1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

- **Premium Fabric:** Features a waterproof top made from 160g PE cloth. Side walls are 140g PE, removable, and include window walls and zipper doors for ventilation and UV protection.
- **Versatile Use:** Ideal for providing shade and rain protection for a wide range of events.
- **Quick Setup & Easy Takedown:** User-friendly push-button system allows for hassle-free assembly and disassembly.
- **Heavy-Duty Storage Bags:** Comes with 2 rugged, long storage bags designed for easy transport and durability of tent poles.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Setting up your Delta PE Tent is designed to be straightforward, though it requires careful attention to the provided manual and the assistance of at least two people for optimal assembly. All necessary components are included in the package.

Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unbox all parts and lay them out. Identify the steel tubes, connectors, tent top, and sidewalls.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel tubes using the metal connectors. The push-button system

simplifies this process. Ensure all connections are secure and stable.

3. **Attach Top Cover:** Drape the 160g PE waterproof top cover over the assembled frame. Ensure it is centered and evenly distributed.
4. **Install Sidewalls:** Attach the 140g PE removable window walls and zipper doors to the frame. These can be fully or partially enclosed based on your needs, allowing for ventilation.
5. **Anchor the Tent:** Utilize the 4 super stakes provided to securely anchor the tent to the ground. Proper anchoring is crucial for stability, especially in varying weather conditions.

3. OPERATING AND USAGE GUIDELINES

The Delta PE Tent is designed for versatility and protection in various outdoor settings. To ensure optimal performance and longevity, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Weather Conditions:** This product should be used with caution in extreme weather conditions, such as heavy winds. Always ensure the tent is properly anchored to maintain stability. While the top is waterproof, prolonged heavy rain can lead to water pooling if not properly tensioned, which may cause structural stress.
- **Ventilation:** The removable window walls and zipper doors allow for proper ventilation. Utilize these features to ensure adequate airflow, especially during warmer weather or when the tent is fully enclosed.
- **Sun Protection:** The tent's fabric provides protection against UV rays, offering a shaded area for your events.
- **Fire Safety:** Avoid open flames near the tent due to its heat-sealed and waterproof top cover. Maintain a safe distance from any heat sources.
- **Overnight Use:** It is generally recommended not to leave the tent up overnight, particularly with the roof and side panels on, especially if there is a risk of rain or strong winds.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your Delta PE Tent. Follow these steps for cleaning and storage:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the tent fabric with mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the PE cloth.
- **Drying:** Ensure all tent components, especially the fabric, are completely dry before disassembling and storing. This prevents mold, mildew, and material degradation. If used in rain, allow the canopy to dry thoroughly in the sun before packing.
- **Storage:** Store the tent in its provided heavy-duty storage bags in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The bags are designed to handle the weight of the poles and fabric for long-term durability.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

- **Water Pooling on Roof:** If water collects on the tent roof during rain, it indicates insufficient tension or improper setup. Ensure the top cover is taut and properly secured to allow water to run off. Regularly check and clear any accumulated water to prevent damage to the frame and fabric.
- **Holes Not Lining Up During Assembly:** While rare, some minor alignment issues may occur. Double-check that all poles are correctly oriented according to the manual and that you are using the correct parts for each section. Gentle manipulation may be required to align holes.
- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** In the event of missing components or damage upon arrival, contact customer service immediately. Replacement parts can often be provided.
- **Tent Instability:** Ensure all super stakes are fully inserted into the ground and that all frame connections are

securely fastened. In windy conditions, additional anchoring or temporary disassembly may be necessary.
