1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

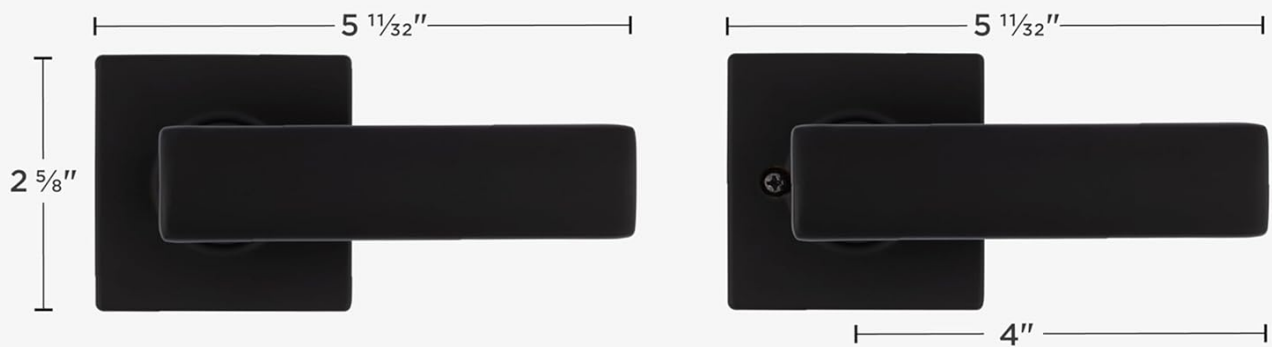


Image: A visual representation of all components included in the Weiser Breton Passage Lever package, including levers, latch, strike plate, screws, and Allen wrench.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Installation of the Weiser Breton Passage Lever is designed to be straightforward and can be completed with minimal tools. Follow these general steps for a successful installation:

1. **Prepare the Door:** Ensure your door has the correct bore holes. The lever fits door thicknesses from 1-3/8" to 1-3/4" and requires a cross bore of 2-1/8".
2. **Install the Latch:** Insert the latch into the edge of the door. Ensure the bevel of the latch bolt faces the door frame. Secure with screws.
3. **Install the Levers:** Align the exterior and interior levers with the latch mechanism. Insert the spindle through the latch.
4. **Secure the Levers:** Use the provided screws to fasten the levers together through the door. Tighten securely but do not overtighten.
5. **Install the Strike Plate:** Attach the strike plate to the door frame, aligning it with the latch bolt. Secure with screws.

6. **Test Operation:** Close the door and test the lever operation to ensure smooth engagement and disengagement of the latch.

