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INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Hoteche 12-Inch Circular Saw. Please read all instructions carefully before operating the tool. Proper understanding and adherence to these guidelines will ensure optimal performance and user safety.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE)** including safety glasses, hearing protection, and gloves.
- **Ensure the work area is clean and well-lit.** Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.
- **Do not operate power tools in explosive atmospheres,** such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases, or dust.
- **Keep children and bystanders away** while operating a power tool. Distractions can cause you to lose control.
- **Avoid accidental starting.** Ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting to power, picking up or carrying the tool.
- **Maintain a firm grip** on the tool with both hands during operation.
- **Always unplug the saw** before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing the tool.
- **Never bypass safety guards.** Ensure all guards are in place and functioning correctly.
- **Use the correct blade for the material** being cut.
- **When using as a desktop saw, ensure it is securely mounted** and stable to prevent movement during operation.

COMPONENTS AND PARTS IDENTIFICATION

Familiarize yourself with the various parts of your circular saw for safe and efficient operation.

SETUP

Unpacking and Initial Inspection

Carefully remove the saw and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect for any damage that may have occurred during shipping. Ensure all included components are present: 1 Pair of Carbon Brush, 1 Pc of 40T Saw Blade, 1 Pc of Hex Wrench.

Saw Blade Installation

Follow these steps to safely install or replace the saw blade:

1. **Adjust the baseplate to the lowest cutting depth.** This provides maximum clearance for blade access.
2. **Push the spindle lock button towards the motor housing and hold it firmly.** This locks the spindle to prevent rotation while changing the blade.
3. **Use the hex wrench to loosen and remove the blade clamp bolt.** Remove the outer flange and the old saw blade (if replacing).
4. **Install the new saw blade, ensuring the teeth are oriented correctly** for cutting (usually indicated by an arrow on the blade matching the rotation direction on the saw). Reinstall the outer flange and tighten the

blade clamp bolt securely with the hex wrench.

5. **Make sure that the saw blade runs freely** by turning the blade by hand after releasing the spindle lock.

CHANGE THE SAW BLADE



Adjust the baseplate to the lowest cutting depth



Push the spindle lock button towards the motor housing and hold it firmly



Reinstall the saw blade, and tighten the blade clamp bolt

Adjustments

- **Depth Adjustment:** Use the lock lever for depth adjustment to set the desired cutting depth. Ensure the blade extends just enough to clear the workpiece.
- **Bevel Angle Adjustment:** Loosen the lock knob for angle adjustment to tilt the baseplate for bevel cuts (0-45 degrees). Tighten the knob firmly once the desired angle is set.
- **Parallel Guide:** The saw includes a lock knob for a parallel guide, allowing for straight cuts parallel to the edge of the workpiece. Attach and adjust the guide as needed.

OPERATION

Basic Operation

- **Power On/Off:** The saw is equipped with an ON/OFF switch. Press to start and release to stop.
- **Lock-on Button:** For extended use, press the ON/OFF switch and then engage the lock-on button to keep the saw running without continuously holding the trigger. To disengage, press the ON/OFF switch again.

Cutting Techniques

This circular saw is versatile and can be used for both handheld and desktop applications.

INDUSTRIAL

- **Handheld Use:** Ensure a firm grip on both the main and auxiliary handles. Guide the saw smoothly through the material, allowing the blade to do the work. Do not force the saw.
- **Desktop Use (Inverted):** The saw can be inverted and mounted to a stable surface to function as a table saw. This is ideal for repetitive cuts or when greater stability is required. *Note: For safety, ensure the saw is securely mounted and the work area is clear.*

Cutting Various Materials

The Hoteche 12-Inch Circular Saw is suitable for cutting various materials, including composite board, wood, and PVC, when equipped with the appropriate blade.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your circular saw.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, unplug the saw and clean dust and debris from the tool, especially around the motor vents and blade area. Use a soft brush or compressed air.
- **Blade Care:** Keep saw blades sharp and clean. Replace dull or damaged blades promptly to prevent kickback and ensure efficient cutting. Refer to the "Saw Blade Installation" section for replacement instructions.
- **Carbon Brush Replacement:** The saw includes a pair of carbon brushes. These wear down over time and should be replaced when significantly reduced in size. Consult a qualified technician if you are unsure how to replace them.
- **Cord Inspection:** Regularly inspect the power cord for any signs of damage. Do not use the saw if the cord is frayed or cut.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Hoteche Circular Saw, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Saw does not start	No power supply; Faulty switch; Worn carbon brushes	Check power connection; Test switch; Replace carbon brushes
Blade not cutting efficiently	Dull or incorrect blade; Improper cutting depth	Replace or sharpen blade; Adjust cutting depth
Excessive vibration or noise	Loose blade; Damaged blade; Motor issue	Tighten blade clamp bolt; Replace blade; Contact support
Saw stalls during cut	Overloading; Dull blade; Incorrect feed rate	Reduce load; Replace blade; Adjust feed rate
