## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your VIZIO 32-inch HD Smart TV, Model VHD32M-08. This television is designed to deliver clear 720p resolution with a Full Array LED backlight, optimized for vibrant color. It features the VIZIO OS for integrated app access, free streaming content, and compatibility with various smart home ecosystems.

Key features include:

- Integrated VIZIO OS for direct access to streaming applications.
- 720p HD resolution with Active Pixel Tuning for enhanced picture quality.
- Built-in WatchFree+ app offering hundreds of free channels and thousands of on-demand titles.
- Bluetooth headphone capability for private listening.
- Compatibility with Apple AirPlay, Google Cast, and voice assistants like Alexa and Google Home.

## 2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

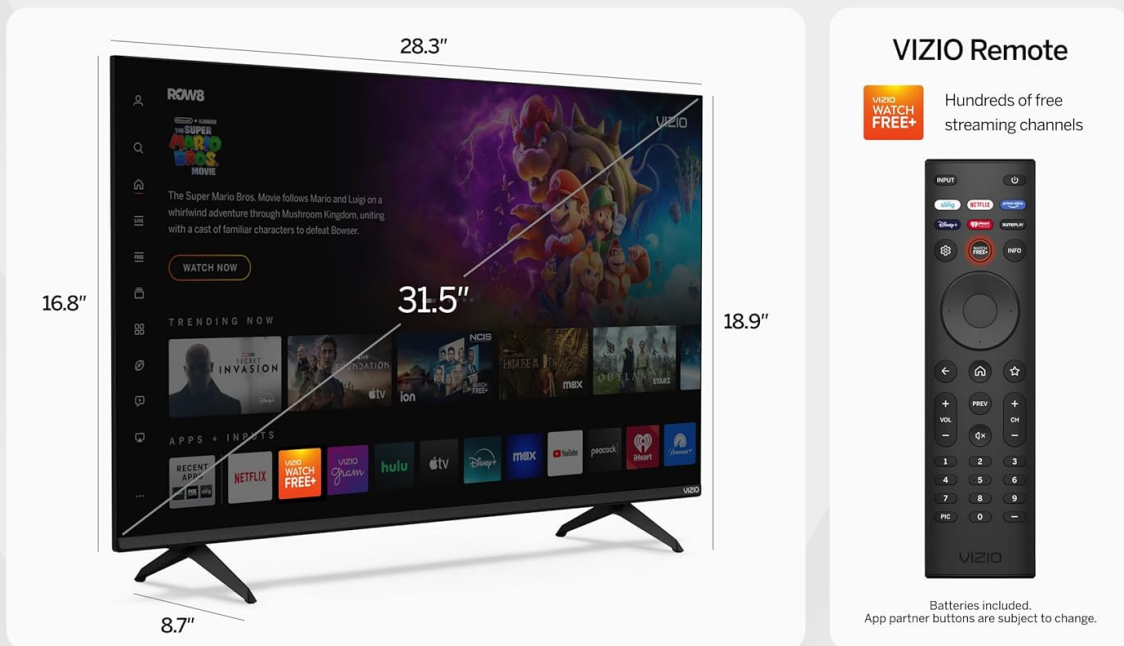

- Remote Control
- Power Cable
- TV Stand (2 pieces)
- Screws for Stand Installation

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the TV from its packaging. It is recommended to have two people for this process to prevent damage to the screen or the unit.

### 3.2 Attaching the Stand

1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align each stand piece with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.

### 3.3 Connecting Power

Plug the power cable into the TV's power input, then plug the other end into a wall outlet. Do not power on the TV yet.

### 3.4 Initial Setup Wizard

Once powered on, the TV will guide you through the initial setup process. This includes:

- **Language Selection:** Choose your preferred language.
- **Network Connection:** Connect to your home Wi-Fi network. A VIZIO Account is required for Smart TV functionality and product updates.
- **Channel Scan:** If using an antenna, the TV will scan for available channels.
- **Software Updates:** The TV may download and install the latest software updates.

## 4. OPERATING YOUR VIZIO SMART TV

### 4.1 VIZIO OS Home Screen

The VIZIO OS provides a centralized home screen for accessing all your entertainment. From here, you can launch apps, browse content, and manage inputs.

