1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Yaheetech Retractable Manual Awning is designed to provide effective sun protection and shade for various outdoor spaces such as terraces, balconies, restaurants, and cafes. This manual awning features a telescopic design, allowing for adjustable height and angle, and can be easily retracted when not in use. Its robust construction ensures durability and resistance to various weather conditions.

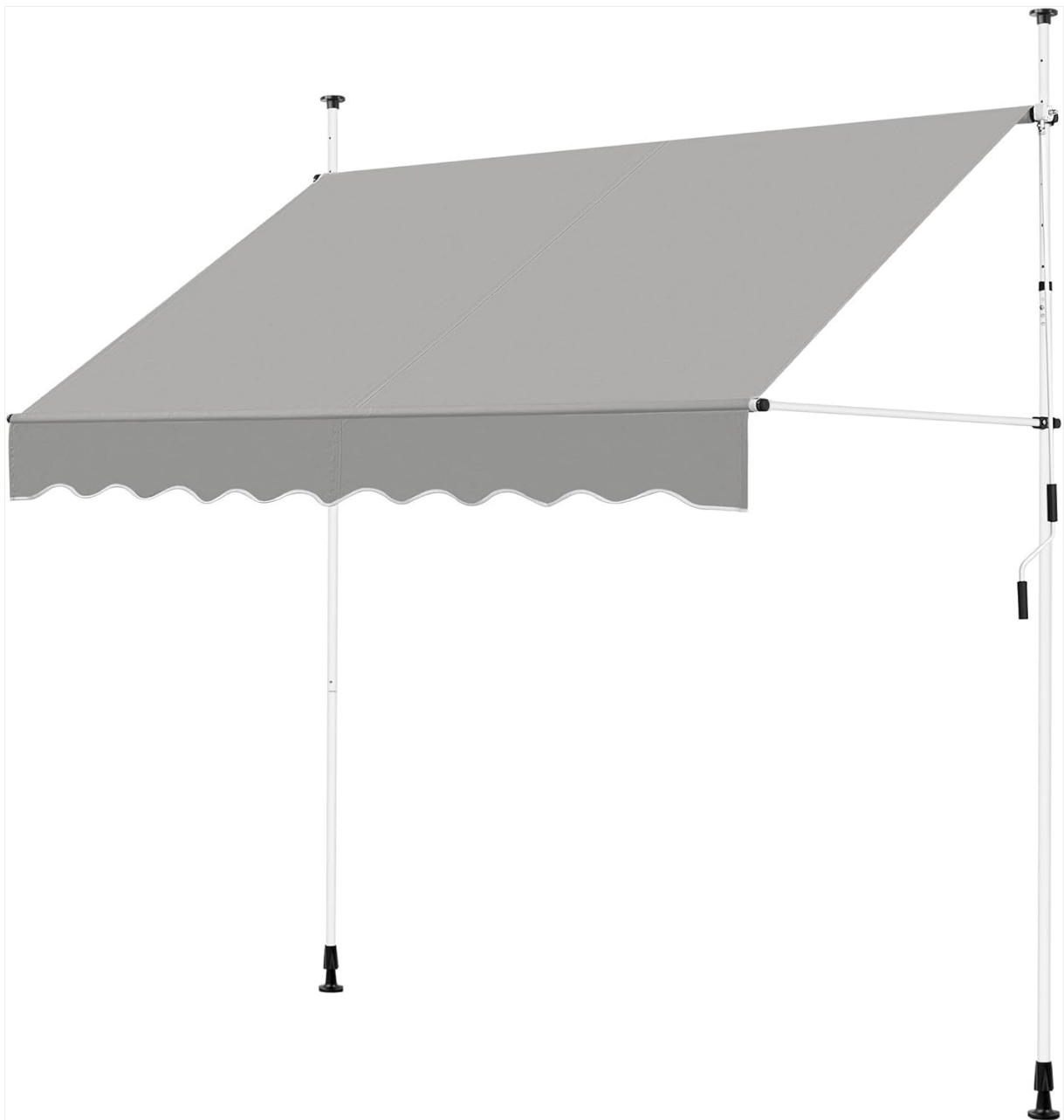


Figure 1.1: The Yaheetech Retractable Manual Awning, showcasing its light grey fabric and white frame.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembling and operating the awning. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- For safety reasons, always retract the awning during windy and rainy weather conditions. This prevents potential damage to the awning and ensures user safety.
- Ensure all components are securely fastened during assembly to prevent instability.
- Do not hang heavy objects from the awning frame.
- Keep children and pets away from the awning during operation.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, ensure all the following components are present and undamaged:

- Awning Fabric (Polyester with PU coating)
- Durable Steel Frame (Telescopic poles, support arms)
- Crank Handle
- Non-slip Foot Pads (4 units)
- Adjusting Holes/Mechanisms
- Solid Base
- Mounting Hardware (if applicable, for securing top pads)