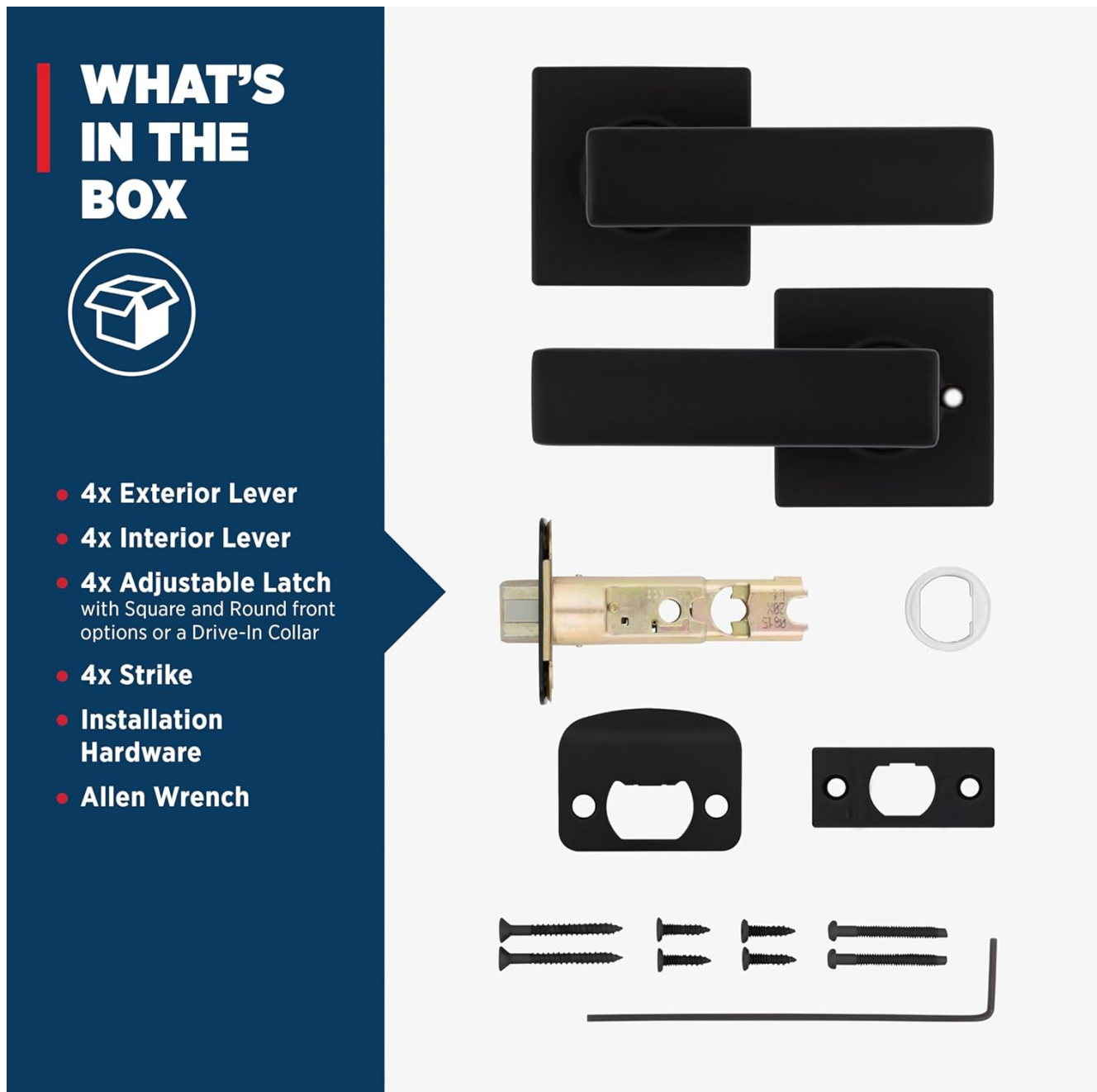


Image: A hand using a screwdriver to install a Weiser door lever, demonstrating the ease of installation.

