PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP

1. Charging the Device

Before first use, fully charge the earbuds and the charging case. Connect the charging cable to the case and a power source. The indicator light on the case will show charging status.

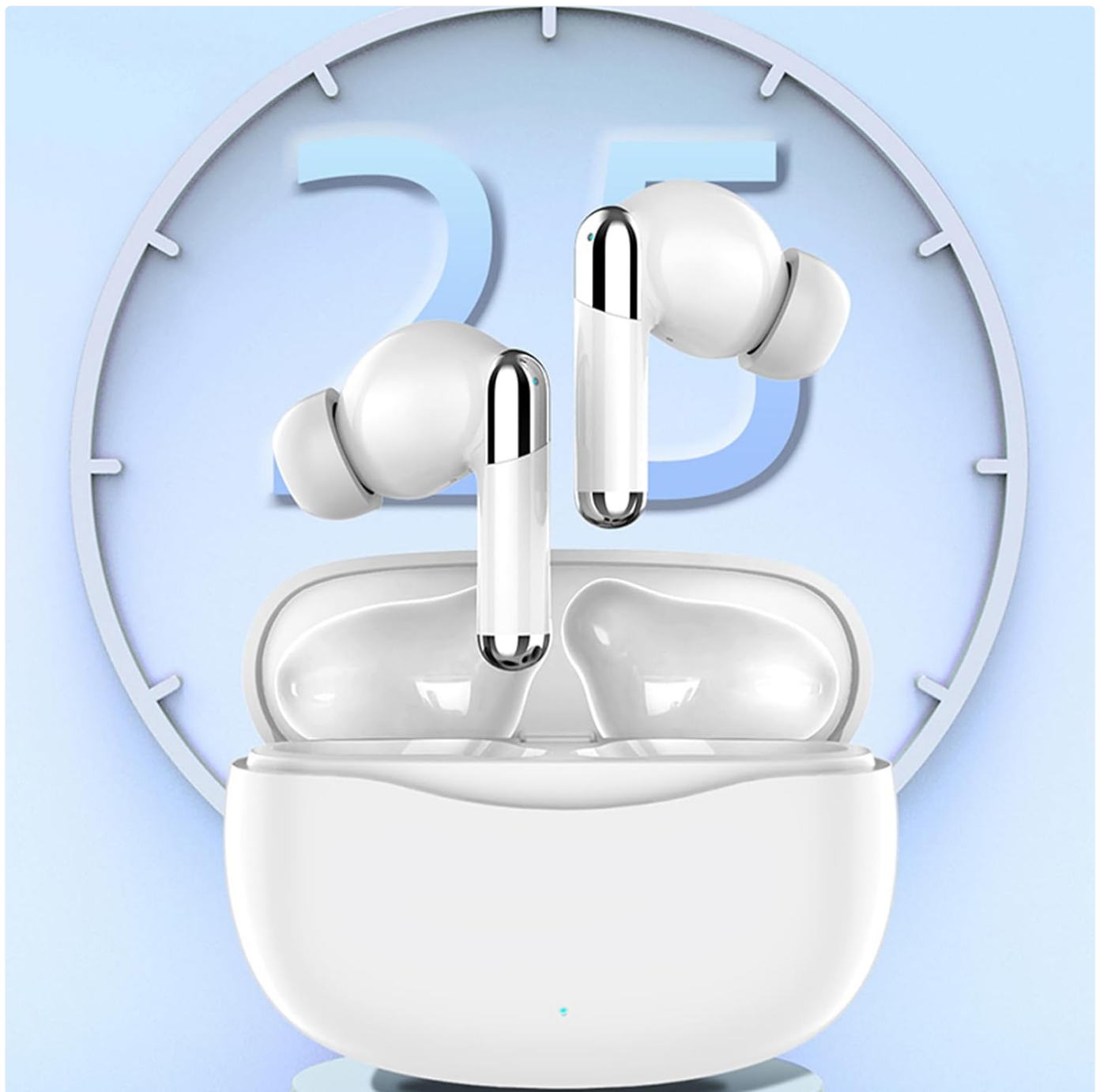


Image: The Yanmis J66 earbuds inside their charging case, with a clock graphic indicating charging time.

2. Pairing with Your Device

1. Ensure earbuds are charged and placed in the charging case.
2. Open the charging case lid. The earbuds will automatically enter pairing mode.
3. On your smartphone or tablet (iOS or Android), go to Bluetooth settings.
4. Select "J66" from the list of available devices to connect.
5. Once connected, you will hear an audio prompt.

3. Installing the Translation Application

To utilize the translation features, you must download the dedicated application. Refer to the separate "Translation Application User Manual" included in your package for detailed instructions on downloading and setting up the app on your iOS or Android device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Yanmis J66 earbuds offer three primary translation modes and intuitive touch controls for various functions.

Translation Modes

The earbuds support 144 languages for online translation. The translation speed is approximately 0.2 seconds.

- **Touch Mode:** Designed for two people, each wearing one earbud. Tap or double-tap the earbud to initiate real-time translation of spoken words. This mode is ideal for direct conversations.
- **Outgoing Mode:** One person wears an earbud, and the other person speaks into the phone. The earbud wearer hears the translation, and their speech is translated and played through the phone's speaker.
- **Voice Mode:** One earbud is used by two people. This mode allows for shared listening and translation in a single earbud setup.

Intelligent Noise Suppression

The J66 earbuds feature intelligent noise suppression technology, enhancing clarity for both translation and audio playback. This ensures a clear listening experience even in noisy environments.

Touch Controls (Binaural Finger Control)

The earbuds are equipped with touch-sensitive surfaces for easy control of various functions:

- **Single Tap:** Play/Pause music, Answer/End call.
- **Double Tap:** (Specific to translation app) Initiate translation in Touch Mode.
- **Long Press:** Reject call, Activate voice assistant (if supported by your device).
- **Triple Tap (Left/Right):** Previous/Next track (music playback).

Note: Specific touch functions may vary slightly depending on the translation application settings and your connected device.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Yanmis J66 earbuds, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the earbuds and charging case with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the earbuds in their charging case to protect them from dust and damage.
- **Charging:** Use only the provided charging cable. Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures.
- **Water Exposure:** The earbuds are not waterproof. Avoid contact with water or excessive moisture.
- **Eartips:** Clean the silicone eartips periodically with a damp cloth and mild soap, then dry thoroughly before reattaching.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Yanmis J66 earbuds, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Earbuds not pairing	◦ Ensure earbuds are charged. ◦ Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. ◦ Forget "J66" in your device's Bluetooth settings and try pairing again. ◦ Ensure earbuds are in pairing mode (open case lid).
No sound from earbuds	◦ Check volume levels on both earbuds and connected device. ◦ Ensure earbuds are properly connected via Bluetooth. ◦ Re-pair the earbuds.
Translation not working	◦ Ensure the translation application is installed and correctly configured. ◦ Check your internet connection (online translation requires internet). ◦ Verify language settings in the app. ◦ Ensure earbuds are properly connected to the app.
Poor sound quality / Noise	◦ Ensure earbuds are clean and free of debris. ◦ Check for interference from other wireless devices. ◦ Ensure a stable Bluetooth connection (within 10m/32.8ft).
