SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Logitech Wave Keys MK670 Combo:




Image: A user viewing the Logi Options+ application on a computer monitor, demonstrating the software's interface for customizing the Wave Keys MK670 Combo.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to clean the surfaces of the keyboard and mouse. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Battery Replacement: The keyboard and mouse are designed for long battery life. When batteries are low, replace them promptly with new AAA (keyboard) and AA (mouse) alkaline batteries. Dispose of old batteries according to local regulations.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, turn off the devices to conserve battery life. Store them in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

• **No Connection:** If the keyboard or mouse does not connect, ensure the USB unifying receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port. Check that the devices are powered on and have fresh batteries. Try plugging the receiver into a different USB port.

- Lag or Intermittent Connection: Move the devices closer to the USB receiver. Ensure there are no large metal objects or other wireless devices interfering with the signal between the devices and the receiver.
- **Keys or Buttons Not Responding:** Check for debris under the keys or buttons. If the issue persists, try repairing the devices with the unifying receiver using the Logi Options+ app or by following Logitech's support instructions.
- **Battery Life Issues:** Ensure you are using high-quality alkaline batteries. Extreme temperatures can affect battery performance.
