Stauer Women's Retrograde Vintage Watch User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Stauer Women's Retrograde Vintage Watch, Model 58014. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use, maintenance, and longevity of your timepiece. The Stauer Retrograde Watch features a unique display where the hour and minute hands sweep in a semi-circle before returning to their starting point.

SETUP

Setting the Time

To set the time on your Stauer Retrograde Watch, follow these steps:

1. Locate the crown on the side of the watch case.
2. Gently pull the crown outwards to the time-setting position. You may feel a slight click.
3. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time. Observe the retrograde movement as the hands sweep across the semi-circular dial.
4. Once the correct time is set, push the crown back into its original position against the watch case. This will engage the movement and the watch will begin to keep time.

Adjusting the Leather Band

The genuine leather band can be adjusted to fit various wrist sizes. Use the buckle to select the appropriate hole for a comfortable and secure fit. Ensure the watch is not too tight, which could restrict circulation, or too loose, which could cause it to move excessively on the wrist.

OPERATION

Understanding the Retrograde Display

Unlike traditional watches where hands rotate in a full circle, the Stauer Retrograde Watch features hands that move along a semi-circular arc. When a hand reaches the end of its arc (e.g., 12 o'clock for hours or 60 minutes for minutes), it instantly "jumps" or "flies back" to the beginning of its arc to start the next cycle. This is a characteristic feature of retrograde movements.

The dial displays numbers for both hours (0-12) and minutes (0-60) along the semi-circle. The shorter hand indicates hours, and the longer hand indicates minutes.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your Watch

- Wipe the watch case and crystal with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- For the leather band, avoid prolonged exposure to water, direct sunlight, and harsh chemicals, as these can cause damage or discoloration. If the band gets wet, gently pat it dry with a soft cloth and allow it to air dry completely.
- Do not use chemical cleaners or abrasive materials on any part of the watch.

Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keeping it in its original box or a watch case can help protect it from dust and scratches.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement requiring a battery. When the watch stops or the hands move erratically, it may be time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and prevent damage to the movement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running or running intermittently.	Depleted battery.	Replace the battery. Consult a professional watch technician.
Time is incorrect after setting.	Crown not fully pushed in; accidental adjustment.	Ensure the crown is fully pushed in after setting the time. Reset the time if necessary.
Hands are not moving smoothly or are stuck.	Internal mechanism issue; debris.	Do not attempt to repair yourself. Contact Stauer customer support or a certified watch repair service.
Leather band shows signs of wear or discoloration.	Exposure to moisture, sweat, or chemicals; natural aging.	Clean and condition the leather regularly. Avoid prolonged exposure to damaging elements. Consider replacing the band if severely worn.