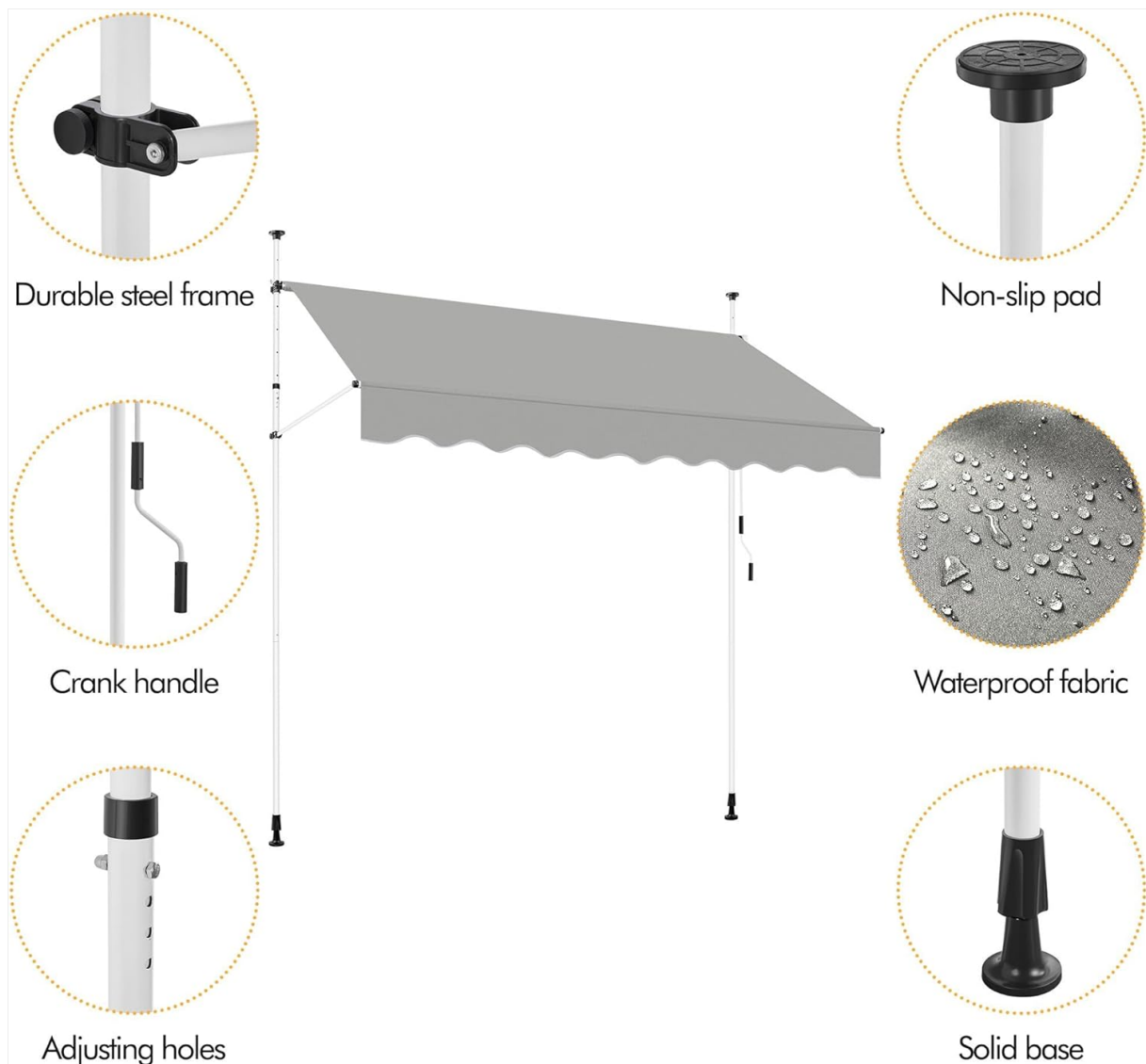


Figure 3.1: Key components of the Yaheetech Retractable Manual Awning.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This manual awning is designed for easy, drill-free installation. Follow these steps for proper assembly:

1. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the telescopic poles according to the instructions provided in the packaging. Ensure all connections are secure.
2. **Attach the Fabric:** Carefully attach the awning fabric to the assembled frame. Ensure it is properly aligned and secured.
3. **Position the Awning:** Place the awning in your desired location. The telescopic poles allow for height adjustment between 210 cm and 300 cm.
4. **Secure the Non-slip Pads:** The four non-slip foot pads at the end of the poles protect both your floor/ceiling and the awning. Fix the upper pads securely against the ceiling or overhang, and ensure the bottom pads are firmly on the ground. No drilling is required for installation.
5. **Adjust Height and Angle:** Use the adjusting holes and mechanisms on the poles to set the desired height and angle of the awning.

