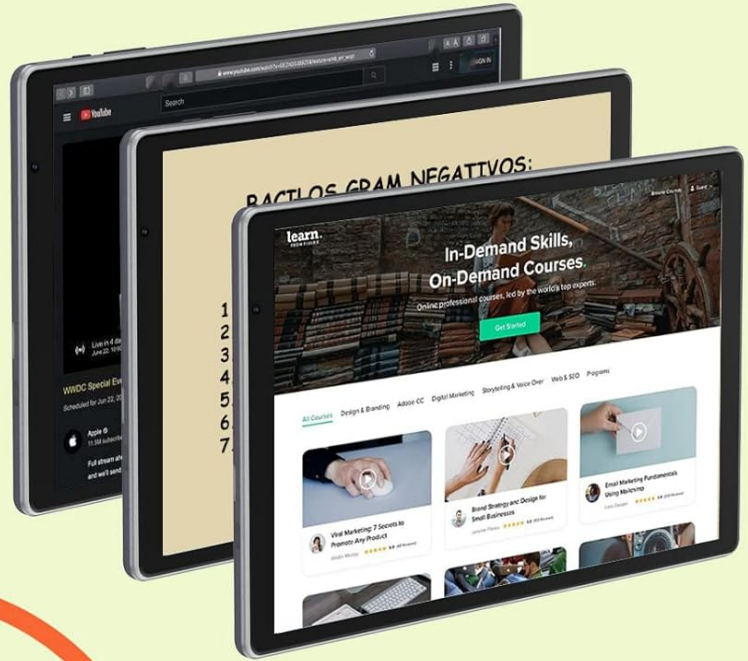
2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

