IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- **Indoor/Outdoor Use:** This fan is suitable for both indoor and covered outdoor areas. Do not expose to direct rain or immerse in water. Ensure the fan is placed in a covered area when used outdoors to prevent water damage.
- **Power Source:** Use only the provided AC adapter for charging. Do not use other adapters.



SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the fan and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the fan on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there are no obstructions to the air intake or outlet.
3. **Initial Charge:** Before first use, fully charge the fan. Connect the AC adapter to the fan's power port and plug it into a standard electrical outlet. The LED display will indicate charging status. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.

OPERATION

Your Airvana fan can be operated using the control panel on the unit or the included remote control.

Power On/Off

- Press the **On/Off** button () on the control panel or remote to turn the fan on or off.

Adjusting Fan Speed

The fan has four speed settings: Low (L), Medium (M), High (H), and Turbo.

- Press the **Speed** button () repeatedly to cycle through the speeds: L → M → H → Turbo → L.
- Alternatively, press the dedicated **Turbo** button on the remote for maximum airflow.

Battery Run Time (approximate on full charge):

- Low Speed: Up to 19 hours
- Medium Speed: Up to 12 hours
- High Speed: Up to 4 hours
- Turbo Speed: Up to 2 hours

Note: The fan can operate continuously while plugged into the AC adapter.

Timer Function

Set the fan to automatically turn off after a set period.

- Press the **Timer** button () repeatedly to select 2, 4, or 8 hours. The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.
- To cancel the timer, press the Timer button until no timer indicator lights are on.

Rotation Mode

Enable oscillation for wider air distribution.

- Press the **Rotate** button () to start or stop the fan's oscillation.

Accent Light

Activate and change the color of the accent light.

- Press the **Display Light** button () to turn the accent light on/off and cycle through available colors.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

- **Cleaning the Exterior:**

- a. Always unplug the fan before cleaning.
- b. Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- c. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.

- **Cleaning Air Inlets/Outlets:**

- a. Use a soft brush or a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to remove dust from the air inlets and outlets.
- b. The bladeless design makes internal cleaning easier; a soft cloth can be used to wipe the inside of the loop.

- **Storage:**

- a. If storing the fan for an extended period, ensure it is clean and dry.
- b. Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- c. It is recommended to fully charge the battery before storage and recharge every 3-6 months to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Airvana Bladeless Fan, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power or low battery. Power button not pressed correctly.	Ensure the AC adapter is securely plugged in or the battery is charged. Press the On/Off button firmly.
Weak airflow.	Fan speed set too low. Air inlets/outlets are blocked or dusty.	Increase the fan speed. Clean the air inlets and outlets.
Fan does not oscillate.	Rotation feature not activated.	Press the Rotate button to activate oscillation.
Battery not charging.	AC adapter not connected properly. Faulty adapter or power outlet.	Ensure the AC adapter is fully inserted into the fan and wall outlet. Try a different outlet or contact customer support.
Remote control not working.	Battery in remote is dead or incorrectly inserted. Obstruction between remote and fan.	Replace the remote control battery (CR2025, not specified in input, but common). Ensure clear line of sight to the fan's sensor.