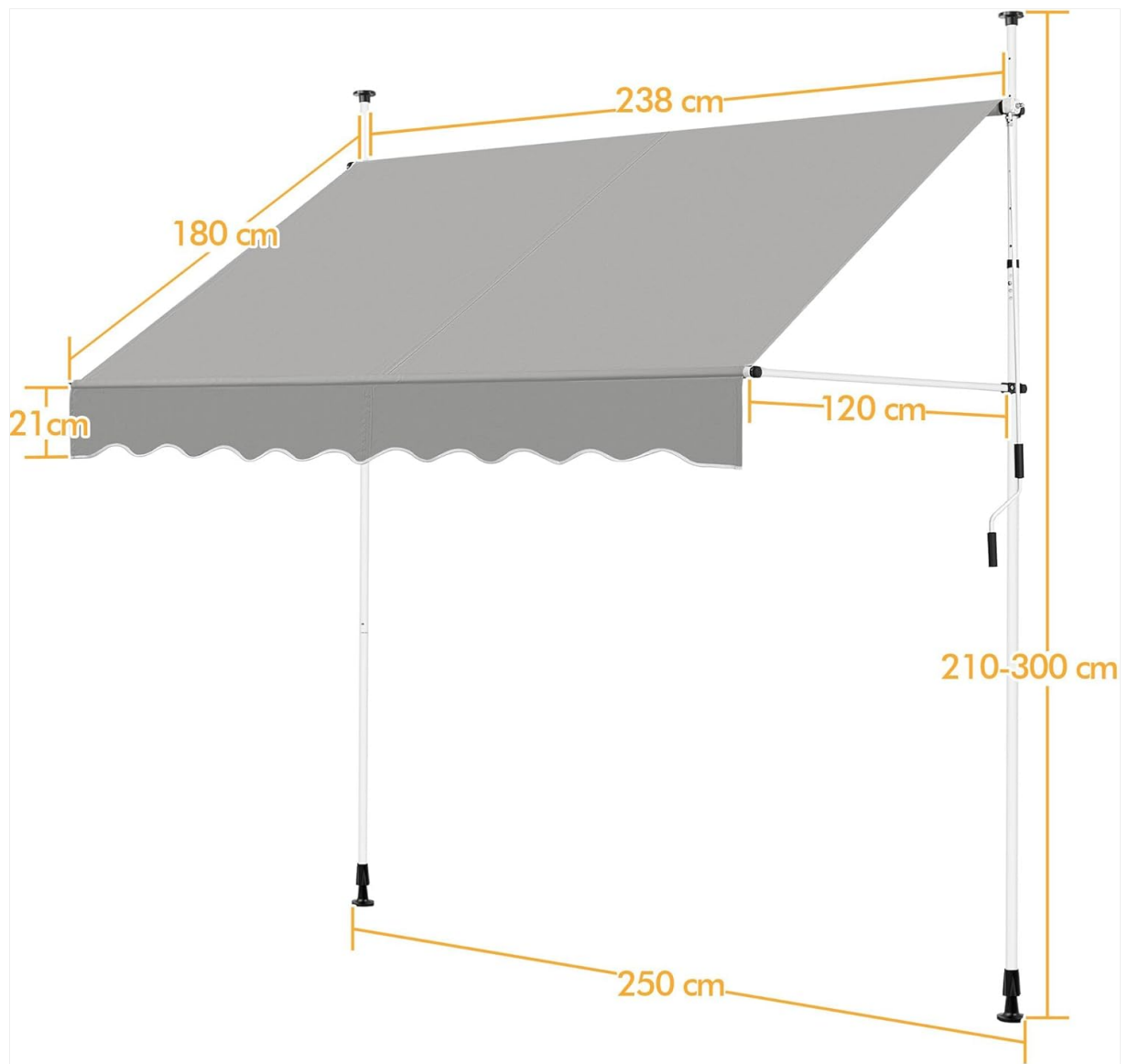


Figure 4.2: The awning providing shade over a window, showcasing its versatility.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Yaheetech Retractable Manual Awning is operated manually using the provided crank handle.

- **Extending the Awning:** To extend the awning, turn the crank handle in the direction that causes the fabric to unroll and extend outwards. Continue turning until the desired shade area is achieved.
- **Retracting the Awning:** To retract the awning, turn the crank handle in the opposite direction. The fabric will roll back into its housing. Fully retract the awning when not in use or during adverse weather conditions.
- **Adjusting Angle and Height:** The awning's angle and height can be adjusted by manipulating the telescopic poles and support arms. This allows you to optimize the shade coverage throughout the day.
- **Privacy Function:** The supporting rod can be adjusted to roll the awning down further, providing additional privacy when needed.

