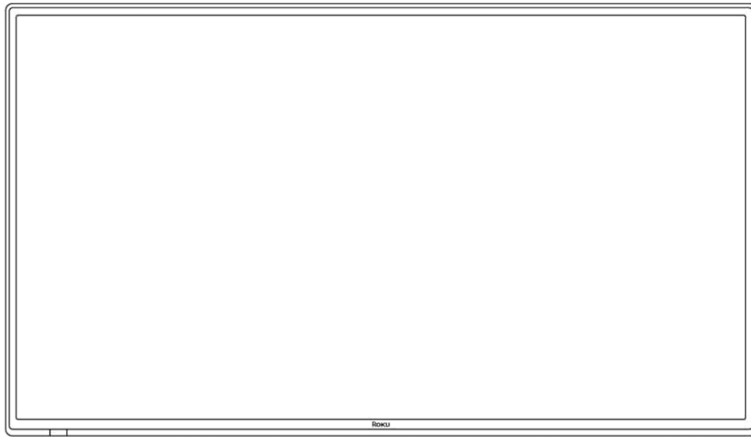
Figure 1: Roku 40-Inch Select Series Smart TV and its retail packaging.

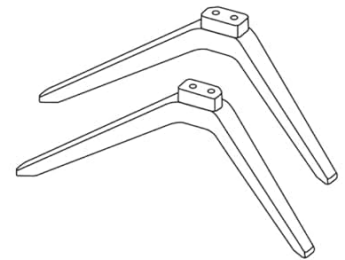

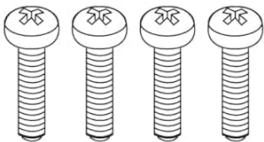

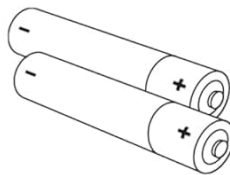

SETUP

1. Physical Setup

Choose between placing the TV on a stand or wall-mounting it. Ensure proper ventilation around the TV.

1. **Stand Installation:** Attach the provided stands to the bottom of the TV using the included screws. Ensure they are securely fastened.
2. **Wall Mounting:** If wall-mounting, use a VESA-compatible wall mount (not included) and follow the mount manufacturer's instructions.

