Use Apple-certified or reputable third-party adapters and accessories. Ensure compatibility when connecting external devices via USB-C ports.

### Data Management

- **Transferring Data:** Use Migration Assistant to transfer data from an old Mac or PC to your new MacBook Air.
- **Backup and Restore:** Regularly back up your data using Time Machine to an external drive or iCloud to prevent data loss.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter.

- **Device Not Powering On:** Ensure the battery is charged and the power adapter is properly connected. Try a different power outlet.
- **Wi-Fi Connectivity Issues:** Check your router, restart your MacBook Air, or reset network settings in System Settings.
- **Application Not Responding:** Force quit the application by pressing Command + Option + Esc, then select the app and click 'Force Quit'.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications, check storage space, or restart your MacBook Air.

- **External Display Not Detected:** Ensure the cable is securely connected and the display is powered on. Check display settings in System Settings.