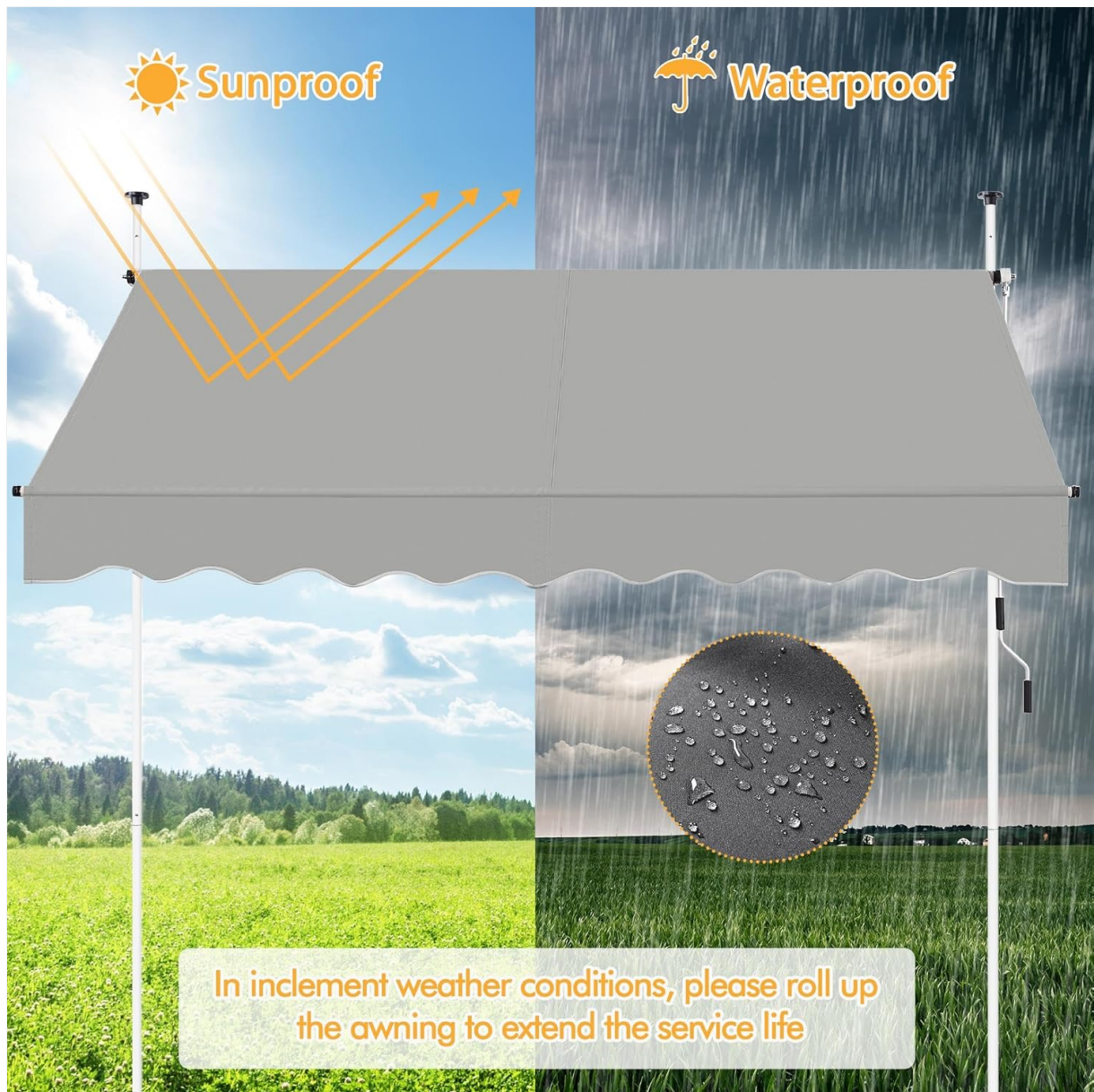
