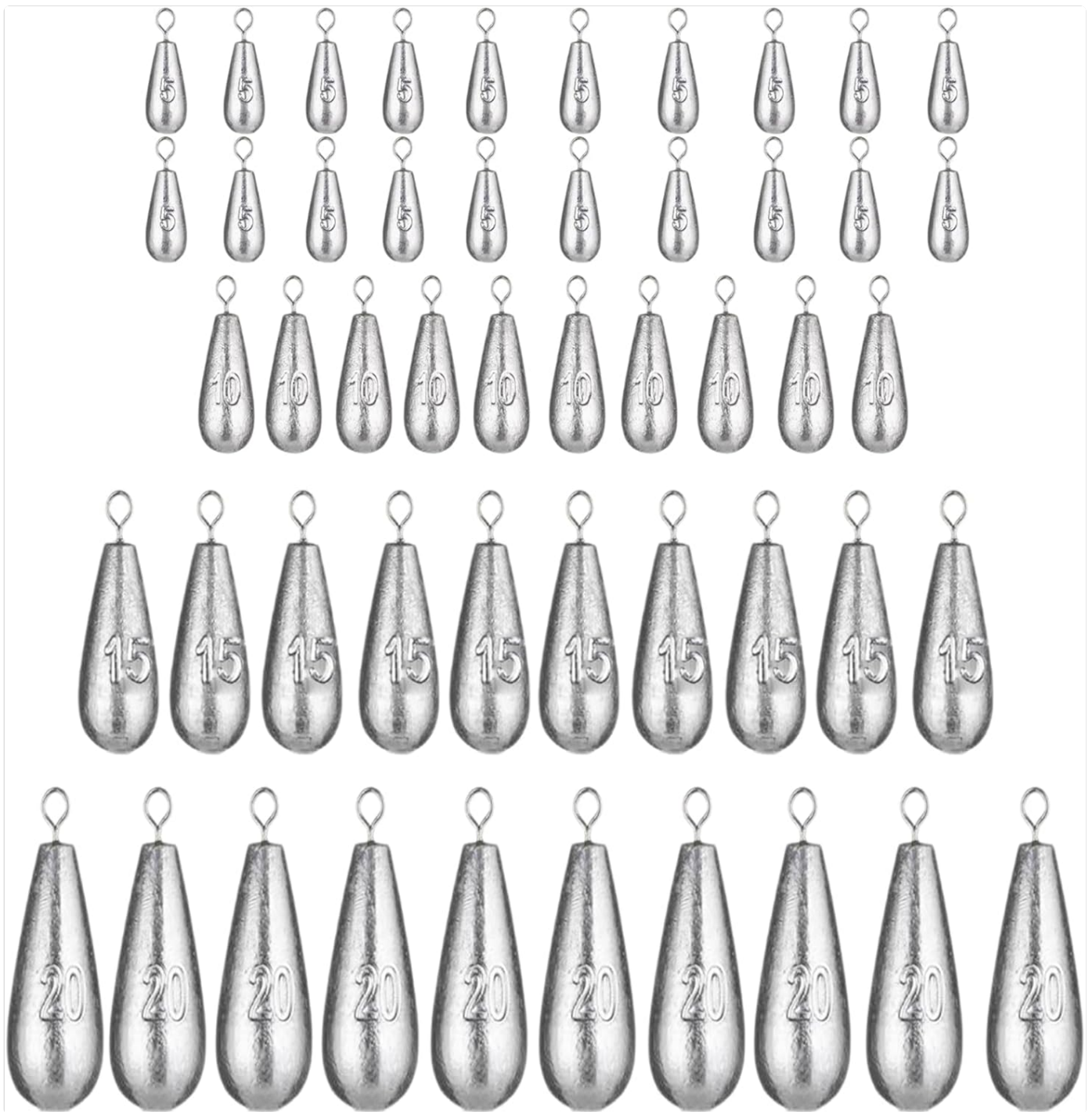


Image: Overview of the 50-piece fishing sinker set, showing different weights.

