For safe and effective use of Duraflame Indoor/Outdoor Fire Logs.

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and proper use of Duraflame 4.5 lb, 3-hour fire logs. These logs are designed for convenient use in indoor open-hearth fireplaces, outdoor fireplaces, and fire pits. Please read all instructions and safety warnings carefully before use.

IMPORTANT SAFETY WARNINGS

- FOR USE IN OPEN-HEARTH FIREPLACES, OUTDOOR FIREPLACES, OR FIRE PITS ONLY.
- DO NOT USE IN WOOD STOVES OR INSERTS.
- DO NOT USE FOR COOKING.
- KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY FROM FIRE.
- NEVER LEAVE A BURNING FIRE UNATTENDED.
- Ensure adequate ventilation.
- Place log on a grate in the center of the firebox.
- Do not poke or break apart the log while burning.
- Allow log to burn completely. If extinguishing early, use a fire extinguisher or sand. Do not use water.
- Store logs in a cool, dry place away from heat sources.
- This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive

harm. Wash hands after handling.

SETUP AND PREPARATION

- 1. Inspect Fire Area:** Ensure your fireplace, outdoor fireplace, or fire pit is clean and free of debris. Check that the chimney or vent is clear and unobstructed.
- 2. Position Grate:** Place a sturdy fire grate in the center of your firebox or fire pit.
- 3. Unwrap Log:** Remove the Duraflame fire log from its outer packaging. **Do not remove the paper wrapper on the log itself.** This wrapper is designed to ignite with the log.
- 4. Place Log:** Place one Duraflame fire log on the grate. For optimal burning, ensure it is positioned centrally. Do not place more than one log at a time.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Lighting the Log:** Light the paper wrapper at both ends of the log. Use a long match or lighter to maintain a safe distance.
2. **Ignition Time:** The log is designed for quick lighting, with full flames typically achieved in less than 5 minutes.
3. **Burn Time:** Each Duraflame 4.5 lb fire log provides up to 3 hours of burn time.
4. **Monitoring:** Always supervise the burning log. Do not leave the fire unattended.
5. **Adding Logs:** Do not add additional logs until the previous log has completely burned down and cooled.

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

- **Ash Disposal:** After the log has completely burned and cooled, dispose of the ashes safely. Ensure no embers remain before disposal.
- **Storage:** Store unused Duraflame fire logs in their original packaging in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Keep them out of reach of children and pets.
- **Cleaner Burning:** Duraflame fire logs burn 80% cleaner than comparable wood fires, producing less creosote and particulate matter. Regular chimney inspection and cleaning are still recommended for indoor fireplaces.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- Log Not Lighting:** Ensure the paper wrapper is fully intact and light both ends thoroughly. If the log is damp, allow it to dry in a cool, dry place before attempting to light again.
- Log Burning Too Fast/Slow:** Ensure proper ventilation. Drafts can cause logs to burn faster. Insufficient airflow can cause slower burning or incomplete combustion. Do not poke or break the log.
- Excessive Smoke:** Check for proper ventilation. Ensure the chimney or flue is open and clear. Excessive smoke can indicate poor airflow or improper use.


