INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use of your Generic Golden GC540 Heavy Duty Companion 3 Wheel Scooter. Please read all instructions carefully before operating the scooter. Retain this manual for future reference.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to prepare your scooter for first use.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Seat Installation:** Place the seat post into the receiver tube on the scooter's base. Secure the seat onto the post. Ensure it clicks into place or is tightened according to specific instructions.
3. **Tiller Adjustment:** Adjust the tiller to a comfortable height and angle using the adjustment lever. Ensure it locks securely in position.
4. **Battery Installation/Connection:** Locate the battery compartment. Insert the batteries and connect the terminals as indicated. Ensure all connections are secure.
5. **Initial Battery Charge:** Before first use, fully charge the scooter's batteries. Connect the charger to the scooter's charging port and then to a standard electrical outlet. Refer to the charger's indicator lights for charging status.

6. **Basket Attachment:** Attach the front basket to the designated mounting points on the tiller.

Control Panel Overview

- **Key Switch:** Insert the key and turn it to the 'ON' position to power on the scooter. Turn to 'OFF' to power off.
- **Battery Indicator:** Displays the current battery charge level. Charge the batteries when the indicator shows low power.
- **Speed Adjustment Dial:** Rotate to increase or decrease the maximum speed of the scooter.
- **Throttle Levers:** Push the right lever for forward motion, and the left lever for reverse. Releasing both levers engages the electromagnetic brake.
- **Horn Button:** Press to activate the horn.
- **Headlight Switch:** Press to turn the front and rear LED lights on or off.
- **USB Charging Port:** Located on the tiller for convenient charging of personal electronic devices.

Driving Your Scooter

1. **Starting:** Ensure the key is in the 'ON' position. Select a low speed setting initially.
2. **Acceleration:** Gently press the appropriate throttle lever. The scooter will accelerate smoothly.
3. **Steering:** Use the tiller to steer the front wheel in the desired direction. The scooter has a 51-inch turning

radius for maneuverability.

4. **Braking:** Release the throttle levers to engage the automatic electromagnetic brake. For immediate stopping, release the levers completely.
5. **Stopping:** Once stopped, turn the key to the 'OFF' position.

Safety Guidelines

- Always operate the scooter on stable, level surfaces.
- Avoid sudden starts, stops, or turns.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 500 lbs.
- Be aware of your surroundings and other pedestrians or vehicles.
- Use the LED lighting in low-light conditions for visibility.
- Ensure the tiller is securely locked in place before driving.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your scooter.

- **Battery Care:**
 - Charge batteries fully after each use.
 - Do not allow batteries to fully discharge.
 - If storing the scooter for an extended period, ensure batteries are fully charged and recharge them monthly.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the scooter with a damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or excessive water, which can damage electronic components.
- **Tire Inspection:** The scooter is equipped with solid, non-marking tires. Regularly inspect them for wear or damage.
- **General Inspection:** Periodically check all nuts, bolts, and connections for tightness. Ensure all moving parts operate smoothly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scooter does not power on.	Key not in 'ON' position, low battery, loose battery connection.	Ensure key is 'ON'. Check battery indicator and charge if low. Verify battery connections are secure.
Reduced travel range.	Undercharged batteries, old batteries, rough terrain.	Ensure batteries are fully charged. Consider battery replacement if old. Avoid consistently driving on challenging terrain.
Scooter moves slowly or intermittently.	Low battery, speed dial set too low, motor issue.	Charge batteries. Adjust speed dial. If problem persists, contact support.
Brake not engaging properly.	Throttle levers not fully released, brake system fault.	Ensure throttle levers are fully released. If issue continues, contact support.