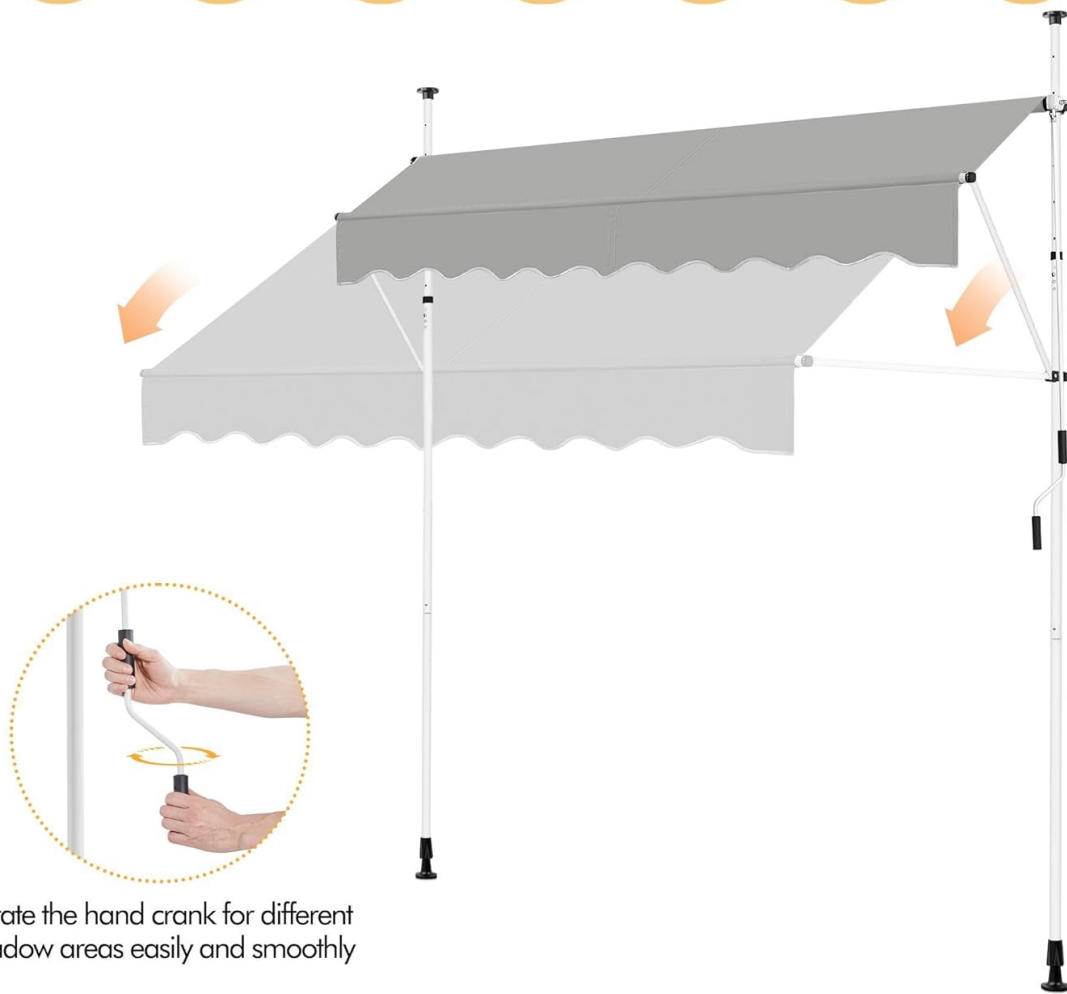