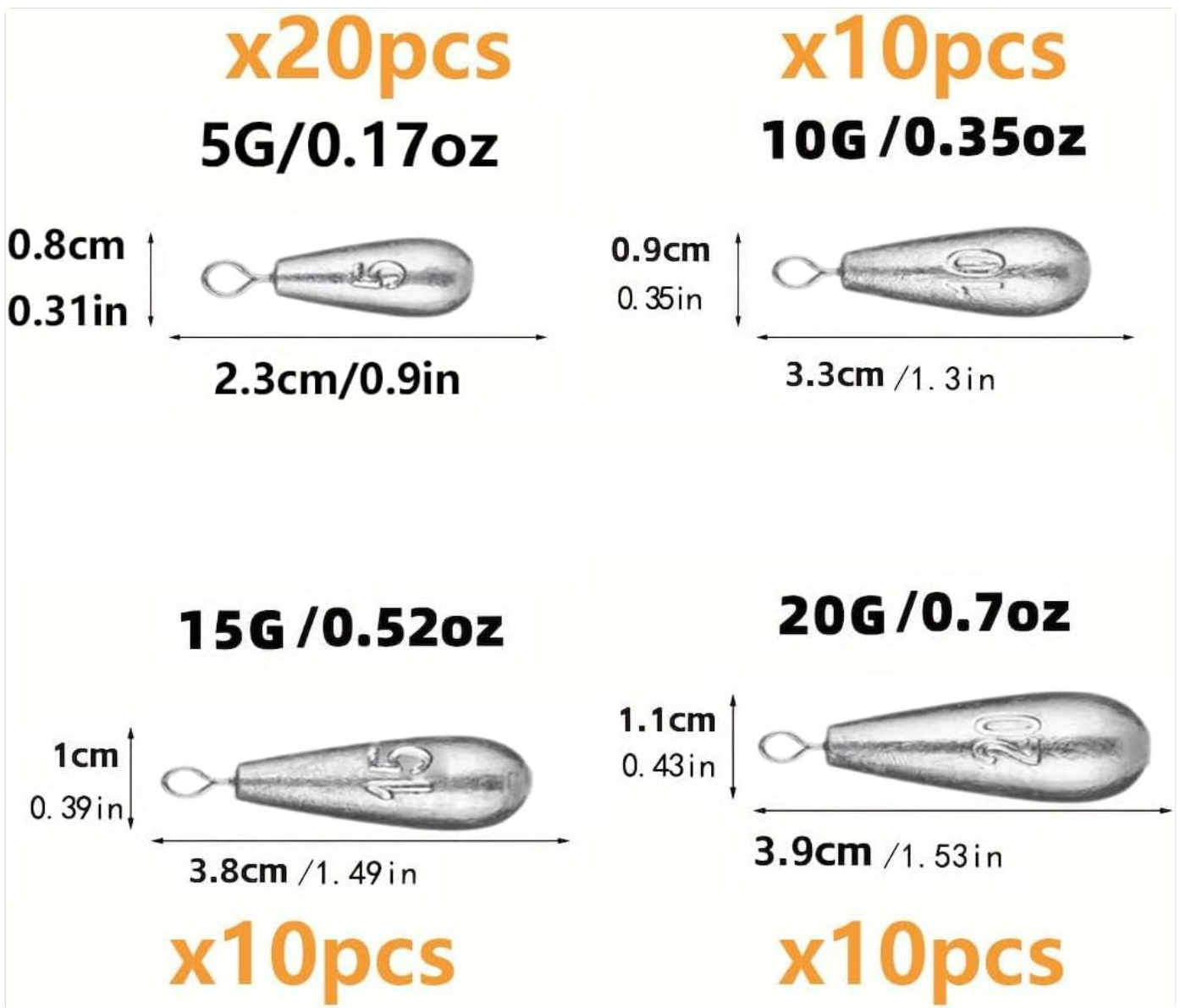


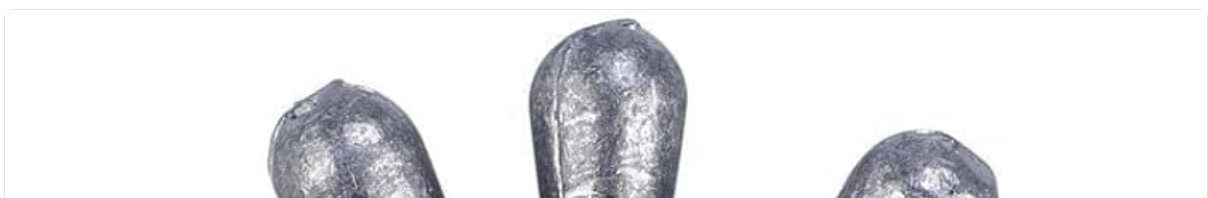
Image: Detailed dimensions for each sinker weight (5g, 10g, 15g, 20g).

### 3. SETUP

Attaching the pear-shaped sinker to your fishing line is a straightforward process. The integrated eyelet allows for quick and secure rigging.

#### Steps for Attachment:

1. **Select the appropriate weight:** Choose a sinker weight (5g, 10g, 15g, or 20g) based on your fishing conditions, target species, and desired casting distance.