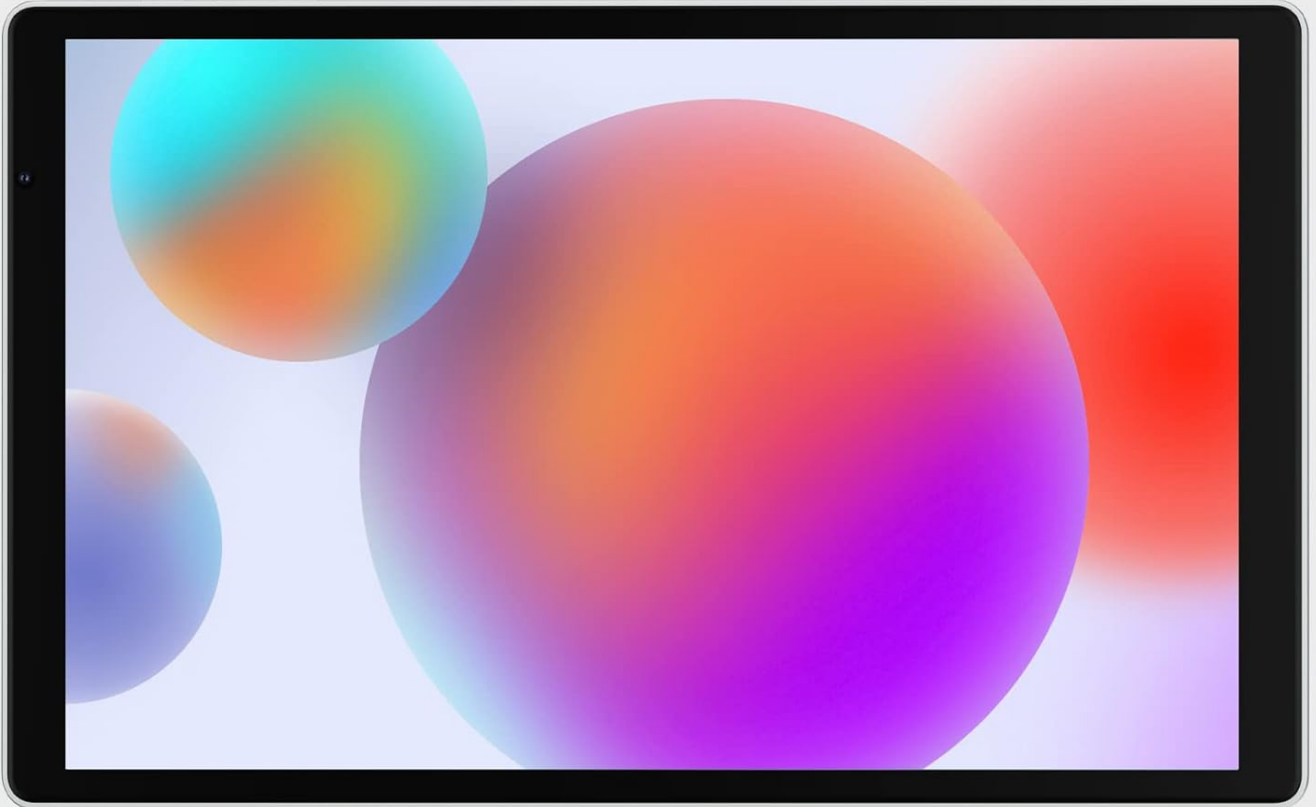

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your PlimPad P3 tablet. Connect the included Type-C charging cable to the tablet's charging port and the other end to a power adapter. A full charge typically takes 2-3 hours. The tablet includes a 6ft (1.8m) charging cable for convenience.