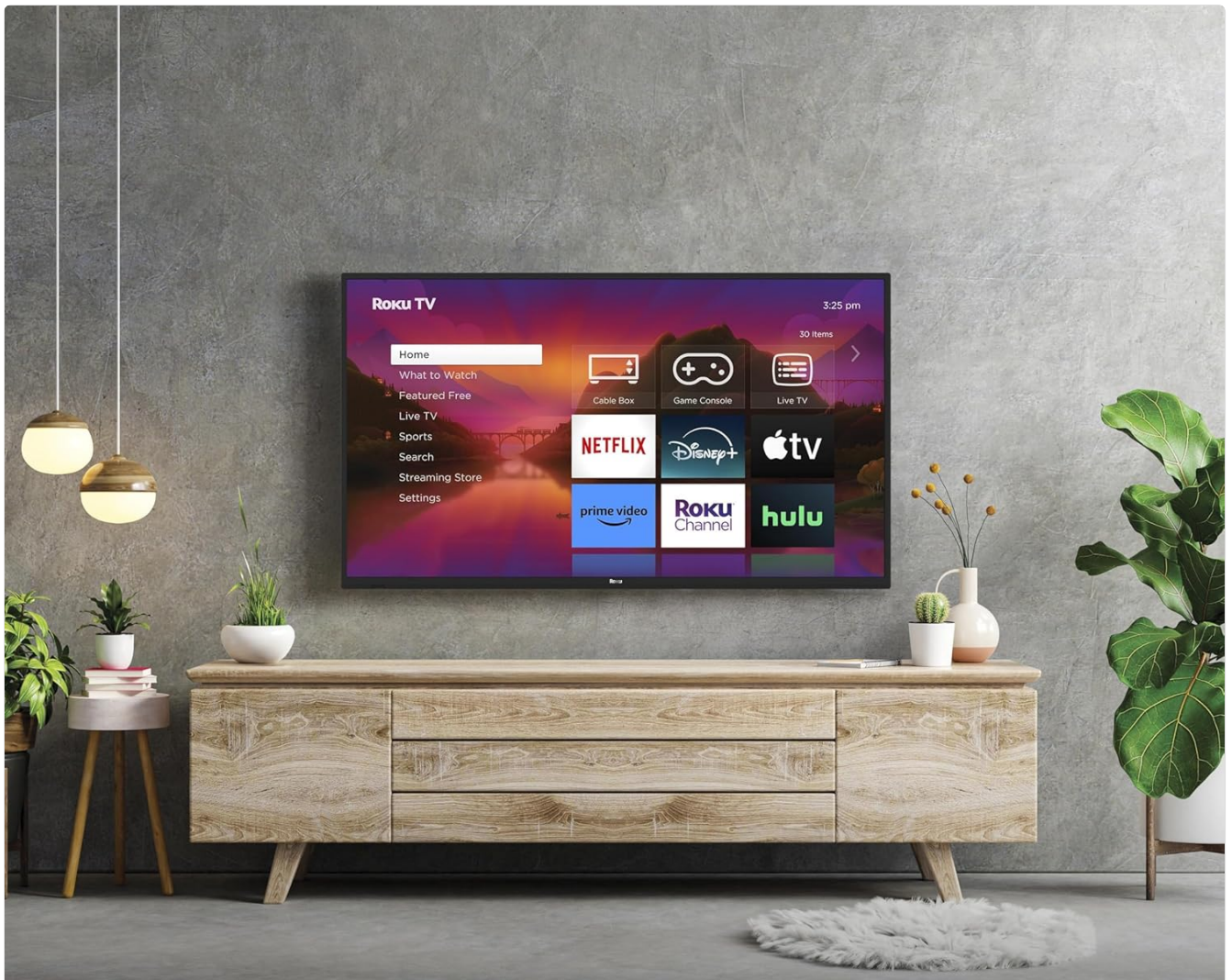
2. Initial Power On and Network Connection

1. Connect the power cord to the TV and a power outlet.
2. Insert the included AAA batteries into the Roku Voice Remote.
3. Press the power button on the remote to turn on the TV.
4. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language and connect to your Wi-Fi network.
5. Activate your Roku account or create a new one if prompted.

OPERATING YOUR TV

Home Screen Navigation

The Roku Home Screen provides quick access to your favorite streaming apps, inputs, and free live TV. Use the directional pad on your remote to navigate through options.

Streaming Apps and Content

Access thousands of streaming channels and content directly from your TV. Popular apps like Netflix, Hulu, Disney+, and Prime Video are readily available. You can also explore free live TV options.

Using the Voice Remote

The Roku Voice Remote simplifies content discovery and control. Press the microphone button to use voice commands for searching, playing content, and controlling your TV.

Connecting External Devices (Inputs)

The TV features multiple input ports for connecting external devices such as gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, and cable boxes.

- **HDMI Ports:** Connect devices using HDMI cables. HDMI 1 supports ARC (Audio Return Channel) for simplified audio connections to soundbars or AV receivers.
- **USB Port:** For media playback from USB drives.
- **Antenna/Cable Input:** For connecting an antenna for over-the-air broadcasts or a cable TV connection.

Turn your TV into a digital gallery with Backdrops. Browse famous artists and photographers or upload your personal photos.

