## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the EasyKeys Replacement Key, specifically designed for Huwil locks with code 3066A. This key is compatible with Huwil Key Series 3001A-4000A and Steelcase locks. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and compatibility.

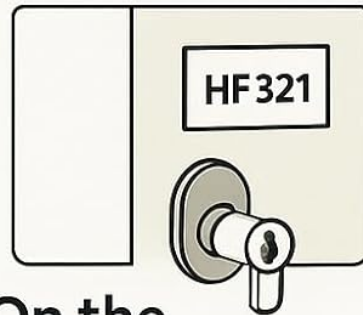

## Important Notes

- Order by Manufacturer → Lock codes are manufacturer-specific.
- Key Cuts Differ → Even if codes look similar, they vary by brand.

## 2. KEY IDENTIFICATION AND COMPATIBILITY

Before using your replacement key, it is crucial to verify that your lock code and manufacturer match the product specifications. Incorrect key codes or manufacturers will result in incompatibility and the key will not function correctly.

## 2.1 How to Find Your Lock Code

To ensure you have the correct replacement key, locate the code on your existing key or lock mechanism. Common locations for lock codes include:

- **On the Key:** The code (e.g., FR322) is often stamped directly on the key blade or head.
- **On the Lock Face:** For some locks, the code (e.g., FR322) may be visible on the face of the lock cylinder.
- **On a Label Inside/Behind the Lock:** For cabinet or drawer locks, a label with the code (e.g., CODE: G38) might be affixed to the inside of the furniture or the back of the lock mechanism.
- **On the Cabinet/Door Label:** In some cases, the lock code (e.g., HF321) is found on a label on the cabinet or door itself, near the lock.

## 2.2 Important Notes on Compatibility

- **Order by Manufacturer:** Lock codes are manufacturer-specific. A code from one manufacturer may not be compatible with a lock from another, even if the numbers appear similar. This key is specifically for **Huwil** and **Steelcase** locks.
- **Key Cuts Differ:** Even if codes look similar, the actual key cuts (bitting) vary significantly by brand. Always confirm both the code and the manufacturer.

## 3. KEY USAGE

---

Using your replacement key is straightforward:

1. **Insert the Key:** Gently insert the key into the lock cylinder. Ensure it is fully seated.
2. **Turn the Key:** Turn the key smoothly in the direction required to lock or unlock the mechanism.
3. **Do Not Force:** If the key does not turn smoothly, do not force it. Forcing the key can damage both the key and the lock. Refer to the Troubleshooting section.
4. **Remove the Key:** Once the lock is engaged or disengaged, turn the key back to its original position and remove it.

## 4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and proper function of your replacement key, follow these guidelines:

- Keep the key clean and free from debris, dirt, or foreign objects.
- Avoid exposing the key to extreme temperatures, harsh chemicals, or corrosive substances.
- Store the key in a safe place to prevent bending, breaking, or other physical damage.
- Do not use the key for purposes other than operating its intended lock.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 5.1 Key Does Not Turn in Lock

- **Verify Lock Code and Manufacturer:** Double-check that the code on your lock matches **3066A** and that the manufacturer is indeed **Huwil** or **Steelcase**. An incorrect match is the most common reason for incompatibility.
- **Inspect Key for Damage:** Examine the key for any signs of bending, damage, or obstructions (e.g., dirt, lint) that might prevent it from fully entering or turning in the lock.
- **Inspect Lock Cylinder:** Ensure the lock cylinder is clear of debris. If the lock feels stiff, a small amount of graphite-based lubricant (not oil-based) can be applied to the key and inserted into the lock.
- **Professional Assistance:** If the issue persists after these steps, it may indicate a problem with the lock itself or an incorrect key cut. Consult a qualified locksmith or the lock manufacturer for further assistance.