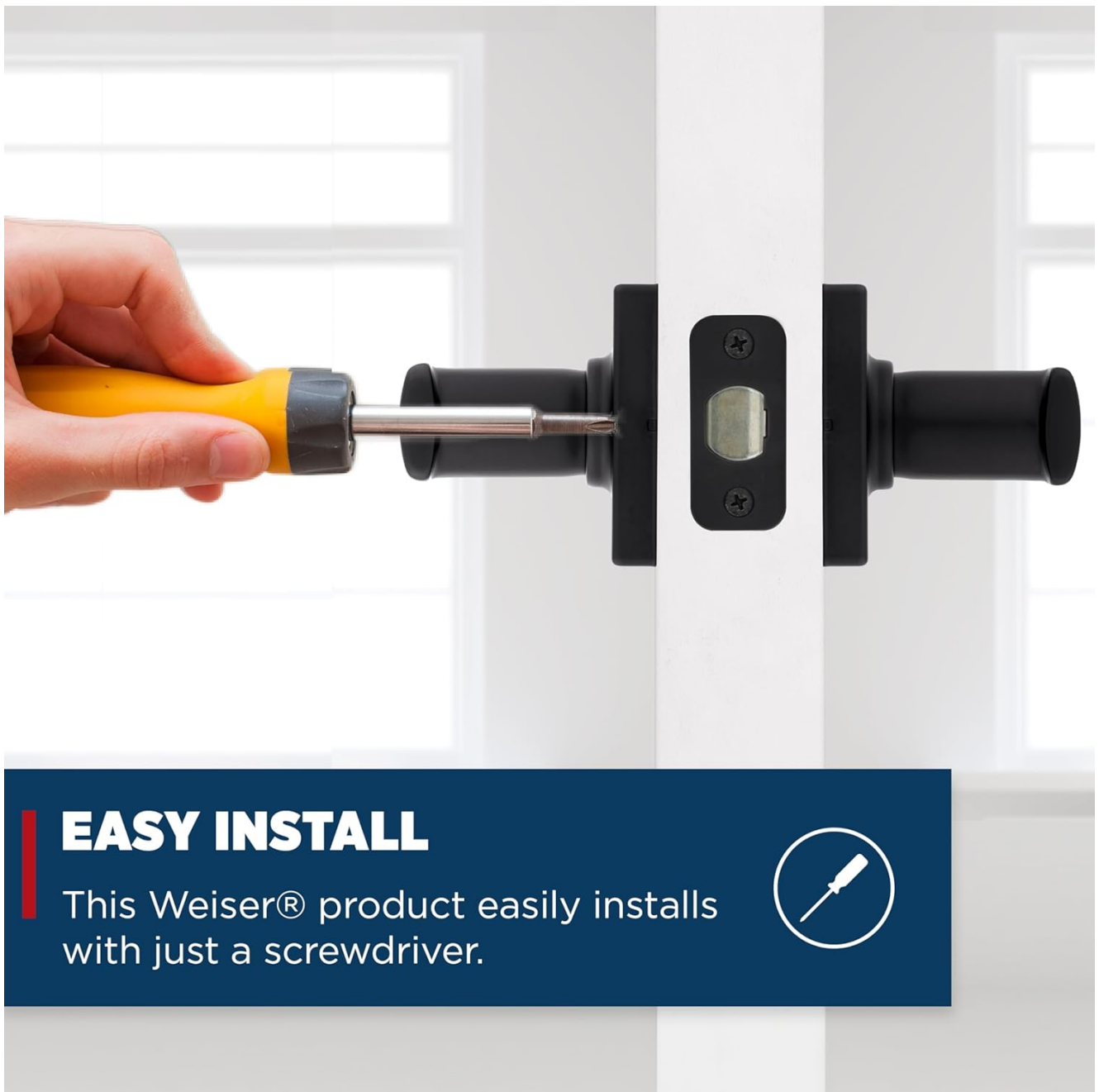

5. OPERATING THE LEVER

The Weiser Breton Passage Lever operates by simply pressing down on the lever handle to retract the latch bolt, allowing the door to open. Releasing the lever extends the latch bolt, securing the door when closed. As a passage lever, it does not include a locking mechanism, making it ideal for rooms where privacy is not required, such as hallways, closets, and utility rooms.

6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Weiser Breton Passage Levers, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the levers regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the latch bolt and internal mechanisms to ensure smooth operation. Do not use oil-based lubricants, which can attract dust and debris.
- **Tightening Screws:** Over time, screws may loosen. Periodically check and tighten all mounting screws to prevent lever wobble or sag. Do not overtighten.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Weiser Breton Passage Lever, refer to the following common troubleshooting

tips:

- **Lever is Loose/Wobbly:** This is typically caused by loose mounting screws. Tighten the screws on both the interior and exterior levers. Ensure the spindle is properly seated.
- **Latch Bolt Does Not Retract Smoothly:** Check for obstructions in the door frame or strike plate. Ensure the latch bolt is clean and lubricated. Verify that the latch is installed correctly and not binding.
- **Door Does Not Latch Properly:** Ensure the strike plate is correctly aligned with the latch bolt. Adjust the strike plate position if necessary. Check for any warping in the door or frame that might prevent proper latching.
- **Finish Damage:** Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials for cleaning. Minor scratches may be touched up with a matching matte black paint, but significant damage may require replacement.