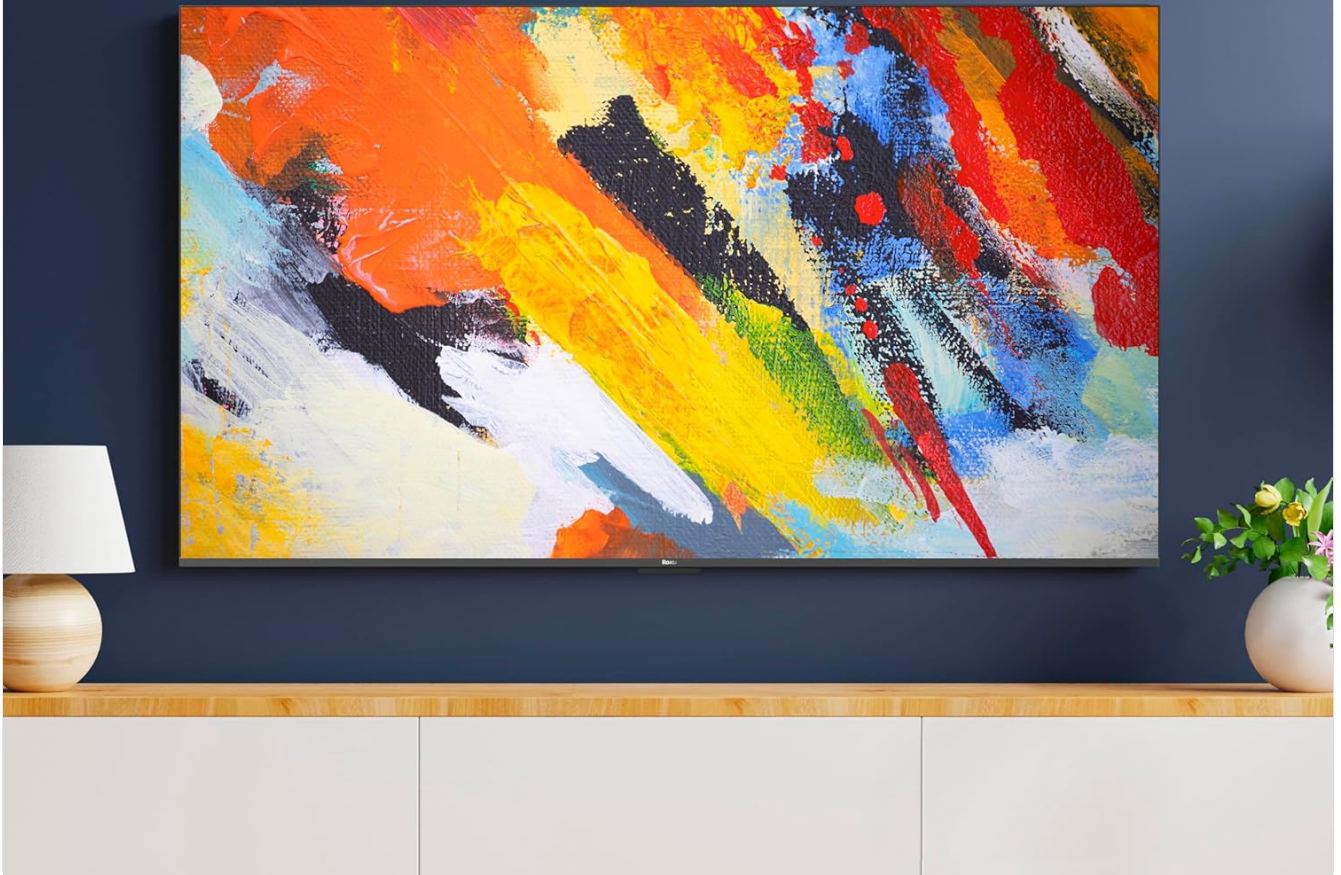


Figure 5: Rear view of the Roku TV showing connectivity options including HDMI, USB, and Reset button.

Picture and Sound Settings

- **Sound Modes:** Select sound modes (e.g., Standard, Speech, Night) or adjust bass and treble. The TV is designed for clear speech and louder sound.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your TV

To maintain the clarity and longevity of your TV screen, follow these cleaning guidelines:

- Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the screen and frame.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen-specific cleaning solution. Never spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.

Software Updates

Your Roku TV automatically receives software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet for these updates to occur. You can check for updates manually in the Settings menu under System > Software Update.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Roku TV, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, etc.) for looseness.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the remote batteries. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your Wi-Fi router. Go to Settings > Network > Check connection on your TV to diagnose.
- **App Crashing/Freezing:** Restart the app. If the issue persists, try restarting the TV (Settings > System > Power > System restart).
- **Poor Picture Quality:** Adjust picture settings (Settings > TV picture settings). Ensure your content source is high quality.




