and exterior of your refrigerator. Use a soft cloth with mild soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. For the interior, remove shelves and drawers and wash them separately. Ensure the anti-bacterial gasket is clean to maintain a tight seal.

5.2 Defrosting

This refrigerator features an easy manual defrosting system. When ice buildup in the freezer compartment becomes excessive (approximately 0.5 cm thick), manually defrost the unit. Turn off the refrigerator, remove all food items, and allow the ice to melt naturally. Use a soft cloth to wipe away melted water. Do not use sharp objects to remove ice.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your refrigerator, please refer to the following common troubleshooting tips before contacting customer service:

- **Refrigerator not cooling:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged in. Ensure the temperature control is set correctly. Verify that the door is closing properly and the gasket is sealing.
- **Excessive noise:** Ensure the refrigerator is level. Check if any items inside are vibrating against each other.
- **Water leakage:** Check the drain pan and ensure it is not overflowing. Verify that the drain hose is not clogged.
- **Light not working:** Ensure the refrigerator is plugged in and receiving power. The bulb may need replacement.
