Featuring an Android 9.0 operating system, 80GB of storage (2GB RAM + 16GB ROM + 64GB TF card), and a 4.0-inch full-touch IPS screen, it supports a wide range of audio and video formats. With built-in Wi-Fi and Bluetooth, you can enjoy streaming services, browse the internet, and connect to various audio devices.

Physical Features

- 4.0-inch Full-Touch IPS Screen: For intuitive navigation and media viewing.
- Power Button: Located on the side for turning the device on/off and screen lock.

SETUP

1. Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge your SWOFY M503 Pro. Connect the included USB Type-C cable to the device's charging port and the other end to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port. The device features a 2000mAh battery for extended playback.

2. Power On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button until the screen lights up.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button, then select "Power off" from the options.
- To lock/unlock screen: Briefly press the Power button.

3. Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to select your preferred language (English is default), connect to a Wi-Fi network, and set up basic device preferences.

4. Inserting a Micro SD Card

The device comes with 80GB of storage (16GB internal + 64GB TF card). To expand storage further, locate the Micro SD card slot on the side of the device. Gently insert a Micro SD card (up to 512GB supported) until it clicks into place. Ensure the card is inserted correctly to avoid damage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Navigation

The SWOFY M503 Pro features a full-touch IPS screen for intuitive navigation. Swipe left/right to switch between home screens, tap icons to open applications, and use the on-screen navigation buttons (Back, Home, Recent Apps) at the bottom of the display.

Music Playback

Connectivity (Bluetooth & Wi-Fi)

- **Bluetooth:** Connect wirelessly to Bluetooth speakers, headphones, or car stereos for a customized audio experience. Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth to pair.
- Wi-Fi: Connect to Wi-Fi networks to access online streaming services, browse the internet, and download/uninstall apps from the Play Store. Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi.

App Management

The device runs on Android 9.0, allowing you to download and manage applications. Use the pre-installed Play Store to find and install new apps. You can also uninstall apps you no longer need.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the device. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check for system updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update.
- Battery Care: To prolong battery life, avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures. It is recommended to fully charge the device before long periods of inactivity.
- Storage Management: Regularly clear unnecessary files and apps to maintain smooth operation.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Device does not power on.	Ensure the device is fully charged. Connect to a power source and try again. If unresponsive, press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds for a forced restart.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Check if Wi-Fi is enabled in Settings. Ensure the Wi-Fi password is correct. Restart your Wi-Fi router.

Problem	Possible Solution
Bluetooth device not pairing.	Ensure the Bluetooth device is in pairing mode. Check if Bluetooth is enabled on the MP3 player. Try restarting both devices.
Poor audio quality.	Check headphone connection or Bluetooth connection. Ensure audio files are not corrupted. Adjust equalizer settings if available.
Device is slow or unresponsive.	Close background applications. Clear cache. Consider performing a factory reset (backup data first). Ensure sufficient storage space.
