1. Introduction

The HP Color LaserJet Pro MFP M182nw is a versatile all-in-one color laser printer designed for efficient printing, scanning, and copying. This manual provides essential information to help you set up, operate, and maintain your device, ensuring optimal performance and longevity.

2. What's in the Box

3. Setup Guide

Follow these steps to set up your HP Color LaserJet Pro MFP M182nw printer:

1. **Unpack the Printer:** Carefully remove the printer from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, tapes, and protective films from the exterior and interior of the printer.
2. **Install Toner Cartridges:** Open the toner access door and insert the provided starter toner cartridges into their corresponding slots. Ensure they click into place.
3. **Load Paper:** Open the paper tray and load plain paper. Adjust the paper guides to fit the paper size.
4. **Connect Power:** Connect the power cord to the printer and then to a grounded electrical outlet.
5. **Power On:** Press the power button to turn on the printer.
6. **Choose Connection Method:**
 - **USB Connection:** Connect the USB cable from the printer to your computer.
 - **Ethernet (Wired Network):** Connect an Ethernet cable from the printer to your network router or switch.
 - **Wi-Fi (Wireless Network):** Follow the on-screen prompts on the printer's control panel to connect to

your wireless network. You may need your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password.

7. **Install Software/Drivers:** Insert the installation CD (if provided) or visit the official HP support website to download and install the latest drivers and software for your operating system. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.

4. Operating Instructions

The HP Color LaserJet Pro MFP M182nw offers print, scan, and copy functionalities. Use the two-Line LCD with numeric keypad on the control panel to navigate settings and initiate tasks.

4.1. Printing

- **From a Computer:** Select 'Print' from your application, choose the HP Color LaserJet Pro MFP M182nw, and adjust settings as needed (e.g., color, paper size, number of copies). The printer delivers crisp text and vibrant color prints at speeds of up to 17 pages per minute (ppm).
- **Mobile Printing:** The printer supports various mobile printing solutions:
 - **Apple AirPrint:** For iOS devices.
 - **Mopria:** For Android devices.
 - **HP ePrint:** Print from anywhere by sending an email to your printer's unique email address.
 - **HP Smart App:** Download the HP Smart App for guided setup, mobile printing, scanning, and monitoring printer status.

4.2. Scanning

The flatbed scanner offers an optical scan resolution of 1200 dpi, enabling high-quality digital captures. Supported file formats include JPG, RAW (BMP), PNG, TIFF, and PDF.

- **From the Printer:** Place your document on the scanner glass. Use the control panel to select 'Scan' and choose your destination (e.g., computer, email, network folder).
- **From a Computer:** Open the HP scanning software on your computer, select the HP Color LaserJet Pro MFP M182nw, and initiate the scan.

4.3. Copying

Copy speeds match printing speeds at 17 ppm for both black and color documents. You can make up to 99 copies at a time.

- Place the document on the scanner glass or in the automatic document feeder (if available).
- On the control panel, select 'Copy'.
- Use the numeric keypad to enter the desired number of copies.
- Press the 'Start' button (usually a green button or 'OK') to begin copying.

5. Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your printer.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the exterior of the printer with a soft, damp cloth. Clean the scanner glass with a lint-free cloth and glass cleaner.
- **Toner Replacement:** Replace toner cartridges when the printer indicates low toner levels. Refer to the printer's display for specific instructions on replacing cartridges.
- **Paper Handling:** Use recommended paper types and sizes. Ensure paper is loaded correctly to prevent jams.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the HP support website for firmware updates to ensure your printer has the latest features and bug fixes.

The printer boasts a maximum monthly duty cycle of 30,000 pages, with a recommended volume ranging between 150 and 1500 pages for consistent reliability.

6. Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your printer.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Printer not responding	Check power connection. Ensure USB/Ethernet cable is securely connected or Wi-Fi is active. Restart printer and computer.
Poor print quality	Check toner levels. Ensure correct paper type is used. Clean print heads (if applicable, though less common for laser).
Paper jams	Remove jammed paper carefully following printer instructions. Ensure paper is loaded correctly and not overfilled.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Verify Wi-Fi password. Ensure printer is within range of the router. Restart router and printer.
Scanner not working	Ensure printer drivers are installed correctly. Check USB/network connection. Restart printer.
