## 1. INTRODUCTION TO THE SUONA

The Suona is a traditional Chinese double-reed woodwind instrument, known for its distinctive loud and penetrating sound. ## 2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

---

Your YCXYQ Suona package includes all necessary components for assembly and playing. Please verify that all items listed below are present:

- 1 x Suona Pole (main body of the instrument)
- 1 x Suona Bowl (bell-shaped end)
- 1 x Copper Core (connects the reed to the pole)
- 3 x Plastic Whistles (reeds)
- 3 x Reed Whistles (reeds)
- 1 x Whistle Box (for storing reeds)
- 1 x Pole Bag (for carrying the instrument)
- 1 x Piece of Clean Cotton (for maintenance)
- 1 x Fingering Chart (located on the last page of the textbook)
- 1 x Textbook
- 1 x Air Plate

### 3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Follow these steps to properly assemble your Suona instrument:

1. **Prepare Materials:** Lay out all the components on a clean, flat surface.
2. **Fix the Copper Core:** Gently insert and fix the copper core onto the top end of the Suona pole.
3. **Attach the Suona Bowl:** Pass the pole through the center of the Suona bowl and secure it firmly at the bottom of the pole.
4. **Fix the Air Plate:** Place the air plate onto the copper core.
5. **Insert the Whistle (Reed):** Carefully put your chosen whistle (reed) onto the top of the copper core. Ensure it is seated securely.
6. **Ready to Play:** Your Suona is now assembled and ready for use.

