1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Lenovo ThinkPad T14s 14-inch laptop. Designed for productivity and portability, this device features an Intel Core i7-10610U processor, 16GB RAM, a 512GB SSD, and a Full HD (1920x1080) touch display running Windows 11 Pro.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove your Lenovo ThinkPad T14s laptop and its accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components are present and undamaged. The package includes the laptop and a 65W USB-C Adapter.

2.2 Connecting Power

3.2 Keyboard and TrackPoint

The integrated TrackPoint, located in the center of the keyboard, provides precise cursor control without needing to move your hands from the keyboard. The touchpad below the keyboard also supports multi-touch gestures.

3.3 Fingerprint Sensor

For enhanced security and quick login, utilize the integrated fingerprint sensor. Register your fingerprints through Windows Hello settings.

3.4 Ports and Connectivity

Your ThinkPad T14s offers various ports for connecting peripherals and external displays:

- **USB-C Ports:** Two USB-C ports for charging, data transfer, and video output.
- **USB 3.0 Ports:** One USB 3.0 port for high-speed data transfer.
- **USB 2.0 Ports:** One USB 2.0 port for connecting standard USB devices.
- **HDMI Port:** For connecting to external monitors or projectors.
- **Ethernet Port:** For wired network connections.
- **SD Card Slot:** For expanding storage or transferring files from memory cards.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.2 Software Updates

Keep your Windows 11 Pro operating system and drivers updated to ensure optimal performance and security. Check for updates regularly through Windows Settings.

4.3 Battery Care

To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures and fully discharging the battery frequently. For long-term storage, charge the battery to about 50% and store the laptop in a cool, dry place.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your laptop, consider the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the laptop and a working power outlet. Try a different outlet if necessary.
- **Screen Issues:** If the screen flickers or goes black, try restarting the laptop. Ensure display drivers are up to date. If connected to an external monitor, check the cable connection.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications, check for malware, and ensure your SSD has sufficient free space. Regular software updates can also improve performance.
- **Connectivity Problems:** For Wi-Fi issues, restart your router and the laptop. For wired connections, check the Ethernet cable.
