INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the proper use, installation, and maintenance of the Generic 12-Pack Vacuum Cleaner Bags, Model MC125P. These bags are designed for compatibility with various Panasonic vacuum cleaner models, ensuring optimal performance and dust collection.

- Ensure the vacuum cleaner is turned off before opening the bag compartment.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP (BAG INSTALLATION)

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your Panasonic vacuum cleaner is unplugged from the electrical outlet.
2. **Open Compartment:** Locate and open the vacuum cleaner's dust bag compartment. Refer to your vacuum cleaner's specific user manual for exact instructions on opening the compartment.

3. **Remove Old Bag:** Carefully remove the full or old vacuum bag. Most bags have a self-sealing collar or a flap to prevent dust from escaping. Dispose of the old bag properly.
4. **Insert New Bag:** Take a new Generic MC125P vacuum bag. Align the cardboard collar of the new bag with the bag holder or intake port inside the vacuum cleaner's compartment. Push firmly until the bag is securely seated. Ensure the bag is fully unfolded inside the compartment and does not obstruct the closing mechanism.
5. **Close Compartment:** Close the dust bag compartment securely. Ensure it latches properly to prevent air leaks during operation.
6. **Reconnect Power:** Plug the vacuum cleaner back into the electrical outlet.

OPERATING

Once the new vacuum bag is installed, your vacuum cleaner is ready for operation. The bags are designed to collect dry debris. Avoid vacuuming liquids, sharp objects, or extremely fine powders (like drywall dust) as these can damage the bag or the vacuum cleaner.

Monitor the vacuum cleaner's performance. A decrease in suction power often indicates a full bag that needs replacement.

MAINTENANCE (BAG REPLACEMENT)

Regular bag replacement is crucial for maintaining optimal vacuum cleaner performance and air quality. Replace the vacuum bag when:

- The suction power of your vacuum cleaner noticeably decreases.
- The bag full indicator (if your vacuum has one) illuminates.
- The bag appears visibly full or heavy.
