INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Lisowod AN1 Mini Projector. Designed for both home theater and outdoor camping, this portable projector features WiFi, Bluetooth, touchscreen controls, and a removable battery, offering a versatile viewing experience.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Initial Power On and Focus Adjustment

Upon receiving your projector, the image may appear blurry. This is normal as the projector is reset to factory settings before shipping. The first step is to adjust the focus for optimal clarity.

- Power on the projector.
- Locate the focus adjustment control (often an electric focus button or ring).
- Adjust until the projected image is sharp and clear.
- **Important:** Remove the protective film from the lens before use to ensure a clear image.

2. Charging the Projector and Battery Base

The projector features a removable battery for enhanced portability. Proper charging ensures optimal battery life.

- For separate battery charging, use a dedicated USB-C fast charger with a power output of 20V or higher.
- If using the projector and battery base simultaneously, connect the DC cable to charge the projector, not the Type-C input.
- Ensure the insulation film on the battery base is removed before charging or use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Screen Mirroring / Wireless Projection

To mirror your mobile phone screen to the projector:

- Ensure both the projector and your mobile phone are connected to **thesame Wi-Fi network**.
- On the projector, select "Wireless Projection" and navigate to the wireless projection guide page. Remain on this page.
- On your mobile device, search for available devices and select the projector to establish a connection.
- **Note:** If your Wi-Fi is set to guest mode, it may interfere with the connection.
- **Troubleshooting Tip:** If mirroring fails, try creating a hotspot using your mobile phone's data plan and connect both the projector and your device to this hotspot.

Important Copyright Information: Due to HDCP copyright protection, certain applications like Netflix and YouTube may not support direct screen mirroring from your smartphone. To view content from these platforms, connect a Fire TV Stick, laptop, or PC to the projector.

2. Bluetooth Functionality (Two-Way)

The AN1 projector supports two-way Bluetooth, allowing it to connect to external speakers or function as a Bluetooth speaker itself.

Connecting to an External Speaker:

1. Go to "Settings" on the projector.
2. Navigate to "Other Settings" and then select "Bluetooth".
3. Press the right button to turn Bluetooth on.
4. Click "[Search BT]" to find available devices.
5. Once your speaker is found, select it. The status will change to "[Connected]" upon successful pairing.

Using the Projector as a Bluetooth Speaker:

1. Long press the Power button for 3 seconds.
2. Choose "Speaker Mode" from the options on the right.
3. Stay on the Bluetooth speaker page.
4. On your mobile phone, open Bluetooth settings, search for available devices, and select "BT6556PJ" to connect.
5. Open your music application on your phone to play audio through the projector.
6. **Tip:** In Speaker Mode, you can select "Green Mode" on the bottom left to turn off the projection light and save power.



3. Audio Settings and Dolby Support

The Lisowod AN1 projector does not support Dolby audio. If you encounter audio issues, please ensure Dolby is turned off on your connected device or change the sound mode to stereo.

4. Optimal Viewing Environment

For the best viewing experience, it is recommended to use the projector in a dark or semi-dark environment. This enhances image clarity and contrast.



MAINTENANCE

Dust-proof Lens and Cleaning

The AN1 projector features a dust-proof lens design to minimize black spots and maintain image quality over time. However, regular cleaning is still recommended.

- Gently wipe the lens with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- For the projector body, use a dry or slightly damp cloth to remove dust and smudges.
- Ensure the projector is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Blurry Image

If the image is blurry, even after initial setup:

- Re-adjust the focus using the electric focus control.
- Check if the protective film on the lens has been fully removed.

2. Screen Cast / Mirroring Issues

If screen mirroring is not working as expected:

- Verify that both the projector and your mobile phone are connected to the **same Wi-Fi network**.

- Ensure you are on the "Wireless Projection Guide" page on the projector when attempting to connect from your device.
- Check if your Wi-Fi network is in "guest mode," which can restrict device communication.
- Remember that HDCP copyright protection prevents direct mirroring of certain apps (e.g., Netflix, YouTube) from smartphones. Use a streaming stick or PC for these.
- Try creating a mobile hotspot and connecting both devices to it as a test.
- If issues persist, contact customer support with your device and system information, and an operation video if possible.

3. Bluetooth Connection Problems

If Bluetooth is not functioning:

- Review the "Bluetooth Functionality (Two-Way)" section in Operating Instructions to ensure all steps are followed correctly.
- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on both the projector and the device you are trying to connect.
- Check if the correct Bluetooth mode (connecting to speaker vs. projector as speaker) is selected.

4. Battery Not Holding Charge

If the portable battery does not hold a charge:

- Confirm you are using the correct USB-C fast charger (20V or higher output).
- If using the projector and battery base together, ensure the DC cable is connected to charge the projector, not the Type-C input.
- Verify that the insulation film on the battery base has been removed.

5. Netflix/Amazon Prime Video Playback Issues

As noted, direct playback from smartphone apps like Netflix or Amazon Prime Video is restricted by HDCP copyright. To watch these services:

- Connect a Fire TV Stick, laptop, or PC to the projector via HDMI.
- Ensure Dolby audio is turned off on your connected device, or change the sound mode to stereo, as the projector does not support Dolby.




