# WPPO 1200 Watt Ash Vacuum with Accessories User Manual

Model: 1200 Watt Ash Vacuum

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the WPPO 1200 Watt Ash Vacuum. This powerful and versatile vacuum is designed for efficient and safe cleanup of ash from various sources, including wood stoves, pellet stoves, fireplaces, fire pits, and BBQ grills. Its robust 1200-watt motor and specialized fire-retardant filtration system ensure thorough cleaning while maintaining air quality. Please read this manual carefully before operating the vacuum to ensure safe and optimal performance.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

**WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, read and follow all instructions before use.

- **Never vacuum hot ash or embers.** Ensure all ash is completely cold and extinguished before vacuuming. Wait at least 24-48 hours after a fire, or until ash is cool to the touch.
- This appliance is for dry ash collection only. Do not use for wet materials or liquids.
- Do not use the vacuum if the power cord or plug is damaged. Contact customer support for replacement.
- Do not operate the vacuum without the fire-retardant filter properly installed.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.

- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Store the vacuum indoors in a dry place.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Your WPPO 1200 Watt Ash Vacuum package includes the following components:

- WPPO 1200 Watt Ash Vacuum Unit
- Flexible Hose
- Metal Nozzle/Wand
- Fire-Retardant Filter (pre-installed or separate)
- Power Cord (5 ft.)
- Additional Accessories (specific types may vary)

## 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Inspect for Damage:** Check the vacuum unit, hose, and power cord for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
3. **Filter Installation (if not pre-installed):**
  - Open the vacuum lid by releasing the latches.
  - Ensure the fire-retardant filter is securely seated over the motor housing. The filter is crucial for safe operation and ash containment.
  - Close the lid, ensuring the latches are firmly secured.
4. **Attach Hose and Nozzle:**
  - Insert the flexible hose into the intake port on the vacuum unit until it clicks or is firmly seated.
  - Attach the metal nozzle/wand to the other end of the flexible hose.
5. **Positioning:** Place the vacuum on a stable, level surface near the area to be cleaned. Ensure the 5 ft. power cord can reach a suitable 120V outlet without being stretched or obstructed.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Ensure Ash is Cold:** Double-check that all ash and embers are completely cold before proceeding. This is critical for safety.
2. **Plug In:** Insert the power cord plug into a standard 120V electrical outlet.
3. **Turn On:** Locate the power switch on the vacuum unit and switch it to the "ON" position. The vacuum will start.
4. **Vacuum Ash:**
  - Carefully guide the metal nozzle over the cold ash. The powerful suction will draw the ash into the vacuum canister.
  - Work systematically to cover the entire area.
  - Avoid excessive contact of the metal nozzle with hot surfaces, even if the ash is cold.
5. **Turn Off:** Once cleaning is complete, switch the power button to the "OFF" position.

- 6. **Unplug:** Disconnect the power cord from the electrical outlet.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your ash vacuum.

### 6.1 Emptying the Canister

- 1. Ensure the vacuum is unplugged.
- 2. Release the latches on the vacuum lid and carefully lift the lid off.
- 3. Remove the filter assembly.
- 4. Carefully lift the canister and empty the collected ash into a non-combustible container (e.g., a metal ash can) with a tight-fitting lid.
- 5. Dispose of ash according to local regulations. Even cold ash can contain residual heat.
- 6. Reassemble the filter and lid, ensuring all components are securely in place.

### 6.2 Cleaning the Filter

The fire-retardant filter should be cleaned regularly to maintain suction power. The frequency depends on usage.

- 1. Ensure the vacuum is unplugged.
- 2. Remove the filter from the vacuum.
- 3. Gently tap the filter against a hard surface (preferably outdoors or over a trash can) to dislodge accumulated ash.
- 4. For more thorough cleaning, use a soft brush or compressed air to remove fine dust from the filter pleats. Do not wash the filter with water unless specifically instructed by WPPO, as this may damage the fire-retardant properties.
- 5. Inspect the filter for any tears or damage. A damaged filter must be replaced immediately.
- 6. Reinstall the clean filter securely.

### 6.3 Filter Replacement

Over time, filters will wear out and lose effectiveness. Replacement fire-retardant filters are available from WPPO. Refer to the product packaging or WPPO's official website for ordering information.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING