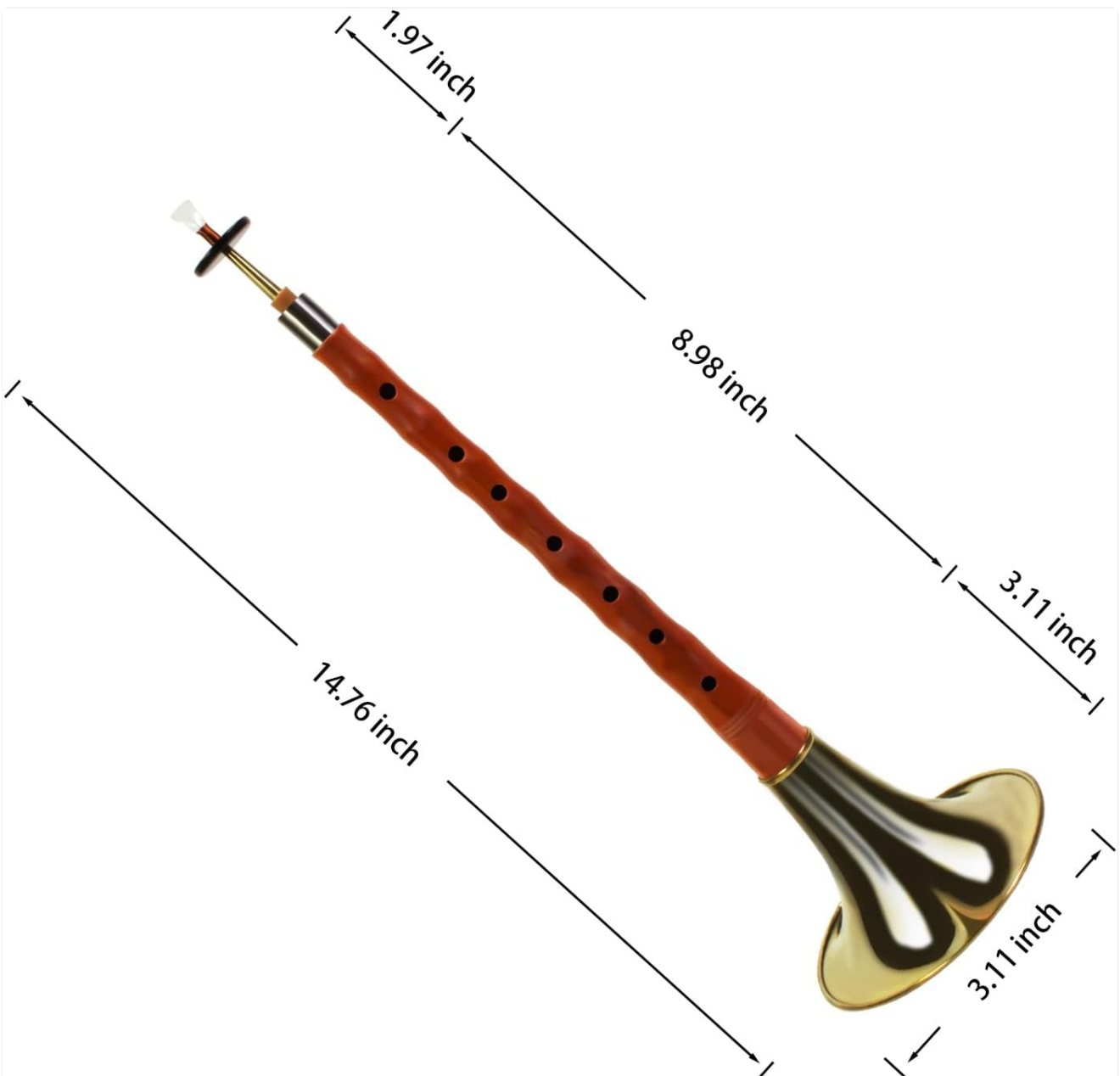


Image: A six-panel visual guide demonstrating the assembly process of the Suona, from preparing components to attaching the reed.

## 4. OPERATING AND PLAYING INSTRUCTIONS

Playing the Suona requires practice and proper technique. Here are some basic guidelines:

- **Holding the Instrument:** Hold the Suona vertically with both hands. Your left hand typically covers the upper holes, and your right hand covers the lower holes. Refer to the diagram below for hand placement and hole identification.
- **Embouchure:** Place the reed gently between your lips. The sound is produced by vibrating the double reed. Experiment with lip pressure and airflow to find the optimal sound.
- **Fingering:** Use the provided fingering chart in the textbook to learn how to produce different notes by covering and uncovering the finger holes.
- **Breathing:** Proper breath support is crucial for sustained notes and dynamic control.

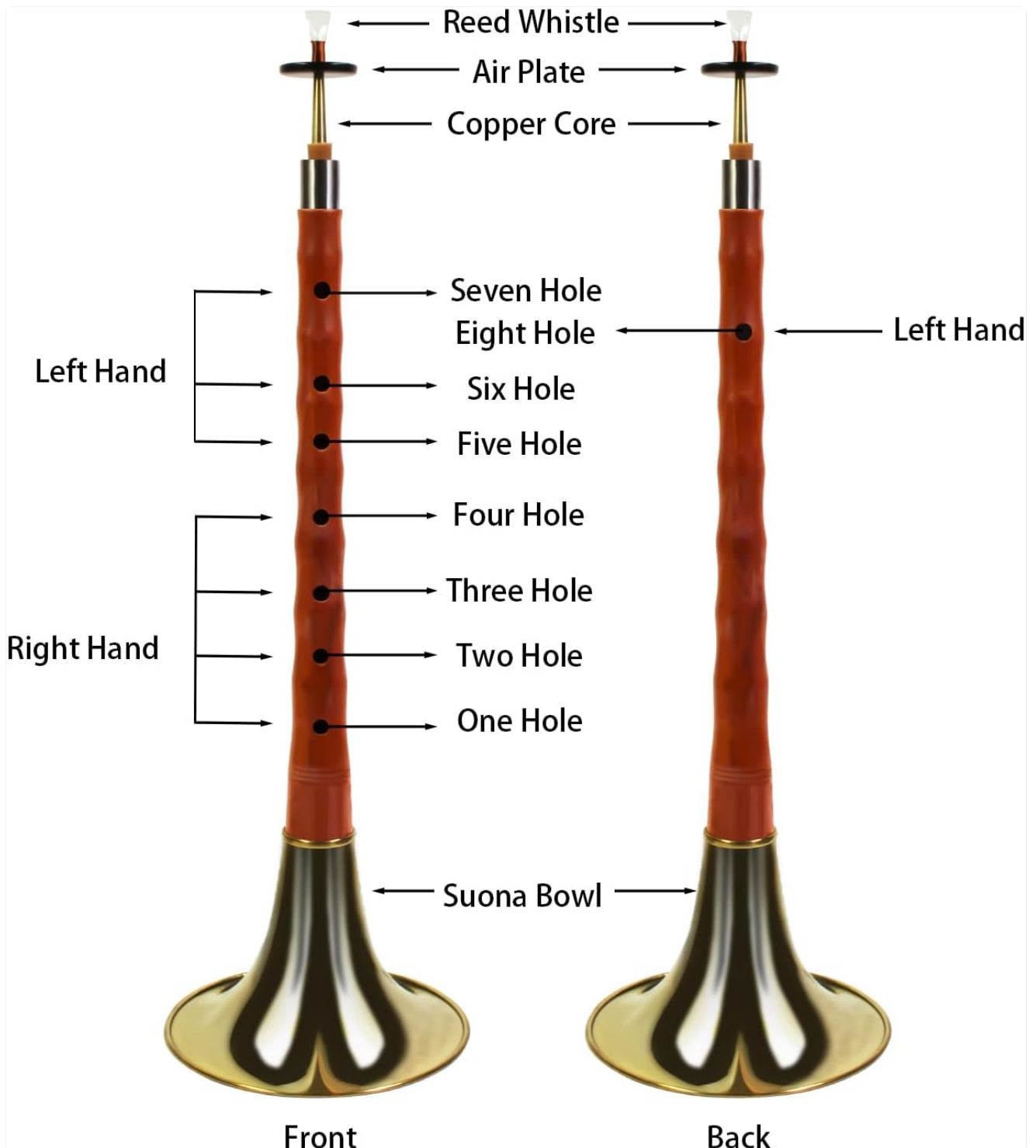
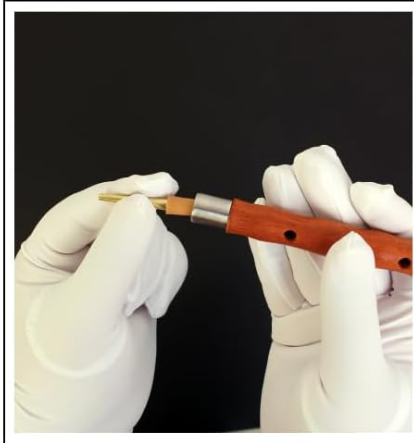

# Installation Steps



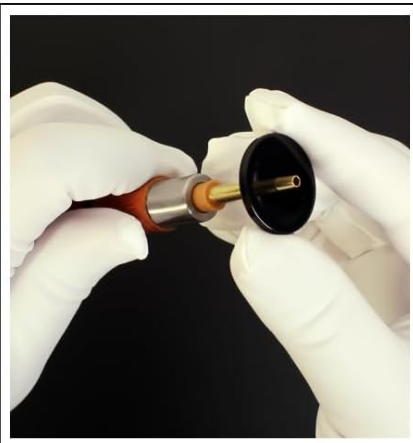
1: First, prepare the required materials.



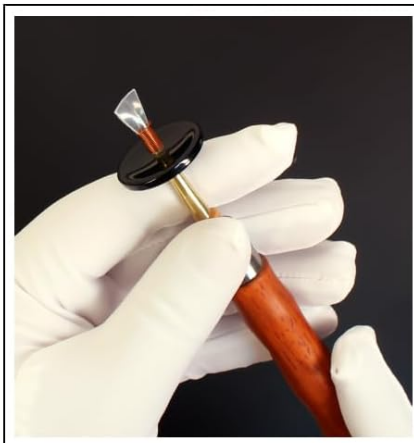
2: Then, fix the copper core on the pole.



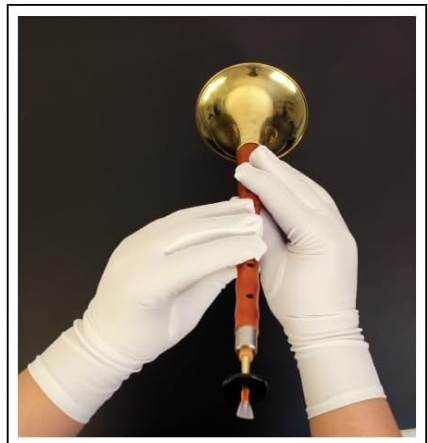
3: Then, pass the pole from the center of the bowl and fix it at the bottom of the pole.



4: Then fix the air plate on the core.



5: Finally, put the whistle on the top of the core.



6: OK, let's play now!

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Suona:

- **Cleaning:** After each use, gently wipe the inside of the instrument with the provided clean cotton to remove moisture. This prevents mold growth and protects the wood.
- **Reed Care:** Store reeds in the whistle box to protect them from damage and humidity changes. If a reed becomes too wet or dry, it may affect the sound.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the Suona in its pole bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperature fluctuations.
- **Handling:** Always handle the instrument with care, avoiding drops or impacts that could damage the wood or metal components.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Suona, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or weak sound	Improper reed placement, damaged reed, incorrect embouchure, air leakage.	Ensure the reed is securely and correctly attached to the copper core. Try a different reed. Adjust your lip pressure and airflow. Check for any gaps in assembly.
Difficulty assembling the instrument	Components not aligned, force applied incorrectly.	Review the "Setup and Installation" section carefully. Ensure components are aligned before gently pushing them together. Do not force parts if they don't fit.
Notes sound off-key	Incorrect fingering, embouchure issues, reed condition.	Consult the fingering chart. Practice embouchure control. Check if the reed is damaged or needs to be replaced.
