Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Timex Unisex Q LCA 35mm Digital Watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize the lifespan of your timepiece. This watch features a digital display, a durable gray case, a comfortable gray strap, an acrylic lens, and is water resistant up to 30 meters.

SETUP

To set up your Timex Q LCA watch, follow these steps. The watch typically has buttons labeled MODE/SET, LIGHT, CH-S/S-AL-ON, ADV-AL-OFF, and LAP/RESET.

1. Initial Activation: If the display is blank, press any button to activate the watch.

2. Setting Time and Date:

- Press and hold the **MODE/SET** button until the time display begins to flash.
- Press the ADV-AL-OFF button to advance the flashing digit (hours, minutes, seconds).
- Press the CH-S/S-AL-ON button to select the next digit or setting (e.g., 12/24 hour format, year, month, day).
- Repeat until all desired settings are adjusted.
- Press MODE/SET again to exit the setting mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Timex Q LCA watch offers several functions. Familiarize yourself with the button layout and their corresponding actions.

- Light Function: Press the LIGHT button (usually on the top left) to illuminate the display for a few seconds.
- **Mode Selection:** Press the **MODE/SET** button repeatedly to cycle through different modes: Time, Dual Time, Alarm, Timer, Stopwatch.

• Stopwatch:

- Navigate to the Stopwatch mode using the MODE/SET button.
- Press CH-S/S-AL-ON to start/stop the stopwatch.
- Press LAP/RESET to record a lap time or to reset the stopwatch when stopped.

· Alarm:

- Navigate to the Alarm mode using the MODE/SET button.
- Press and hold MODE/SET to enter alarm setting.
- Use ADV-AL-OFF to adjust the alarm time.
- Use CH-S/S-AL-ON to toggle the alarm ON/OFF.
- Press MODE/SET to confirm and exit.

• Timer:

- Navigate to the Timer mode using the **MODE/SET** button.
- Press and hold MODE/SET to enter timer setting.
- Use ADV-AL-OFF to adjust the countdown time.
- Press CH-S/S-AL-ON to start/pause the timer.
- Press LAP/RESET to reset the timer.
- Press MODE/SET to confirm and exit.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and performance of your Timex watch.

- Water Resistance: This watch is water resistant up to 30 meters (3 ATM). This means it is suitable for splashes or brief immersion in water. It is not recommended for swimming, showering, or diving. Do not press any buttons while the watch is wet.
- Cleaning: Clean the watch case and strap with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, which can damage the finish.
- Battery Replacement: The watch uses 1 Lithium Metal battery (included). When the display dims or functions become erratic, it may be time to replace the battery. It is recommended to have battery replacement performed by a qualified watch technician to ensure water resistance is maintained.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the watch in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your watch, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• Display is blank or dim:

- The battery may be low or depleted. Replace the battery.
- Ensure the watch is not in a power-saving mode (if applicable). Press any button to wake it up.

• Time is incorrect:

- Re-set the time and date according to the "Setting Time and Date" instructions in the Setup section.
- Check if the 12/24 hour format is set correctly.

• Buttons are unresponsive:

- Ensure the watch is dry. Water can interfere with button operation.
- The battery may be low.
- If the issue persists, contact customer support.

· Alarm does not sound:

- Verify that the alarm is set to ON in the Alarm mode.
- Check the alarm time setting.
