Merax Metal Full Cabin Daybed with Storage Shelves Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Merax Metal Full Cabin Daybed with Storage Shelves. This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new daybed. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always assemble the daybed on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage to the product or your floor.
- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before beginning assembly. Contact customer support immediately if any parts are missing or damaged.
- Do not use power tools for assembly as this may overtighten fasteners and damage the frame.
- Periodically check all connections and tighten them as necessary to ensure stability.
- Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity for the daybed.
- Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children during assembly.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present. If any items are missing or damaged, please contact Merax customer service.

Components:

- Daybed Frame (Metal sections)
- Storage Shelves (MDF and Metal sections)
- Bed Slats (Metal)

- Hardware Pack (Bolts, Washers, Nuts, Allen Wrench)

Note: The daybed is shipped in two packages. Ensure both packages have arrived before starting assembly.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your Merax Daybed. It is recommended that two adults assemble this product.

Step 1: Unpack and Identify Parts

Carefully unpack all components from the boxes. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface. Refer to the parts list (not included in this manual, but typically found in the physical package) to identify each piece.

Step 2: Assemble the Main Frame

Connect the side rails to the headboard and footboard sections using the provided bolts and an Allen wrench. Do not fully tighten all bolts until the entire frame is assembled.

Step 3: Attach Storage Shelves

Assemble the storage shelf unit according to the diagrams in your physical instruction manual. Attach the completed shelf unit to the headboard section of the daybed frame using the designated hardware.

Step 4: Install Bed Slats

Place the metal bed slats across the support rails of the daybed frame. Secure each slat using the provided fasteners to ensure a stable mattress foundation.

Step 5: Final Tightening

Once all components are in place, go back and fully tighten all bolts and fasteners. Ensure the daybed is stable and level before use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Merax Daybed is designed for use with a standard full-size mattress. No box spring is required due to the metal slat support system.

- **Mattress Placement:** Place your full-size mattress directly onto the metal slats.
- **Storage Shelves:** Utilize the integrated shelves for books, decorative items, or personal belongings. Ensure items are placed securely and do not overload the shelves.
- **Weight Capacity:** Adhere to the maximum weight capacity specified in the 'Specifications' section to ensure safety and product longevity.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame and MDF surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts and screws to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Keep the daybed in a dry environment to prevent damage to the wood-look panels and metal components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue: Daybed feels wobbly or unstable.

- **Solution:** Check all bolts and screws. Ensure they are fully tightened. If the issue persists, disassemble and reassemble, ensuring all connections are properly aligned.

Issue: Parts do not align during assembly.

- **Solution:** Do not force parts together. Loosen previously tightened bolts to allow for more flexibility, align the current parts, then gradually tighten all bolts. Ensure you are using the correct parts for each step as per the physical manual's diagrams.

Issue: Missing or damaged parts.

- **Solution:** Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Merax customer support with your product model number and a description of the missing or damaged part for assistance.

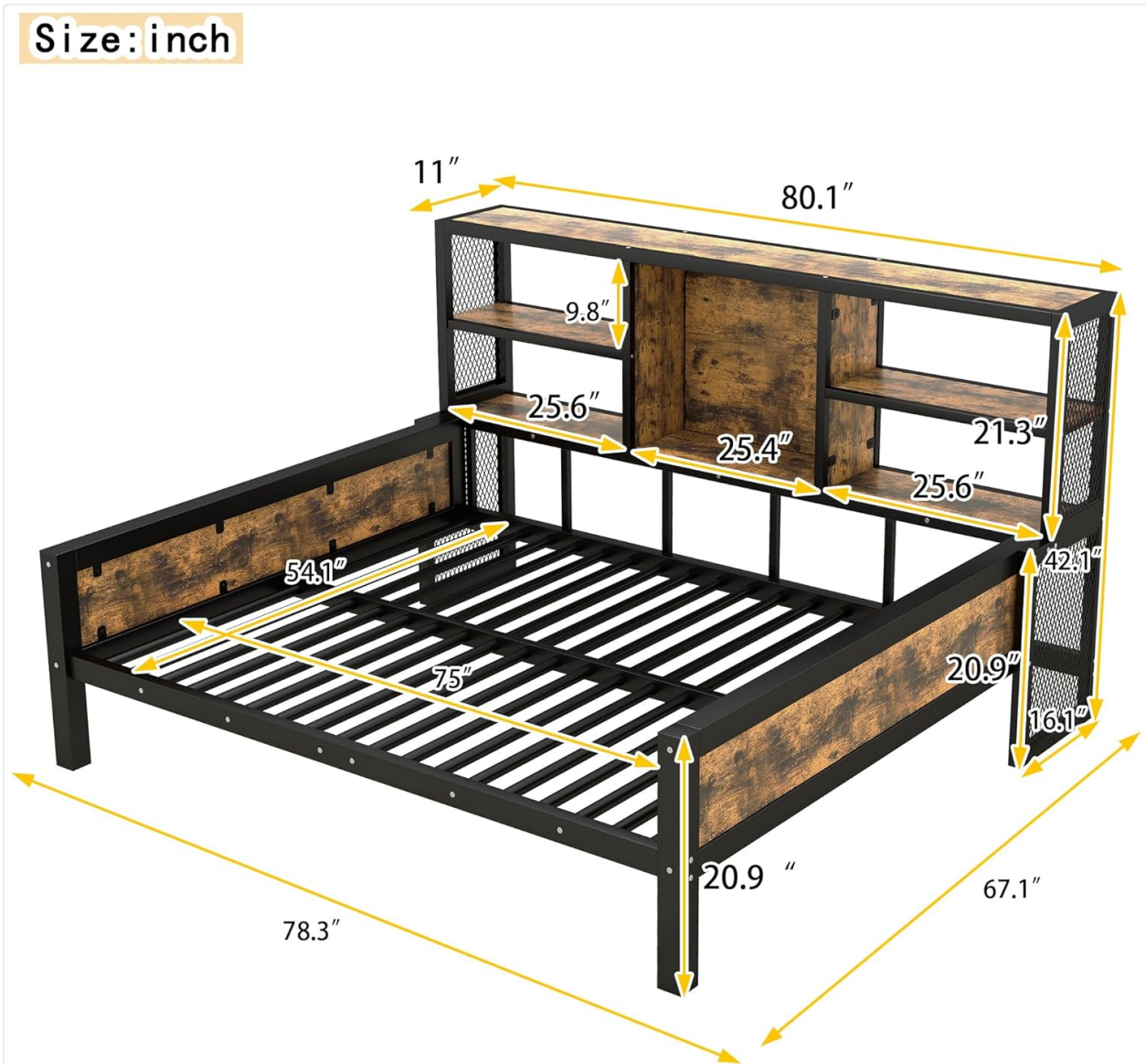


Image: Product dimensions overview.
