# KAKO Gold Bar Cart Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the KAKO Gold Bar Cart. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bar cart. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, please observe the following safety guidelines:

- Do not overload the shelves beyond their weight capacity of 66 lbs per layer.
- Use caution when moving the cart on uneven surfaces to prevent tipping.
- Keep fingers away from moving parts during assembly and use.
- Ensure all screws are tightened securely during assembly.
- Place the cart on a flat, stable surface.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged:

- Gold Steel Frame components
- 2 Mirrored Shelves (Toughened Glass)
- 4 Casters (2 with brakes)
- Wine Bottle Holders
- Glass Holders
- Assembly Hardware (screws, wrench)
- Instruction Manual

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The KAKO Gold Bar Cart is designed for easy assembly. All necessary accessories and detailed instructions are included. Follow the steps below for proper setup:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Verify all parts against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the gold steel frame components using the provided screws and tools. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten initially.

3. **Install Shelves:** Carefully place the toughened glass mirrored shelves into their designated positions within the frame. Ensure they sit flush and are stable. The protective fence on the bottom shelf should face upwards to prevent items from falling.
4. **Attach Casters:** Screw the 4 rotating casters into the base of the cart. Ensure the 2 casters with brakes are positioned on the same side for easy locking.
5. **Install Wine and Glass Holders:** Attach the wine bottle holders and glass holders to the underside of the top shelf as indicated in the detailed instructions.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, go back and securely tighten all screws.

## 360° ROTATING CASTERS

4pcs 360° rotating casters, 2 of which are equipped with brakes to prevent sliding when stopped.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your KAKO Gold Bar Cart is designed for versatile use and easy mobility.

- **Loading Capacity:** Each shelf has a loading capacity of 66 lbs. Distribute weight evenly to maintain stability.
- **Mobility:** The cart is equipped with 4pcs 360° rotating casters. To move the cart, simply push or pull it by the handle.
- **Locking Mechanism:** Two of the casters have brakes. To secure the cart in place, press down on the brake levers. To release, lift the levers.
- **Storage:** Utilize the two tiers for storing various items such as wine bottles, glasses, snacks, fruits, or small appliances. The built-in wine and glass holders can accommodate up to 9 glasses and 4 bottles of red wine.

## MAINTENANCE

To keep your KAKO Gold Bar Cart in optimal condition, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the steel frame and mirrored shelves with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that may damage the finish or glass.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Storage:** Store the cart in a dry environment to prevent potential damage to the metal frame.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your KAKO Gold Bar Cart, consider the following:

- **Cart is unstable:** Ensure all screws are fully tightened. Check that the cart is on a flat, level surface. Engage the

brakes on the casters if stationary.

- **Casters not rolling smoothly:** Check for any debris or hair caught in the wheels. Ensure the brakes are disengaged.
- **Shelves appear loose:** Verify that the shelves are correctly seated within the frame and that the frame itself is securely assembled.
