ASICS Jogger X81 Unisex Adult Shoes User Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

1.1 About the ASICS Jogger X81 Shoes

The ASICS Jogger X81 SHIGEN sneaker is designed with inspiration from various jogging shoes within the ASICS archive. This model incorporates design elements that pay homage to Japan's thorough recycling processes, aiming to maintain a clean environment.

The construction utilizes recycled paper, synthetic leather, and polyester, contributing to resource conservation. The cushioning structure is inspired by the ULTIMATE shoe, featuring an updated design with larger holes on the outside and smaller holes on the inside. This configuration is engineered to provide enhanced cushioning and stability during wear.

Furthermore, the Caldera outsole design is a reference to the unique shapes formed by Hawaiian volcanoes after eruption and collapse. This distinctive outsole pattern was originally developed to help prevent soil accumulation in the tread during off-road running activities.

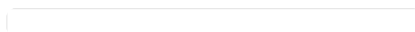


Figure 2: Side view of the ASICS Jogger X81 Shoes, highlighting the ASICS stripes and sole design.

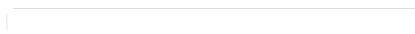


Figure 3: Sole view of the ASICS Jogger X81 Shoes, illustrating the Caldera outsole pattern designed for traction.

2. SETUP AND FIRST USE

2.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the shoes from their packaging. Inspect them for any visible damage or manufacturing defects. Ensure all packaging materials are recycled or disposed of responsibly.

2.2 Lacing and Fit Adjustment

The ASICS Jogger X81 shoes feature a lace-up closure system. Proper lacing is crucial for comfort and support.

- **Initial Lacing:** Ensure the laces are threaded evenly through all eyelets.
- **Adjusting Tension:** Tighten the laces from the toe upwards, ensuring a snug fit across the midfoot without excessive pressure. The heel should feel secure, and your toes should have room to move freely.
- **Knotting:** Tie a secure knot to prevent laces from coming undone during activity.

3. USAGE RECOMMENDATIONS

3.1 Intended Use

The ASICS Jogger X81 shoes are designed for running and general athletic activities. Their construction provides cushioning and stability suitable for various surfaces.

3.2 Optimal Performance

- **Break-in Period:** Allow a short break-in period for the shoes to conform to your feet. Begin with shorter walks or runs before engaging in longer, more intense activities.
- **Sock Choice:** Wear appropriate athletic socks that wick moisture and provide additional cushioning to enhance comfort and prevent blisters.
- **Surface Consideration:** While the Caldera outsole is designed to prevent soil accumulation, these shoes are primarily intended for road running and general fitness.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning Instructions

Regular cleaning helps maintain the appearance and longevity of your ASICS Jogger X81 shoes.

- **Remove Loose Dirt:** Use a soft brush (e.g., an old toothbrush) to gently remove any loose dirt or mud from the outer material and sole.
- **Spot Cleaning:** For stains, use a mild soap solution (e.g., dish soap mixed with water) and a soft cloth or sponge. Gently rub the affected area.
- **Rinsing:** Wipe off any soap residue with a clean, damp cloth. Avoid submerging the shoes in water.
- **Drying:** Allow the shoes to air dry naturally at room temperature. Do not use direct heat sources like radiators or tumble dryers, as this can damage the materials. Stuffing the shoes with paper towels can help absorb moisture and maintain their shape.
- **Laces:** Laces can be removed and hand-washed separately.

4.2 Storage

Store your shoes in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keeping them in their original box or a shoe bag can help protect them from dust and damage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

5.1 Discomfort or Improper Fit

If you experience discomfort or feel the shoes do not fit correctly:

- **Re-adjust Lacing:** Experiment with different lacing techniques to find a fit that is secure but not too tight.
- **Check Sock Thickness:** Thicker or thinner socks can significantly alter the fit.
- **Verify Size:** Refer to the ASICS size guide (Section 7) to ensure you have the correct size for your foot length and width.

5.2 Excessive Wear and Tear

All footwear experiences wear over time. The lifespan of your shoes depends on usage frequency, intensity, and care. If you notice significant wear on the outsole, upper, or a decrease in cushioning, it may be time to consider replacement to maintain optimal performance and support.

The standard (medium) width for women is B, while the standard width for men is D. Shoe boxes and labels will typically indicate widths other than standard. Visible stretching or bulging on the sides of the forefoot material may indicate that additional width is needed. ASICS offers various widths in many of its running and training shoes.