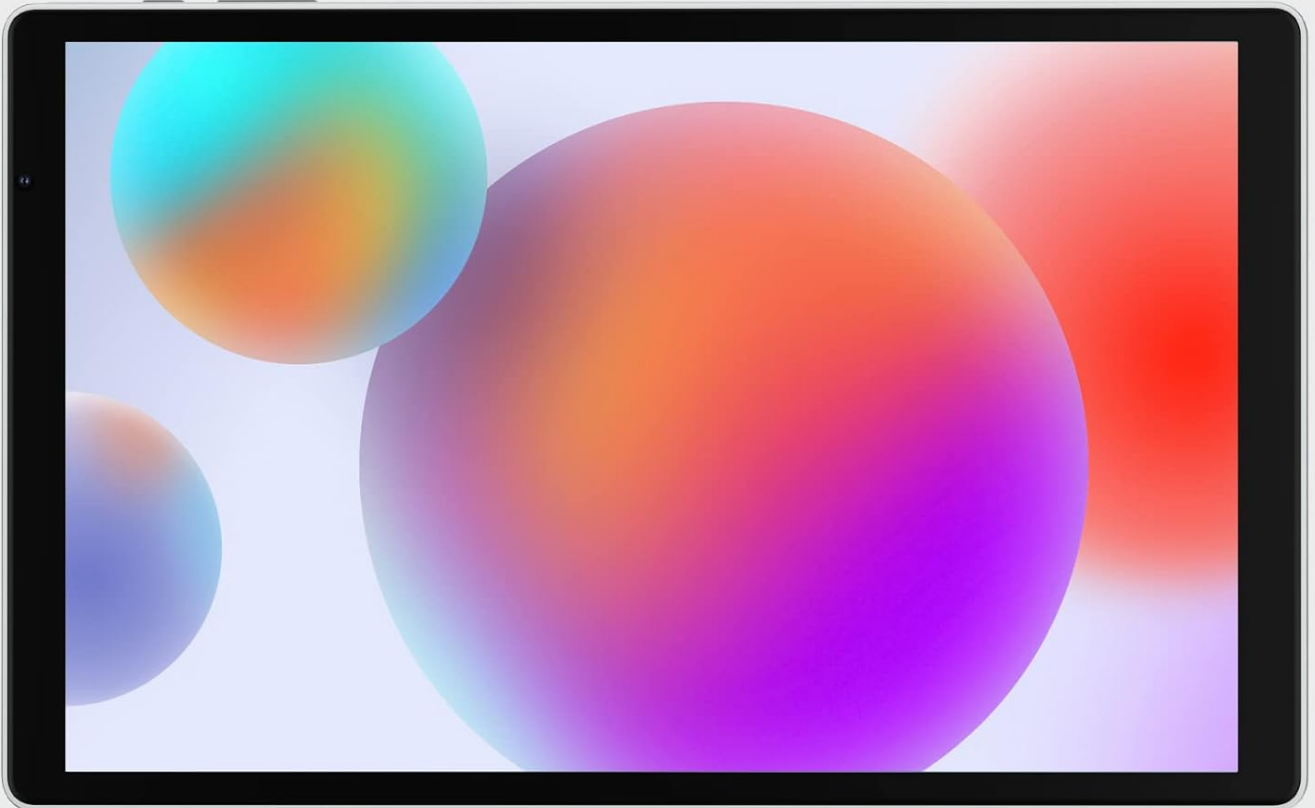


Image: Shows the tablet's 6000mAh battery capacity and the Type-C charging port.

3.2 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the Plimpton logo appears on the screen.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the power button until a menu appears. Select "Power off" and confirm.
- **To Restart:** From the power menu, select "Restart" and confirm.

3.3 Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup:

1. Select your preferred language.
2. Connect to a Wi-Fi network. Ensure your router supports Wi-Fi 6 for optimal performance.
3. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one. This is necessary to download apps from the Google Play Store.
4. Review and accept the terms and conditions.
5. Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, or password) for security.

3.4 Inserting a Micro SD Card

To expand storage, insert a Micro SD card (up to 512GB, not included) into the designated slot. Gently push the card until it clicks into place. The tablet will recognize the card, and you can then use it for storing photos, videos, music, and documents.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Navigation

The PlimPad P3 uses touch gestures for navigation:

- **Tap:** Select an item or open an app.
- **Swipe:** Scroll through screens or lists.
- **Pinch:** Zoom in or out on images and web pages.
- **Long Press:** Access contextual menus or move app icons.

4.2 Wi-Fi Connectivity

To connect to Wi-Fi:

1. Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**.
2. Turn on Wi-Fi.
3. Select your desired network from the list.
4. Enter the password if prompted and tap **Connect**.

4.3 Bluetooth Pairing

To pair with a Bluetooth device:

1. Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**.
2. Turn on Bluetooth.
3. Ensure the other Bluetooth device is in pairing mode.
4. Select the device from the list of available devices and follow any on-screen prompts to complete pairing.

4.4 Camera Usage

The tablet features an 8MP rear camera and a 2MP front camera.

1. Open the **Camera** app.
2. Tap the camera icon to switch between front and rear cameras.
3. Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start/stop video recording.