Figure 5.1: Adjusting the awning's extension and angle using the hand crank.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your Yaheetech awning.

- **Cleaning the Fabric:** Clean the polyester fabric with a mild soap and water solution. Use a soft brush or cloth to gently scrub away dirt. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow to air dry completely before retracting. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Frame Inspection:** Periodically inspect the metal frame for any signs of rust, damage, or loose connections. Tighten any loose bolts or screws.
- **Lubrication:** If the crank mechanism or telescopic poles become stiff, apply a silicone-based lubricant to the moving parts.
- **Weather Precautions:** Always retract the awning during strong winds, heavy rain, snow, or hail to prevent damage. This is crucial for the longevity of the product.
- **Storage:** If storing the awning for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry before retracting and storing in a protected area.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your awning.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Awning difficult to extend/retract.	Mechanism is dry or dirty; fabric is misaligned.	Clean and lubricate the crank mechanism and telescopic poles. Check fabric alignment on the roller.
Awning is unstable.	Poles not properly secured; non-slip pads not firmly placed.	Ensure telescopic poles are fully extended and locked. Verify non-slip pads are firmly pressed against the ceiling/ground.
Fabric appears dirty or stained.	Accumulation of dirt, dust, or mildew.	Clean the fabric as described in the Maintenance section.
Awning sways excessively in light wind.	Not properly secured or adjusted.	Ensure all connections are tight and the poles are securely positioned. Retract in stronger winds.

