1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Philips Series 2000 Table Fan. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new fan. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

The Philips Series 2000 Table Fan is designed to provide powerful yet quiet air circulation, featuring SilentWings Technology for reduced noise levels, a 180-degree adjustable tilt, and multiple operating modes including a 12-hour timer, Quiet Sleep, and Natural Breeze modes.

Important Safety Information

- Always ensure the fan is placed on a stable, flat surface.
- Do not insert fingers or objects into the grille when the fan is operating.
- Keep the fan away from water or other liquids. Do not use in wet environments.
- Unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not operate the fan with a damaged cord or plug. Contact qualified service personnel for repairs.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

3. SETUP

The Philips Series 2000 Table Fan is designed for easy setup. Follow these steps to prepare your fan for use:

1. **Unpack the Fan:** Carefully remove the fan and all accessories from the packaging.
2. **Position the Fan:** Place the fan on a stable, flat, and dry surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the fan for optimal airflow.
3. **Connect to Power:** Insert the power cable into the fan's power port, then plug the other end into a standard electrical outlet (220V).

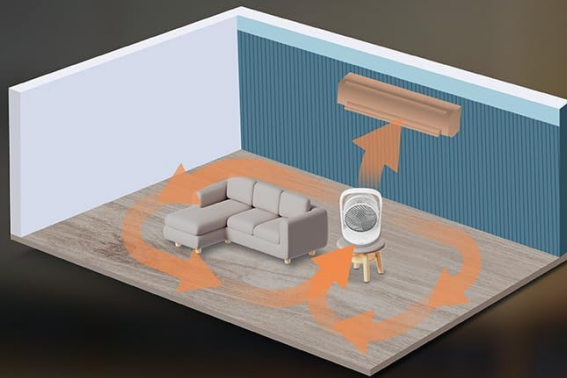

Control Panel Overview

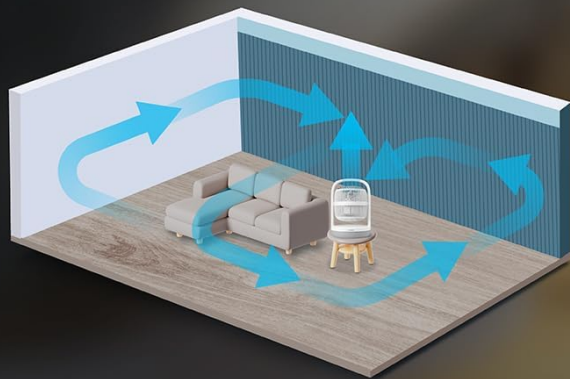
The control panel is located on the base of the fan and includes touch-sensitive buttons for power, speed, mode, and timer functions.



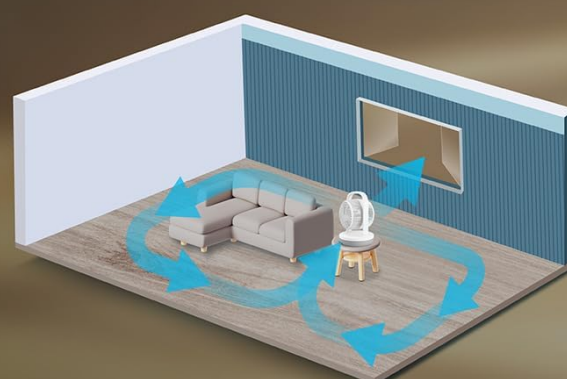

Power On/Off

- Press the **Power button** (🔌) once to turn the fan on.
- Press the **Power button** again to turn the fan off.

Adjusting Fan Speed

The fan features 3 speed settings:

- Press the **Speed button** (🌀) repeatedly to cycle through speeds 1 (low), 2 (medium), and 3 (high).

Operating Modes

The fan offers two special modes for enhanced comfort:

- **Natural Breeze Mode:** Press the **Mode button** (🌿) to activate this mode. It simulates natural outdoor airflow by varying fan speed.
- **Quiet Sleep Mode:** Press the **Mode button** again to activate this mode. The fan speed will gradually decrease

over 30 minutes to provide a quiet sleeping environment.

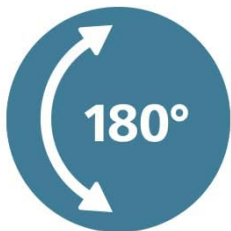

Timer Function

Set the fan to operate for a specific duration:

- Press the **Timer button** (🕒) repeatedly to set the desired operating time (up to 12 hours). The fan will automatically turn off after the set time.

Adjusting Airflow Direction

The fan head can be manually tilted up to 180 degrees to direct airflow precisely where needed. Gently adjust the fan head to your preferred angle.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your Philips Series 2000 Table Fan.

Cleaning the Fan

1. **Disconnect Power:** Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Clean Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
3. **Clean Grille and Blades:** Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment or a soft brush to remove dust from the front and rear grilles and fan blades. The fan grille can be opened for more thorough cleaning of the blades. Refer to the product diagram for grille removal instructions.
4. **Dry Thoroughly:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before plugging the fan back in.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your fan, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power supply. Power button not pressed.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Press the Power button on the control panel.
Weak or no airflow.	Fan speed too low. Grille or blades are dusty.	Increase the fan speed setting. Clean the fan grille and blades as described in the Maintenance section.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unusual noise during operation.	Fan not on a stable surface. Obstruction in the fan blades. Loose parts.	Place the fan on a firm, level surface. Disconnect power and check for any obstructions. If noise persists, contact customer support.