2. **Thread the line:** Pass your fishing line through the eyelet at the top of the pear-shaped sinker.
3. **Tie a secure knot:** Use a reliable fishing knot, such as a Palomar knot or an improved clinch knot, to firmly secure the sinker to your line. Ensure the knot is tight and properly seated.
4. **Trim excess line:** Carefully trim any excess tag end of the line, leaving a small amount to prevent the knot from unraveling.



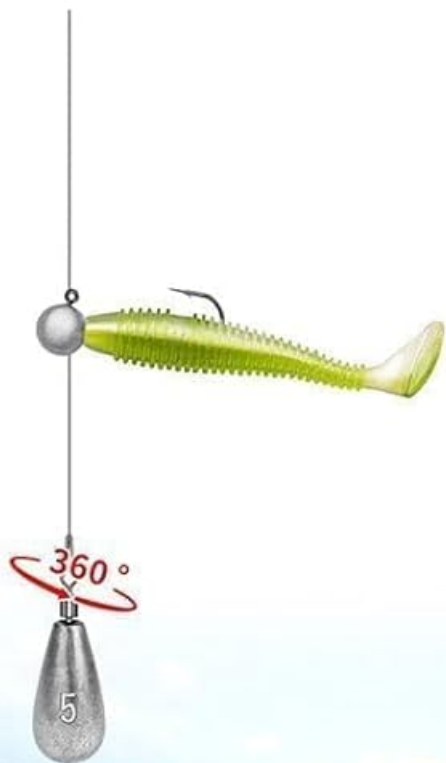
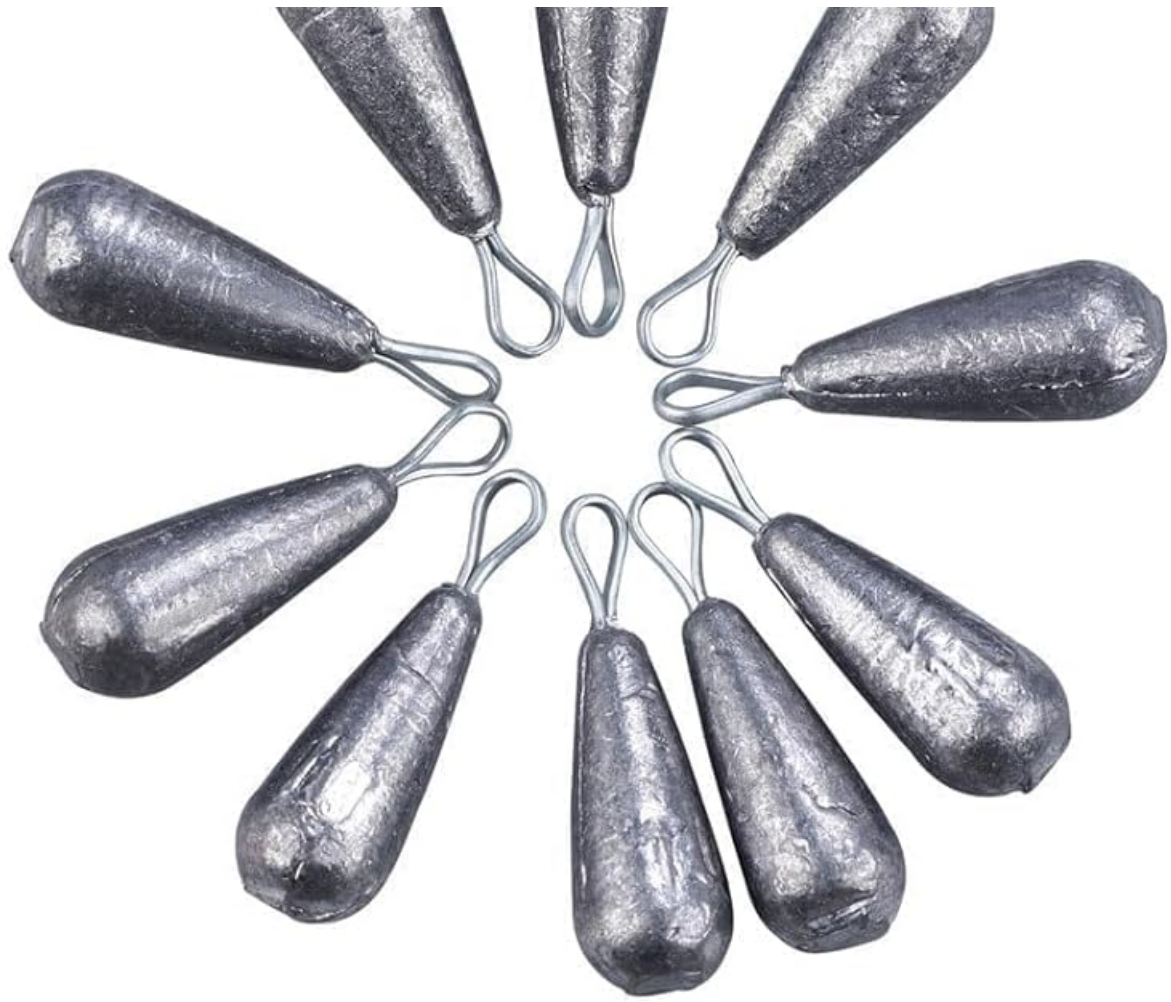




