## 1. INTRODUCTION

- Always use the slide under adult supervision.
- Do not load more than 250 pounds on either bunk.
- Follow assembly instructions carefully to prevent instability or collapse.
- Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use and periodically check for tightness.
- Only use mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions for twin beds.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Always use the ladder for climbing to and from the top bunk.
- Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, or jump ropes.

- **Enhanced Safety:** Full-length guardrails on the upper bunk prevent accidental falls. Heavy-duty screws ensure tight fixation of each part for wobble-resistant sturdiness.
- **Integrated Ladder:** A sturdy built-in ladder with widened steel legs provides easy and safe access to the top bunk.
- **Fun Slide Feature:** A smooth slide with a gentle slope adds an element of play and excitement, ensuring safe descent from the top bunk.
- **No Box Spring Required:** The bed includes 21 sturdy slats that offer ample support for mattresses, eliminating the need for a box spring or foundation. (Mattress not included).

## 6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and recreational use of the slide. Adhere to the following guidelines for safe operation:

- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 250 pounds per bunk.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the built-in ladder to access the top bunk. Face the ladder when climbing up or down.
- **Slide Use:** Use the slide one person at a time, feet first. Ensure the area around the slide is clear before use. Adult supervision is required when using the slide.
- **Mattress Placement:** Ensure mattresses are properly seated on the slats and do not extend above the top of the guardrails on the upper bunk.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and safety of your bunk bed:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners that may damage the powder coating.

- **Fastener Check:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and other fasteners to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability.
- **Structural Integrity:** Inspect the bed frame, slats, ladder, and slide for any signs of damage, wear, or loose connections. Discontinue use if any damage is found and contact customer support.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Squeaking Noises:** If the bed begins to squeak, check all assembly points and tighten any loose bolts or screws. Ensure the mattress is properly seated.
- **Instability/Wobbling:** If the bed feels unstable, immediately cease use. Re-check all connections and ensure they are fully tightened according to the assembly instructions. Verify that the bed is on a flat, level surface.
