1. IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS

Please read and understand all instructions before operating the vehicle. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Adult Supervision Required: This product is intended for children aged 3-8 years and must always be operated under direct adult supervision.
- Environmental Conditions: Keep the car and remote control away from water and rain to prevent electrical damage and ensure safe operation.
- Weight Limit: Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 66 lbs (30 kg).
- Safety Belt: Always ensure the child is securely fastened with the safety belt before operation.
- Safe Operating Areas: Operate the vehicle on flat, dry surfaces. Avoid slopes, uneven terrain, public roads, or areas near swimming pools or other bodies of water.
- **Charging:** Only use the provided charger. Do not overcharge the battery. Refer to the 'Charging the Battery' section for detailed instructions.



2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Hetoy 12V Kids Ride On Truck Car is an electric vehicle designed for children aged 3 to 8 years. It features two operational modes, a soft start system for safety, and multimedia functions for an engaging experience.

Key Features:

- **Dual Control Modes:** Operable via child's manual control (pedal and steering wheel) or parental 2.4GHz remote control.
- Safety Features: Equipped with a soft start system to prevent sudden acceleration, anti-slip wear-resistant wheels, spring suspension, and a safety belt.
- **Multimedia Functions:** Includes an MP3 player, AUX input, USB port, and TF card slot for music and stories. Features LED lights and a horn.
- Durable Construction: Made with solid steel and PP materials.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the Hetoy 12V Kids Ride On Truck Car is required before first use. Please follow the detailed step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included in your package. Ensure all screws and fasteners are tightened securely.

Note: Adult assembly is mandatory. Keep small parts away from children during assembly.

5. CHARGING THE BATTERY

The vehicle is powered by a 12V 4.5AH rechargeable battery. Proper charging ensures optimal performance and battery longevity.

- 1. Locate the charging port, typically found in the lower right corner of the steering wheel area.
- 2. Connect the charger to the charging port.
- 3. Plug the charger into a standard wall outlet.
- 4. The charging indicator on the charger will typically show a red light during charging and turn green when fully charged.
- 5. Initial charge time should be 8-12 hours. Subsequent charges should also be within this range. Do not charge for more than 18 hours.
- 6. Disconnect the charger once charging is complete.

Important: Always charge the battery under adult supervision. Do not operate the vehicle while it is charging.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Hetoy Ride On Truck Car offers two modes of operation: manual control by the child and parental remote control.

6.1. Manual Operation Mode (Child Control)

- Ensure the vehicle is turned on using the power button on the dashboard.
- The child can press the foot pedal to accelerate and use the steering wheel to steer.
- Releasing the foot pedal will engage the brakes due to the soft start technology, ensuring a gradual stop.
- Use the forward/reverse switch to select direction.

6.2. Parental Remote Control Mode

The 2.4GHz remote control allows parents to safely guide the vehicle, overriding child controls when necessary.

- Pairing: Refer to the remote control's specific instructions for initial pairing with the vehicle.
- **Controls:** The remote typically includes buttons for forward, reverse, left, right, speed selection (three speeds), and an emergency brake function.
- **Speed Adjustment:** Adjust the speed settings on the remote control to suit the child's skill level and environment.
- Emergency Stop: The remote control's brake button can be used to stop the vehicle immediately.

6.3. Multimedia Functions

- Horn: Press the horn button on the steering wheel for sound effects.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your Hetoy Ride On Truck Car.

• **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.

- **Battery Care:** Recharge the battery after each use. If storing the vehicle for an extended period, charge the battery fully every 30 days to prevent deep discharge.
- Storage: Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws, nuts, and moving parts for tightness and wear. Replace worn parts as needed.
- Wheel Maintenance: Ensure wheels are free of debris and rotate smoothly.

8. Troubleshooting

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Hetoy Ride On Truck Car.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery is low or not connected; Power switch is off; Loose wire connection; Overload.	Charge the battery; Turn on the power switch; Check all wire connections; Reduce load (weight).
Short run time	Battery not fully charged; Old battery; Overload.	Charge battery for 8-12 hours; Replace battery if old; Reduce load.
Remote control not working	Remote batteries are dead; Remote not paired.	Replace remote control batteries; Re-pair the remote control with the vehicle (refer to remote manual).
Vehicle moves slowly	Low battery; Overload; Operating on rough terrain.	Charge the battery; Reduce load; Operate on flat surfaces.