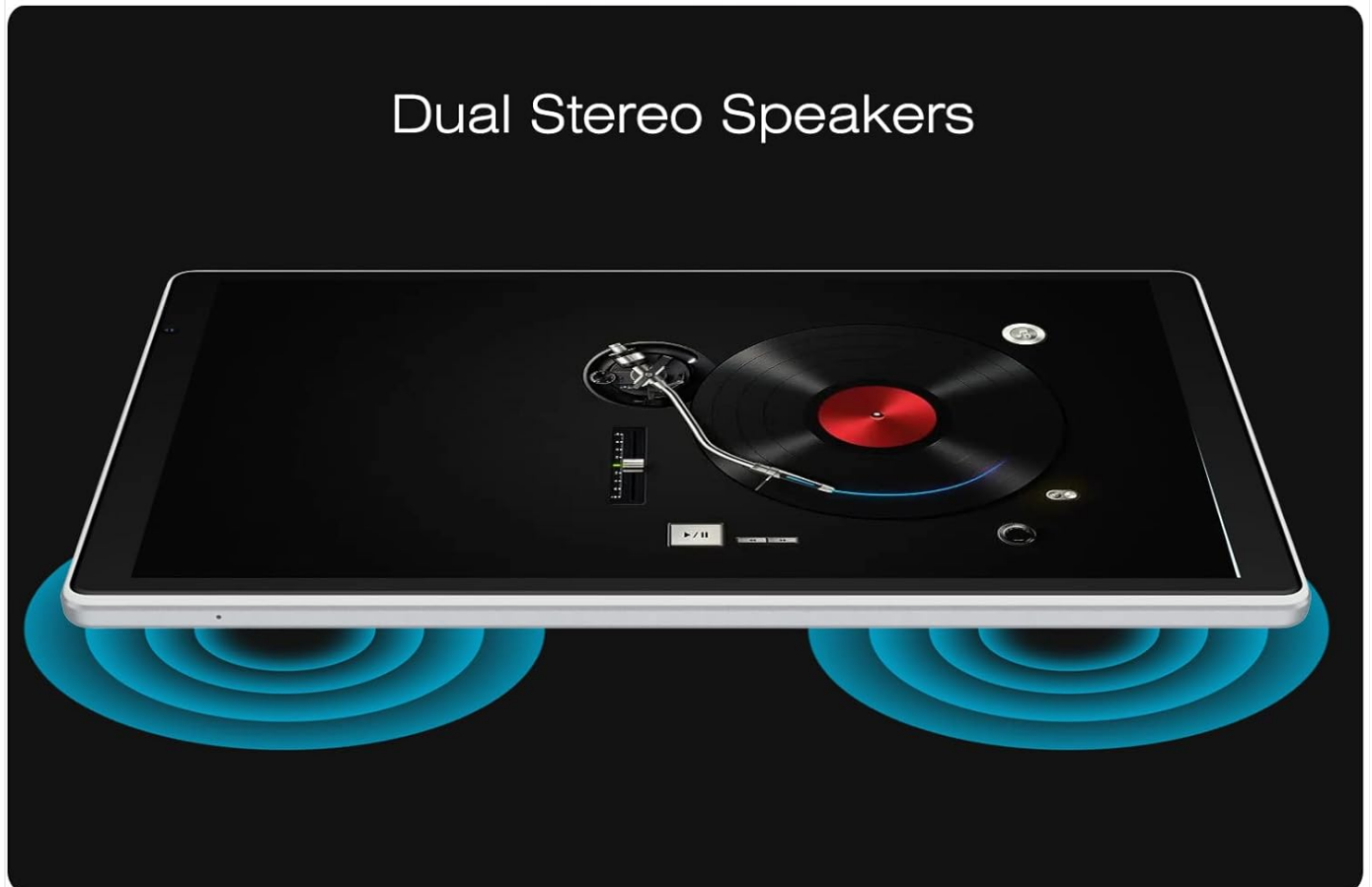


Image: Details of the tablet's 8MP rear camera and its 9mm thickness, along with a visual representation of the dual stereo speakers.

4.5 Managing Storage

To check and manage your tablet's storage:

1. Go to **Settings > Storage**.
2. Here you can see the usage of internal storage and any inserted SD card.
3. You can free up space by uninstalling unused apps, deleting old files, or moving files to the SD card.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Device

To clean your tablet:

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to wipe the screen and body.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner.

- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive moisture.

5.2 Battery Care

To maximize battery life and performance:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not let the battery completely drain frequently.
- Use the original charger and cable provided.
- If storing the tablet for an extended period, charge it to about 50% before turning it off.

5.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features and security patches.

1. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to check for and install any available updates.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Tablet does not turn on:** Connect the tablet to the original charger and charge for 2-3 hours. Most startup issues are due to a low battery.
- **Tablet is slow or unresponsive:** Close unused apps, clear cache, or restart the device. Ensure you have sufficient free storage space.
- **Wi-Fi connection issues:** Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled, restart your router, or forget and reconnect to the network.
- **Apps crashing:** Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache/Clear data), or reinstall the app.