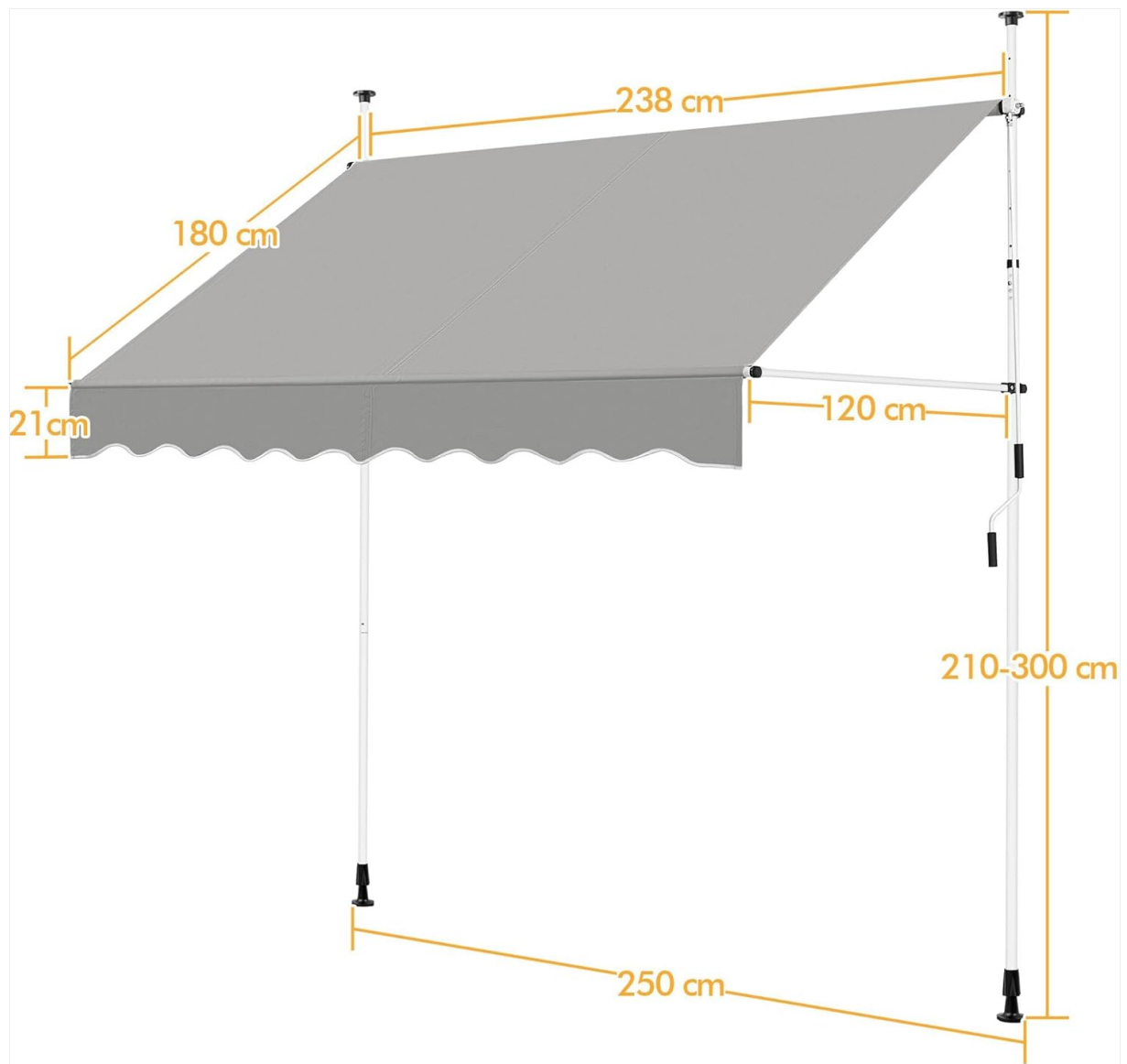






Figure 8.1: Dimensional overview of the awning.
