Tissot Everytime 34mm Quartz Watch Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Tissot Everytime 34mm Quartz Watch. Please read these instructions carefully to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece.

The Tissot Everytime watch features a classic and timeless dial design, crafted with a 316L stainless steel case and a quartz movement. It is designed for versatility and elegance.

2. SETUP

2.1 Initial Inspection

Upon unboxing, carefully inspect your watch for any visible damage. Ensure all protective films are removed from the crystal and case back.

2.2 Setting the Time and Date

1. Locate the crown on the right side of the watch case.
2. Gently pull the crown out to position 2 (first click) to set the date. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise until the correct date is displayed.
3. Pull the crown out further to position 3 (second click) to set the time. Turn the crown to move the hour and minute hands. To ensure accurate time setting, synchronize with a reliable time source.
4. Once the time and date are set, push the crown back into position 1 (fully in) to engage the movement and start the watch.

2.3 Adjusting the Bracelet

The stainless steel bracelet features an interchangeable quick-release mechanism and a butterfly clasp with push-buttons. For initial fitting, you may need to adjust the length of the bracelet by adding or removing links. This procedure typically requires specialized tools and is best performed by a qualified watchmaker or jeweler to avoid damage.

3. OPERATING THE WATCH

3.1 Basic Time Reading

Your Tissot Everytime watch displays time using traditional hour, minute, and second hands on an index dial. The date is displayed in a window on the dial.

3.2 Water Resistance

This watch is water-resistant up to a pressure of 5 bar (50 meters / 165 feet). This rating makes it suitable for short periods of recreational swimming and showering. However, it is **not** suitable for diving, snorkeling, or high-impact water sports. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, clean the case and bracelet regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stainless steel, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

4.2 Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement, which requires a battery. When the battery is depleted, the watch will stop running. Battery replacement should be performed by an authorized Tissot service center or a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

4.3 Water Resistance Care

The water resistance of your watch is not permanent and may decrease over time due to the aging of gaskets or accidental impacts. It is recommended to have the water resistance checked annually by an authorized service center, especially if the watch is frequently exposed to water.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch Not Running:** If the watch stops, the battery may need replacement. Refer to section 4.2.
- **Incorrect Time/Date:** Ensure the crown is fully pushed in after setting. If the issue persists, re-set the time and date as per section 2.2.
- **Condensation Under Crystal:** This indicates a loss of water resistance. Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center to prevent further damage to the movement.
- **Strap Discomfort:** If the bracelet feels too tight or loose, consider having it adjusted by a professional (refer to section 2.3).
