## 1. INTRODUCTION

### 3. SETUP

Before beginning any bracelet project, ensure the Wrapit Loom is properly set up on a stable, flat surface. The loom features adjustable pegs to accommodate different bracelet lengths and styles. - 3. Organize Beads:** Utilize the built-in compartments on the loom to sort and store your beads, making them easily accessible during the crafting process.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Wrapit Loom supports four primary bracelet styles: macrame, wrapped, friendship, and beaded. Each style utilizes specific knotting or threading techniques. Detailed step-by-step instructions with diagrams are provided in the physical instruction manual included with your kit.

### 4.1. Macrame Bracelets

Macrame bracelets involve knotting threads in specific patterns to create intricate designs. The loom helps maintain tension and alignment of the core threads while you tie the working threads around them.

1. **Thread Setup:** Secure the base threads onto the loom pegs as indicated for macrame.
2. **Knotting:** Use a separate working thread to tie square knots or other macrame knots around the base threads.
3. **Pattern Repetition:** Continue knotting, following the pattern diagrams in your manual, until the desired bracelet length is achieved.

### 4.2. Wrapped Bracelets

Wrapped bracelets involve tightly wrapping one or more threads around a core thread or set of threads, often incorporating beads.

1. **Core Thread:** Secure the core thread(s) on the loom.
2. **Wrapping:** Begin wrapping the working thread(s) tightly around the core thread(s).
3. **Adding Beads:** Slide beads onto the working thread at desired intervals before continuing to wrap.

### 4.3. Friendship Bracelets

Traditional friendship bracelets are created by knotting multiple strands of thread together in various patterns. The loom simplifies the process by holding the threads in place.

1. **Thread Arrangement:** Arrange and secure the desired number of threads onto the loom pegs.
2. **Knotting Patterns:** Follow the specific knotting patterns (e.g., chevron, diagonal stripes) outlined in the manual.
3. **Consistency:** Maintain consistent tension for a uniform and neat appearance.

### 4.4. Beaded Bracelets

Beaded bracelets focus on stringing beads onto threads, often combined with knotting techniques for secure placement and design.

1. **Thread Preparation:** Cut threads to the appropriate length and secure them to the loom.
2. **Bead Stringing:** Thread beads onto the working threads. The loom can assist in keeping multiple threads separate.
3. **Securing Beads:** Use small knots or specific weaving techniques to hold beads in place along the bracelet.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your Wrapit Loom and materials will ensure longevity and continued enjoyment.

- **Cleaning the Loom:** Wipe the loom clean with a soft, dry cloth after each use to remove any dust or residue. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Storing Materials:** Keep threads and beads organized in the loom's compartments or in separate sealed containers to prevent tangling, loss, or damage. Store away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Thread Care:** Avoid excessive pulling or fraying of threads. If a thread becomes frayed, trim the damaged section.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues while using your Wrapit Loom, consider the following common solutions:

- Tangled Threads:** If threads become tangled, carefully untangle them. Ensure threads are kept separate and taut during the crafting process.
- Loose Beads:** If beads are not staying in place, ensure they are properly secured with knots or by weaving the thread through them multiple times as per the instructions for your chosen bracelet style.
- Difficulty with Knots:** Practice knotting techniques on scrap threads before applying them to your main project. Refer to the manual's diagrams for visual guidance.
- Bracelet Length:** Always measure your wrist or the intended recipient's wrist before starting to ensure the correct length. The loom's adjustable feature helps in this regard.
