1. INTRODUCTION

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The PoolMr Cordless Robotic Pool Cleaner is designed for efficient cleaning of flat inground and above ground pools up to 1384 sq. ft. It features a cordless design, dual motors for strong suction, and smart route technology for effective cleaning.

Key Features:

- Cordless & Fast Cleaning:** Hassle-free operation without cables, offering a cleaning speed of 52 Ft/min.
- Powerful Suction & Deep Cleaning:** Equipped with newly upgraded powerful dual motors providing up to 15kpa of underwater suction. Includes two cleaning scrapers and large suction ports for effective sediment removal.
- Smart Route Tech & Self-Parking:** Precision sensors enable quick reversal upon touching pool walls, preventing damage. The cleaner stops near the wall when the cleaning cycle ends or battery is low.
- High Filter & Safety Design:** Features a 250um fine filter to capture leaves, branches, sand, and small stones. Designed to operate only when submerged in water, ensuring electrical safety.
- Long Lasting Battery:** 5000mAh battery provides over 140 minutes of cleaning time.

- Main Unit (Robotic Pool Cleaner)

- Fine Filter Mesh
- Hook
- Charge Adapter
- Scrapers (2)
- Direction Controller

3. SETUP

The PoolMr Robotic Pool Cleaner is designed for easy assembly and setup. Follow these steps to prepare your cleaner for first use:

- 1. Charge the Unit:** Before initial use, fully charge the robotic pool cleaner using the provided charge adapter. The charging time is approximately 3 hours.
- 2. Install Scrapers:** Attach the two cleaning scrapers to the designated slots on the bottom of the cleaner. Ensure they are securely fastened.
- 3. Prepare for Deployment:** Ensure the pool cleaner is fully assembled and the filter is clean and properly installed.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your PoolMr Robotic Pool Cleaner is straightforward:

- 1. Power On:** Locate the power switch on the unit and turn it on.
- 2. Submerge:** Gently place the cordless pool vacuum into the water. The unit will begin its cleaning cycle automatically once submerged.
- 3. Cleaning Cycle:** The cleaner will navigate your pool, utilizing its smart route technology to cover the entire flat surface. It will reverse direction upon contact with pool walls.
- 4. Self-Parking:** Once the cleaning cycle is complete or the battery is low, the cleaner will automatically move to the nearest wall for easy retrieval.
- 5. Retrieval:** Use the provided hook to safely retrieve the cleaner from the pool.



5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your PoolMr Robotic Pool Cleaner:

- 1. Clean the Filter:** After each cleaning cycle, remove the fine filter mesh and rinse it thoroughly with water to remove collected debris. Ensure the filter is completely clean before re-installing.
- 2. Inspect Scrapers:** Check the cleaning scrapers for wear or damage. Replace if necessary to maintain effective cleaning.
- 3. Store Properly:** When not in use, store the cleaner in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- 4. Battery Care:** Do not leave the battery completely discharged for extended periods. Charge it periodically even during off-season storage.



6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PoolMr Robotic Pool Cleaner, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---|---|--|
| Cleaner not moving or stuck. | Low battery, debris caught in wheels/motors, uneven pool surface. | Charge the unit. Clear any obstructions. Ensure pool surface is flat as recommended. |
| Poor cleaning performance. | Clogged filter, worn scrapers, insufficient charge. | Clean the filter thoroughly. Check and replace scrapers if needed. Ensure unit is fully charged. |
| Unit does not turn on. | Battery not charged, power switch off, unit not submerged. | Charge the battery. Ensure power switch is in the 'ON' position. The unit activates only when submerged in water. |
| Debris leaks out when removing from pool. | Filter flaps not closing properly. | Ensure the filter assembly is correctly seated and the flaps are free from obstruction. Remove the cleaner slowly and carefully. |





