1. INTRODUCTION

This portable projector is designed to provide a high-quality visual experience with native 1080P resolution, 4K support, 5G WiFi, and Bluetooth 5.3 connectivity. It is suitable for various applications, including home theater, outdoor movie nights, and presentations. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure proper use and maintenance.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not look directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the projector to prevent overheating. Do not block ventilation openings.
- Use only the power adapter supplied with the projector.
- Do not expose the projector to rain, moisture, or extreme temperatures.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the projector to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the projector yourself. Contact qualified service personnel for assistance.
- Keep the projector away from water and other liquids.

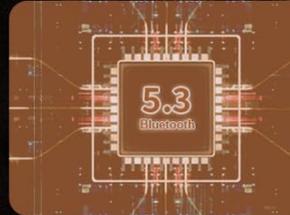

4.1 Front Panel

- **Projection Lens:** Emits the image.
- **IR Receiver:** For remote control signals.

4.2 Rear Panel / Side Panel

5. SETUP

5.1 Placement and Projection Size

The projector can display a screen size from 35 to 200 inches at a projection distance of 4 to 20 feet. Adjust the distance to achieve your desired screen size.

- **Table Placement:** Place the projector on a stable, flat surface.
- **Tripod Mount:** Use the tripod screw hole on the bottom of the projector to attach it to a tripod.
- **Ceiling Mount:** The projector supports ceiling mounting. Ensure it is securely fastened.

5.2 Power Connection

1. Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.
3. The power indicator light will illuminate.

5.3 Focus and Keystone Correction

- **Focus Adjustment:** Rotate the focus ring on the projector lens until the projected image is clear.
- **Keystone Correction:** Use the keystone correction ring or digital keystone adjustment (if available via menu) to

correct trapezoidal distortion, ensuring a rectangular image. The projector supports $\pm 15^\circ$ keystone correction.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press the power button on the projector or remote control.
- **Power Off:** Press the power button again. Confirm shutdown if prompted.

6.2 Menu Navigation

Use the navigation buttons on the projector or remote control to navigate the on-screen menu. Press 'OK' or 'Enter' to select, and 'Return' or 'Back' to go back.

6.3 Connectivity

6.3.1 WiFi Wireless Connection (2.4G + 5G)

1. Go to the "WiFi Settings" menu on the projector.
2. Select your desired WiFi network from the list.
3. Enter the password using the on-screen keyboard and confirm.
4. Once connected, you can use the screen mirroring function.

Note: Due to copyright protections, streaming services like Netflix, Amazon Prime Video, and Hulu do not support screen mirroring directly from mobile devices. Please use a TV Stick or other compatible device connected via HDMI for these services.

6.3.2 Bluetooth 5.3 Function

1. Ensure your Bluetooth audio device is in pairing mode.
2. Go to the "Bluetooth Settings" menu on the projector.
3. Select your device from the list of available devices to pair.

- **HDMI:** Connect your laptop, TV stick, gaming console, or other HDMI-enabled device to an HDMI port. Select the corresponding HDMI input source from the projector's menu.
- **USB:** Insert a USB flash drive into a USB port to play media files (videos, photos, music). Select "USB" as the input source.
- **AV:** Use the provided AV cable to connect to devices with AV output. Select "AV" as the input source.

6.4 Zoom Function

The projector features a zoom function that allows you to adjust the image size from 100% to 50% without moving the projector. This is useful for fine-tuning the display size to fit your screen.

1. Access the "Zoom" setting in the projector's menu.
2. Adjust the percentage to shrink the image as needed.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Lens Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently wipe the projector lens. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Dust Removal:** Regularly clean the projector's ventilation openings with a soft brush or compressed air to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance and lifespan.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging or a protective case.
- **Power Off Properly:** Always power off the projector using the designated power button and allow it to cool down before unplugging or moving.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image projected	Power cable loose; Incorrect input source; Device not connected properly.	Check power connection; Select correct input source (HDMI, USB, AV); Ensure device is connected and powered on.
Image blurry	Focus not adjusted; Projector too close/far from screen.	Adjust the focus ring; Adjust projection distance.
Image is trapezoidal	Keystone correction needed.	Adjust keystone correction ring or digital keystone setting.
No sound	Volume too low; Muted; External audio device not connected/paired.	Increase volume; Unmute; Check Bluetooth connection or external speaker connection.
WiFi connection unstable	Interference; Router too far; Incorrect password.	Move closer to router; Reduce interference; Re-enter WiFi password.
