INTRODUCTION

The Momcozy Breastmilk Storage Bags are designed to provide new parents with a safe, convenient, and reliable solution for storing breastmilk. Featuring a unique temperature-sensing indicator and a spill-free design, these bags simplify the process of breastmilk handling from collection to feeding.

Key Features:

- **Temp-Sensing Color Change:** Easily determine the milk's temperature for optimal feeding.
- **Double Strong Sealing:** Ensures protection against leaks with double-sealed side seams and a double zipper.
- **Innovative Side Spout:** Facilitates convenient and neat pouring of breastmilk.
- **Zero Contamination:** Made from BPA-free materials with a milk import/export separation design.
- **8oz Larger Capacity:** Each bag holds up to 240 mL (8 oz) with clear measurement markings.
- **Presterilized:** Ready for immediate use to ensure hygiene.

SETUP AND PREPARATION

1. **Inspect Bags:** Before use, visually inspect each bag for any damage or defects. Do not use if damaged.
2. **Open Bag:** Carefully tear off the top seal of the bag along the perforated line. Gently pull apart the double zipper to open the bag.
3. **Fill Milk:** Pour expressed breastmilk into the bag. Ensure not to overfill; the maximum capacity is 8 oz (240 mL). Leave some space at the top for expansion during freezing.

4. **Remove Air:** Gently press any excess air out of the bag before sealing to prevent freezer burn and preserve milk quality.
5. **Seal Bag:** Firmly press the double zipper closure together to create a secure, leak-proof seal.
6. **Label Bag:** Use the designated area on the bag to write the date, time, and volume of the breastmilk. This helps in tracking and ensuring proper rotation of your milk supply.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Temperature Sensing Feature:

The Momcozy breastmilk storage bags feature a temperature-sensing indicator to help you identify the milk's temperature for safe feeding.

- **Purple:** Indicates the milk is Cold (<36°C/96.8°F).
- **Blue:** Indicates Optimum Feeding Temperature (36-40°C/96.8-104°F).
- **White:** Indicates the milk is Hot (>40°C/104°F).

Thawing and Warming Breastmilk:

1. **Thawing:** Thaw frozen breastmilk in the refrigerator overnight, or by holding the bag under cool running water, gradually increasing the water temperature. Do not thaw at room temperature.
2. **Warming:** Once thawed, warm the breastmilk by placing the bag in a bowl of warm water or using a bottle warmer. Do not use a microwave or boil breastmilk directly, as this can destroy nutrients and create hot spots.
3. **Check Temperature:** Use the temperature-sensing indicator on the bag to ensure the milk reaches the optimum feeding temperature (blue indicator).
4. **Pouring:** Once warmed, tear off the side spout along the perforated line and carefully pour the breastmilk into a clean feeding bottle.

Breastmilk Storage Guidelines:

Breast Milk Status	Room Temperature (below 77°F / 25°C)	Refrigerator (40°F / 4°C)	Freezer (below 0°F / -18°C)
Freshly Breast Milk	Up to 4 hours	Up to 4 Days	6 months best, max 12 months
Thawed Time	1 - 2 hours	Up to 1 Day	Never refreeze breast milk after thawing

Important Tips:

- Use stored breastmilk within 2 hours after thawing.
- If fresh breastmilk is not consumed within 4 days, freeze it immediately.
- Do not exceed 180mL (approx. 6oz) when filling to avoid bag damage during freezing expansion.
- When traveling, use an insulated cooler with an ice pack. Storage time should not exceed 24 hours. Refrigerate/freeze immediately upon arrival. Do not use after 24 hours.

MAINTENANCE

Momcozy Breastmilk Storage Bags are designed for single-use only. They are presterilized and should not be washed or reused. Reusing bags can compromise their integrity and introduce contaminants, which may harm your baby.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Leakage:** Ensure the double zipper is completely sealed by pressing firmly along the entire length. Avoid overfilling the bag beyond the 8oz mark. If leakage persists, discard the bag and use a new one.
- **Temperature Sensor Not Changing Color:** Ensure the bag is fully immersed in the warming or cooling medium. The sensor reacts to the milk's temperature, not the ambient air. If the sensor remains unresponsive after proper exposure, the bag may be defective; discard and use another.
- **Difficulty Pouring:** Ensure the side spout is fully torn off along the perforated line. The design is intended for smooth pouring, but a partial tear may obstruct flow.
- **Freezer Burn:** Ensure all excess air is removed from the bag before freezing. This helps prevent freezer burn and maintains milk quality.