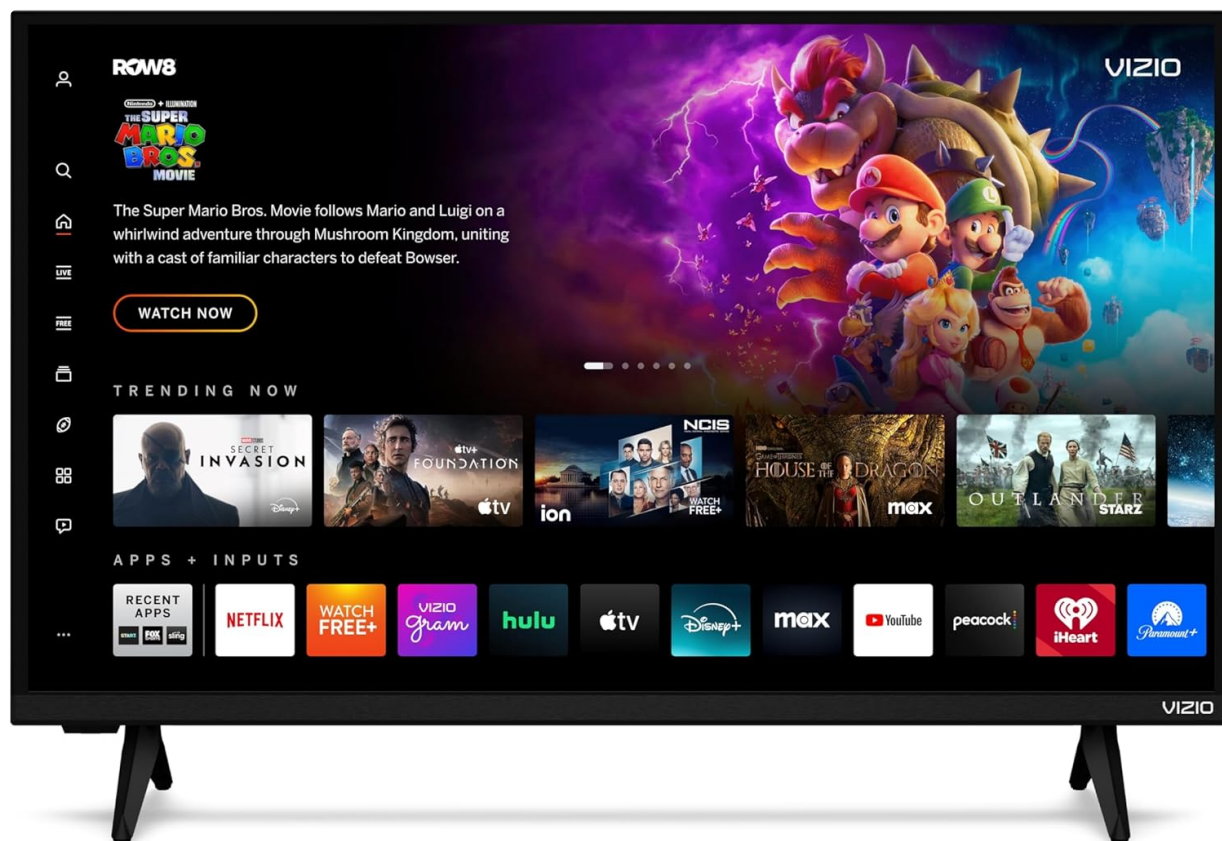


Image: The VIZIO Smart TV home screen displaying a selection of streaming applications and trending content.

### 4.2 Accessing Apps

Navigate to the 'Apps' section on the home screen to find and launch your favorite streaming services. A VIZIO Account is required to access and manage apps.

### 4.3 WatchFree+

The built-in WatchFree+ app offers a wide selection of free live TV channels and on-demand movies and shows. Access it directly from the home screen or via the dedicated button on your remote.

#### 4.4 Bluetooth Audio Pairing

To pair Bluetooth headphones or speakers:

1. Go to the TV's Audio Settings menu.
2. Select 'Bluetooth Audio' and enable it.
3. Put your Bluetooth device into pairing mode.
4. Select your device from the list on the TV screen to connect.