Image: Example of a sinker properly attached to a fishing line with a lure.

## 4. OPERATING GUIDELINES

These pear-shaped sinkers are versatile and suitable for a wide range of fishing applications. Their design ensures quick descent and minimizes snags.

### Choosing the Right Weight:

- **5g Sinkers:** Ideal for light tackle, shallow water, or when a subtle presentation is required. Suitable for small fish or calm conditions.
- **10g Sinkers:** A good all-around weight for general fishing, suitable for moderate currents or slightly deeper waters.
- **15g Sinkers:** Recommended for deeper water, stronger currents, or when targeting larger fish that require a faster sink rate.
- **20g Sinkers:** Best for deep-sea fishing, strong tidal currents, or when you need to get your bait down quickly in challenging conditions.

### Application Scenarios:

These sinkers are perfect for various fishing environments, including:

- Ocean boat fishing
- Sea rock fishing
- Sea beach fishing
- Lakes, rivers, reservoirs, ponds, and streams

- **Store properly:** Store the sinkers in a dry, cool place, preferably in a tackle box or container that prevents them from rubbing against other items, which could scratch their smooth surface.
- **Inspect regularly:** Periodically check the eyelets for any signs of wear or damage. While made from durable lead, proper care ensures longevity.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

While Tintoke fishing sinkers are designed for reliability, here are some common issues and their solutions:

### Common Issues:

- **Sinker getting snagged:** The smooth, teardrop shape is designed to reduce snags. If snags occur frequently, try using a lighter weight sinker or fishing in areas with less underwater debris.
- **Line damage at the eyelet:** Although the eyelet is smooth, continuous friction with the fishing line can cause wear over time. Ensure your knot is tight and consider using a leader line with a higher abrasion resistance if fishing in rough conditions.
- **Sinker not sinking fast enough:** This indicates the chosen weight is too light for the current or depth. Switch to a heavier sinker (e.g., from 5g to 10g or 15g) to achieve the desired sink rate.
