INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Blue Wave Aspen 15FT X 48IN Round Above Ground Swimming Pool Package. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning installation and retain this manual for future reference.

The Blue Wave Aspen pool features a durable metal frame and a heavy-gauge PVC liner reinforced with polyester fabric, designed for lasting enjoyment. This package includes a ladder, maintenance kit, filtration system, and a cover.

SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these safety instructions can result in serious injury or death. Always supervise children and non-swimmers. This pool is not suitable for diving or jumping.

- Never leave children unattended in or around the pool.
- Ensure the pool area is secure to prevent unauthorized access.
- Do not dive or jump into the pool. The water depth is not sufficient for safe diving.
- Keep electrical devices away from the pool.
- Regularly check and maintain water chemistry to ensure a safe swimming environment.
- Always use the provided ladder for safe entry and exit.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

SETUP

Proper site preparation and assembly are crucial for the stability and longevity of your pool. Follow these steps carefully.

1. Site Preparation

1. **Choose a Level Location:** Select a firm, level area in your yard, free from sharp objects, rocks, or debris. The ground must be perfectly level to prevent uneven water pressure and potential pool collapse.
2. **Clear the Area:** Remove all grass, weeds, and roots from the chosen area. A ground cloth (not included) is recommended to protect the pool liner.
3. **Proximity to Power:** Ensure the chosen location is within a safe distance of a grounded electrical outlet for the filtration system, adhering to all local electrical codes.

2. Pool Liner Placement

Carefully spread out the PVC pool liner in the prepared, level area. Ensure the drain plug is positioned correctly for future draining. Smooth out any wrinkles in the bottom of the liner.

3. Frame Assembly

Assemble the metal frame according to the diagrams provided in the separate frame assembly guide (if applicable). Connect all horizontal beams and vertical supports securely. Ensure all pins and connectors are fully engaged.

4. Ladder Assembly

Assemble the ladder with platform following the specific instructions included with the ladder components. Ensure all steps are securely fastened and the ladder is stable before use. Place the ladder firmly on the ground outside the pool and against the pool wall inside.

5. Filtration System Installation

1. **Connect Hoses:** Attach the hoses from the filtration pump to the inlet and outlet fittings on the pool liner. Secure them with the provided clamps.
2. **Install Filter Cartridge:** Open the filter housing and insert the filter cartridge. Close the housing securely.
3. **Position Pump:** Place the pump on a stable, level surface near the pool, ensuring it is protected from direct sunlight and rain.
4. **Electrical Connection:** Plug the pump into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) is used for safety.

OPERATING THE POOL

1. Filling the Pool

Begin filling the pool with water. As the water level rises, gently smooth out any remaining wrinkles in the bottom of the liner. Stop filling when the water reaches the recommended fill line, typically just below the top ring of the pool.

2. Running the Filtration System

Once the pool is filled, turn on the filtration pump. The pump should run for several hours each day (e.g., 8-12 hours) to circulate and filter the water, keeping it clean. Consult the filtration system's specific manual for optimal run times and settings.

3. Water Chemistry

Regularly test the pool water using a pool test kit (not included) to ensure proper chemical balance. Maintain appropriate levels of chlorine, pH, alkalinity, and calcium hardness according to pool water guidelines. Improper chemical balance can lead to cloudy water, algae growth, and damage to pool components.

MAINTENANCE

Consistent maintenance will extend the life of your pool and ensure a safe swimming environment.

1. Daily/Weekly Maintenance

- **Skim Debris:** Use the provided skimmer net to remove leaves, insects, and other floating debris from the water surface.
- **Vacuum Pool:** Use the vacuum head and telescopic pole to remove debris from the pool bottom.
- **Brush Walls:** Brush the pool walls and floor to prevent algae buildup.
- **Check Water Levels:** Ensure the water level is maintained at the recommended height.
- **Test Water Chemistry:** Perform daily or weekly water tests and adjust chemicals as needed.

2. Filter Maintenance

- **Clean Filter Cartridge:** Turn off the pump, remove the filter cartridge, and rinse it thoroughly with a garden hose. Replace the cartridge if it is damaged or excessively dirty.
- **Frequency:** Clean the filter cartridge weekly or more often if the pool is heavily used or water appears cloudy.

3. Pool Cover Usage

Use the provided pool cover when the pool is not in use to prevent debris from entering the water, reduce evaporation, and help maintain water temperature. Ensure the cover is securely fastened.

4. Winterization (Seasonal Storage)

Before freezing temperatures arrive, the pool must be properly winterized. This typically involves draining the pool, cleaning the liner, disassembling the frame, and storing all components in a dry, protected area. Refer to a comprehensive pool winterization guide for detailed steps.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your pool.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water is Cloudy	Poor filtration, improper chemical balance, high organic load.	Clean or replace filter cartridge. Test and adjust water chemistry (chlorine, pH). Run pump longer. Shock the pool.
Algae Growth	Low chlorine, high pH, insufficient circulation.	Shock the pool with chlorine. Brush pool walls. Test and adjust pH. Run pump longer. Consider an algaecide.
Pump Not Running	No power, tripped GFCI, motor malfunction.	Check power connection. Reset GFCI. Ensure pump is plugged into a working outlet. Consult pump manual or contact support if motor issue.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leak	Puncture in liner, loose hose connection, faulty drain plug.	Inspect liner for punctures and repair with a vinyl patch kit. Tighten hose clamps. Ensure drain plug is securely closed.
