1. Introduction and Product Overview

The Bitvae P1 Water Flosser is a portable oral irrigator designed for effective and convenient dental hygiene. Its compact and collapsible design makes it ideal for both home use and travel. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Bitvae P1 Water Flosser typically includes the following components:

- Main Unit (Water Flosser Body)
- Telescopic Water Tank
- Standard Nozzles (typically 4)
- Type-C Charging Cable
- Waterproof Storage Bag
- User Manual (this document)

3. SETUP

- 1. **Charge the Device:** Before first use, fully charge the water flosser using the provided Type-C cable. Connect the cable to the charging port on the device and a 5V1A adapter or USB port. The battery indicator will show charging status. A full charge provides up to 40 days of usage.
- 2. **Attach the Nozzle:** Select a desired nozzle and insert it firmly into the nozzle opening on the top of the main unit until it clicks into place.
- 3. Extend the Water Tank: Pull down the telescopic water tank from the main unit until it is fully extended.
- 4. Fill the Water Tank: Open the water tank cap and fill the tank with lukewarm water. Close the cap securely.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for effective oral irrigation:

- 1. **Positioning:** Lean over a sink and place the nozzle tip into your mouth, aiming it at your gumline at a 90-degree angle.
- 2. Power On: Press the power button to turn on the device.
- 3. **Select Mode:** The Bitvae P1 offers 3 cleaning pressures. Press the mode button to cycle through the available modes (e.g., Soft, Normal, Pulse) to find your preferred intensity.
- 4. **Begin Flossing:** Guide the water stream along your gumline, pausing briefly between teeth. Allow the water to flow into the sink.
- 5. **Rotate Nozzle:** Utilize the 360° rotatable nozzle to reach all areas of your mouth, including the back teeth and around orthodontic appliances.
- 6. Power Off: Press the power button again to turn off the device when finished or when the water tank is empty.




Image: A woman smiling while holding the Bitvae P1 Water Flosser, illustrating the ease of use and suggesting quick and effective cleaning in approximately one minute.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and hygiene of your water flosser:

- Empty and Dry Tank: After each use, empty any remaining water from the tank and allow it to air dry to prevent mold and mildew buildup.
- Clean the Nozzle: Rinse the nozzle under running water. For deeper cleaning, nozzles can be soaked in a denture cleaner solution or a mixture of water and white vinegar periodically.
- Clean the Main Unit: Wipe the exterior of the main unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not submerge the main unit in water, although the device is IPX7 waterproof for shower use, it should not be fully immersed for cleaning.
- **Descaling:** If you notice reduced water pressure or mineral buildup, fill the tank with a mixture of 1 part white vinegar to 2 parts water. Run the solution through the device until the tank is empty. Rinse by running a full tank of clean water through the device.

• Storage: Collapse the water tank and store the device in its waterproof bag when not in use or for travel.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not turn on.	Low battery.	Charge the device fully.
Weak water pressure.	Low battery; Mineral buildup; Nozzle clogged.	Charge the device; Perform descaling; Clean or replace nozzle.
Water leaks from tank.	Tank not properly extended or cap not sealed.	Ensure tank is fully extended and cap is securely closed.
Device stops during use.	Water tank empty; Low battery.	Refill water tank; Charge the device.
