INTRODUCTION

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

5. **Wiring Connection:** Reconnect all wiring harnesses to the new control kit, ensuring proper and secure connections. Refer to the machine's service manual for specific wiring diagrams if necessary.
6. **Panel Reinstallation:** Replace all access panels and secure them.
7. **Power Reconnection:** Plug the laundry machine back into the power supply.
8. **Initial Test:** Power on the machine and perform a functional test to ensure the control kit operates correctly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The H7s Vend Wx Green Control Kit serves as the primary interface for users to interact with the laundry machine's vending and cycle selection features. Specific operational details may vary slightly depending on the laundry machine model it is installed in.

Control Panel Layout

The control kit features a digital display at the top, which typically shows information such as remaining time, credits,

Basic Operation

Inspection

- Periodically inspect the control kit for any visible signs of damage, such as cracks in the casing or frayed wires.
- Ensure all connections are secure and free from corrosion.
- Check that all buttons respond correctly when pressed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or not lighting up.	No power to the machine; loose connection; faulty control kit.	Check machine's power supply. Verify all wiring connections to the control kit. If power is present and connections are secure, the kit may need replacement.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Dirt or debris under buttons; internal component failure.	Gently clean around buttons. Ensure the control kit is properly seated. If issue persists, internal repair or replacement may be necessary.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Incorrect information on display.	Software glitch; communication error.	Power cycle the machine (turn off, wait 30 seconds, turn on). If the problem continues, consult the machine's service manual or a technician.

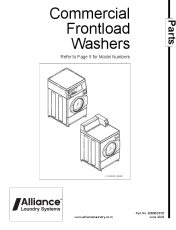
