Introduction

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your Oklar Wrist Blood Pressure Monitor. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure accurate measurements and safe operation. This device is intended for home use by adults to measure systolic and diastolic blood pressure and pulse rate.

Setup

1. Battery Installation

The Oklar Blood Pressure Monitor requires two AAA batteries for operation. Locate the battery compartment on the device, typically on the underside or side. Insert the batteries according to the polarity indicators (+/-) inside the compartment. Close the battery cover securely.

2. Wearing the Monitor

Proper placement of the wrist cuff is crucial for accurate readings. The adjustable cuff fits wrists from 4.9 inches to 8.5 inches. Ensure the monitor is worn on your wrist with the display facing upwards. The device should be positioned at the same level as your heart during measurement. This typically means resting your arm on a table or supporting it with your other hand.

Operating Instructions

1. Taking a Measurement

To begin a measurement, simply press the "Start/Stop" button. The device will automatically inflate the cuff and begin the measurement process. Remain still and silent during the measurement for optimal accuracy. The results will be displayed on the LED screen and announced via voice guidance.

2. Voice Guidance and Volume Control

The monitor features friendly voice guidance that announces measurement results, making it suitable for users with visual impairments. You can turn the voice function ON/OFF or choose from 3 volume levels by pressing the dedicated voice button on the device.

3. Dual-User Mode and Memory

The device supports two user profiles, allowing each user to store up to 120 measurement records separately. This feature facilitates easy tracking of individual blood pressure trends over time.




Image: A visual representation of the dual-user mode, displaying distinct memory logs for two different users.

4. Viewing Past Readings

You can quickly view stored measurement records by rotating the knob. Rotate the knob clockwise to see the latest records first, or counterclockwise to view from oldest to newest. This allows for convenient review of your historical data.

Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and accuracy of your Oklar Blood Pressure Monitor, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the device and cuff with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the device in water.
- **Storage:** Store the monitor in its portable storage bag in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- Battery Replacement: Replace batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the display. Remove batteries if the device will not be used for an extended period.
- **Avoid Damage:** Do not drop the device or subject it to strong impacts. Avoid bending or twisting the cuff excessively.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your blood pressure monitor, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
"Er" Error Message	Movement during measurement, improper cuff placement, or arm not at heart level.	Remain still and silent. Re-adjust the cuff to ensure it's properly positioned and at heart level. Repeat the measurement.
Heart Symbol Flashing	Indicates an irregular heartbeat detected during measurement.	This symbol suggests an irregularity in your pulse. Consult your doctor if this occurs frequently.
No Display/Device Not Turning On	Batteries are low, incorrectly inserted, or missing.	Check battery polarity. Replace with new AAA batteries.
