INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your aarke Purifier Glass Water Pitcher. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always handle the glass carafe with care to prevent breakage. Do not expose the pitcher to extreme temperature changes. Keep out of reach of children. Ensure all components are properly assembled before use to prevent leaks or damage.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The aarke Purifier Glass Water Pitcher is designed to provide clean, great-tasting water by reducing common contaminants. It features a durable glass carafe, a stainless steel filter cartridge, and a detachable silicone bumper for added protection.

Components:

- Glass Water Carafe Purifier
- Stainless Steel BPA-Free Cartridge and Lid
- Detachable Food Grade Silicone Bumper

SETUP

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Wash Components:** Before first use, wash the glass carafe, stainless steel cartridge, and lid with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly. The silicone bumper can also be washed.
3. **Prepare Filter Cartridge:**
 - Open the Pure Filter Refill Bag.
 - Pour the filter granules into the stainless steel filter cartridge.
 - Securely close the cartridge lid.
4. **Assemble Pitcher:**
 - Place the silicone bumper onto the base of the glass carafe.
 - Insert the assembled filter cartridge into the designated slot within the glass carafe.
 - Place the main lid onto the pitcher, ensuring it sits securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Filling the Pitcher:** Open the lid and pour tap water into the top reservoir of the pitcher. The water will slowly filter through the granules into the main carafe.
2. **Filtration Time:** Filtration typically takes 3-5 minutes per liter.
3. **Pouring Water:** Once filtered, the water is ready for consumption. Simply tilt the pitcher to pour. The lid is designed to stay in place during pouring.

Filter Granule Types:

- **Pure Filter Granules:** Reduce limescale, chlorine, and heavy metals (lead and copper).
- **Enriched Filter Granules (Optional):** In addition to the above, these add magnesium minerals for an enhanced drinking experience.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- All components, except the filter granules, are dishwasher safe.
- Before placing the filter cartridge in the dishwasher, ensure all granules are removed.
- Regular cleaning helps maintain hygiene and optimal performance.

Filter Replacement:

- Filter granules should be changed every 8 weeks for sustained purity and performance.
- The lid features a filter-change indicator to remind you when replacement is due.
- To replace, empty the old granules from the stainless steel cartridge and refill with a new bag of aarke filter granules.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow Filtration	Filter granules are saturated or clogged.	Replace filter granules. Ensure proper assembly of the filter cartridge.
Water Taste Not Improved	Filter granules need replacement or are not suitable for specific contaminants.	Replace filter granules. Consider using "Enriched" granules if specific mineral taste is desired. Ensure proper filter installation.
Leaking from Pitcher	Components not assembled correctly or silicone bumper is misplaced.	Disassemble and reassemble all parts, ensuring the silicone bumper is correctly seated and the lid is secure.