#### **4.6 Voice Assistant Integration**

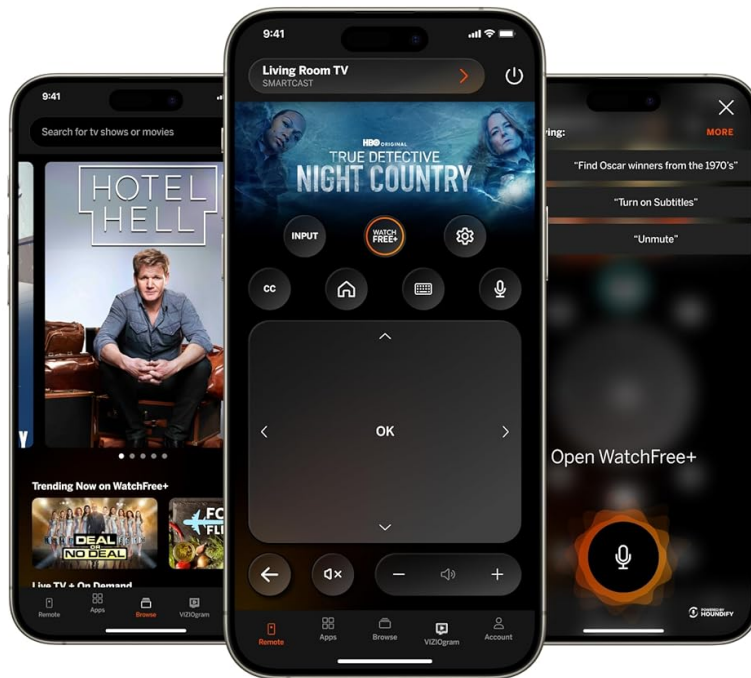
This VIZIO Smart TV is compatible with Alexa and Google Home devices, enabling voice control for basic functions like power, volume, and input switching.

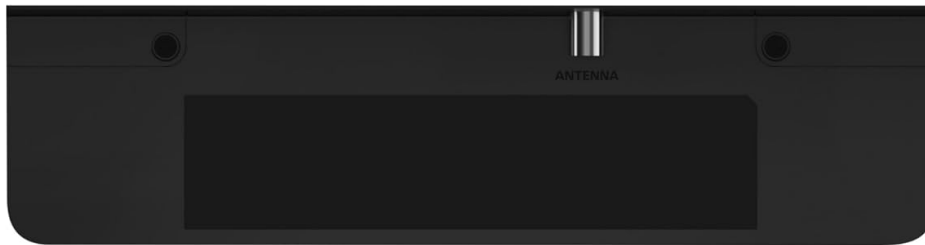

## 5. CONNECTIVITY

The VIZIO 32-inch HD Smart TV offers various ports for connecting external devices.

### 5.1 Input Ports

- **HDMI:** Multiple HDMI ports are available for connecting devices such as Blu-ray players, gaming consoles, and cable/satellite boxes. One HDMI port supports ARC (Audio Return Channel) for simplified audio connections to soundbars or AV receivers.
- **USB:** A USB 2.0 port is provided for media playback from compatible USB storage devices.
- **Antenna/Cable:** Connect an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts or a cable connection for traditional TV services.

## 5.2 Network Connection

The TV connects to the internet via Wi-Fi (802.11n) for streaming content and software updates. Ensure your Wi-Fi network is active and within range for optimal performance.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

### 6.1 Cleaning the Screen

To clean the screen, gently wipe it with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or direct spraying onto the screen.

### 6.2 General Care

- Keep the TV in a well-ventilated area to prevent overheating.
- Avoid exposing the TV to direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.
- Do not place heavy objects on top of the TV.
- Unplug the TV during lightning storms or when it will be unused for extended periods.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your VIZIO Smart TV, refer to the following common solutions:

## 7.1 No Power

- Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and a working electrical outlet.
- Test the outlet with another device to confirm it has power.
- Press the power button on the TV itself, not just the remote, to rule out a remote issue.

## 7.2 No Picture

- Verify that the correct input source is selected (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2).
- Check all cable connections (HDMI, antenna) for looseness or damage.
- Try connecting a different device to the same input or the same device to a different input.

## 7.3 No Sound

- Increase the volume on both the TV and any connected external audio devices.
- Check if the TV is muted.
- Ensure audio cables are correctly connected. If using HDMI ARC, verify the feature is enabled on both the TV and the audio device.
- Disable Bluetooth audio if headphones are inadvertently connected.

## 7.4 Network Connection Issues

- Restart your Wi-Fi router and modem.
- Go to the TV's Network Settings and attempt to reconnect to your Wi-Fi network.
- Ensure the TV is within range of your Wi-Fi router.
