INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Poly EP 320 Stereo USB-C Headset. Designed for clear audio communication, this wired headset features a comfortable over-ear design and an integrated microphone, making it ideal for various communication needs.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Poly EP 320 Stereo USB-C Headset:

- 1. **Connect the Headset:** Locate an available USB-C port on your computer, laptop, or compatible device. Insert the USB-C connector of the headset firmly into the port.
- 2. **Operating System Recognition:** Your operating system (Windows, macOS, Linux, etc.) should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the headset. This process may take a few moments.
- 3. Select as Default Device:
 - Windows: Go to "Sound Settings" (right-click the speaker icon in the taskbar) and ensure the Poly EP 320 is selected as the default playback and recording device.
 - macOS: Go to "System Preferences" > "Sound" and select the Poly EP 320 for both input and output.
- 4. **Adjust Fit:** Place the headset on your head and adjust the headband for a comfortable and secure fit. Position the earcup over your ear.
- 5. **Position Microphone:** Bend the microphone boom to position the microphone approximately 1-2 inches (2.5-5 cm) from your mouth for optimal voice clarity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected and configured, your Poly EP 320 headset is ready for use.

- Audio Playback: The headset will automatically play audio from your connected device. Adjust volume using your
 device's system volume controls or within the application you are using.
- **Microphone Usage:** The integrated microphone is active when selected as the input device. Ensure the microphone is properly positioned for clear voice capture.
- Call Management: For communication applications (e.g., Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Skype), call controls are typically
 managed within the software interface. The headset provides audio input and output.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your headset:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset. For ear cushions, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure they are completely dry before use. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Storage: When not in use, store the headset in a clean, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

 Avoid tangling the cable.
- Cable Care: Do not pull on the cable to disconnect the headset. Always grasp the USB-C connector. Avoid sharp bends or kinks in the cable.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your headset, try the following solutions:

Problem	Solution
No sound from headset	 Ensure the USB-C connector is fully inserted into the port. Check your device's sound settings to confirm the Poly EP 320 is selected as the default playback device. Increase the volume on your device. Try connecting the headset to a different USB-C port or another device to rule out port issues.
Microphone not working	 Verify the microphone boom is positioned correctly near your mouth. Check your device's sound settings to confirm the Poly EP 320 is selected as the default recording device. Ensure the microphone is not muted within your communication application. Test the microphone using your device's sound recorder or a different application.
Audio quality is poor	 Ensure the USB-C connection is secure. Close other applications that might be consuming system resources. Check for any physical damage to the cable or connectors.


