SETUP

1. Assembling the Z-Style Piano Stand (DKS-100)

1. Unfold the Z-style stand legs. The stand is designed for convenient folding and storage.
2. Adjust the width of the stand to accommodate your DP-10 keyboard. The stand has 7 adjustable gears, suitable for keyboards from 37 to 88 keys.
3. Adjust the height of the stand to your preferred playing position (sitting or standing). The height adjustment range is 56.5cm-86.4cm (22.2"-34").
4. Ensure the stand is stable and all locking mechanisms are secure before placing the keyboard on it. The thickened

iron pipe design provides strong stability and ample legroom.

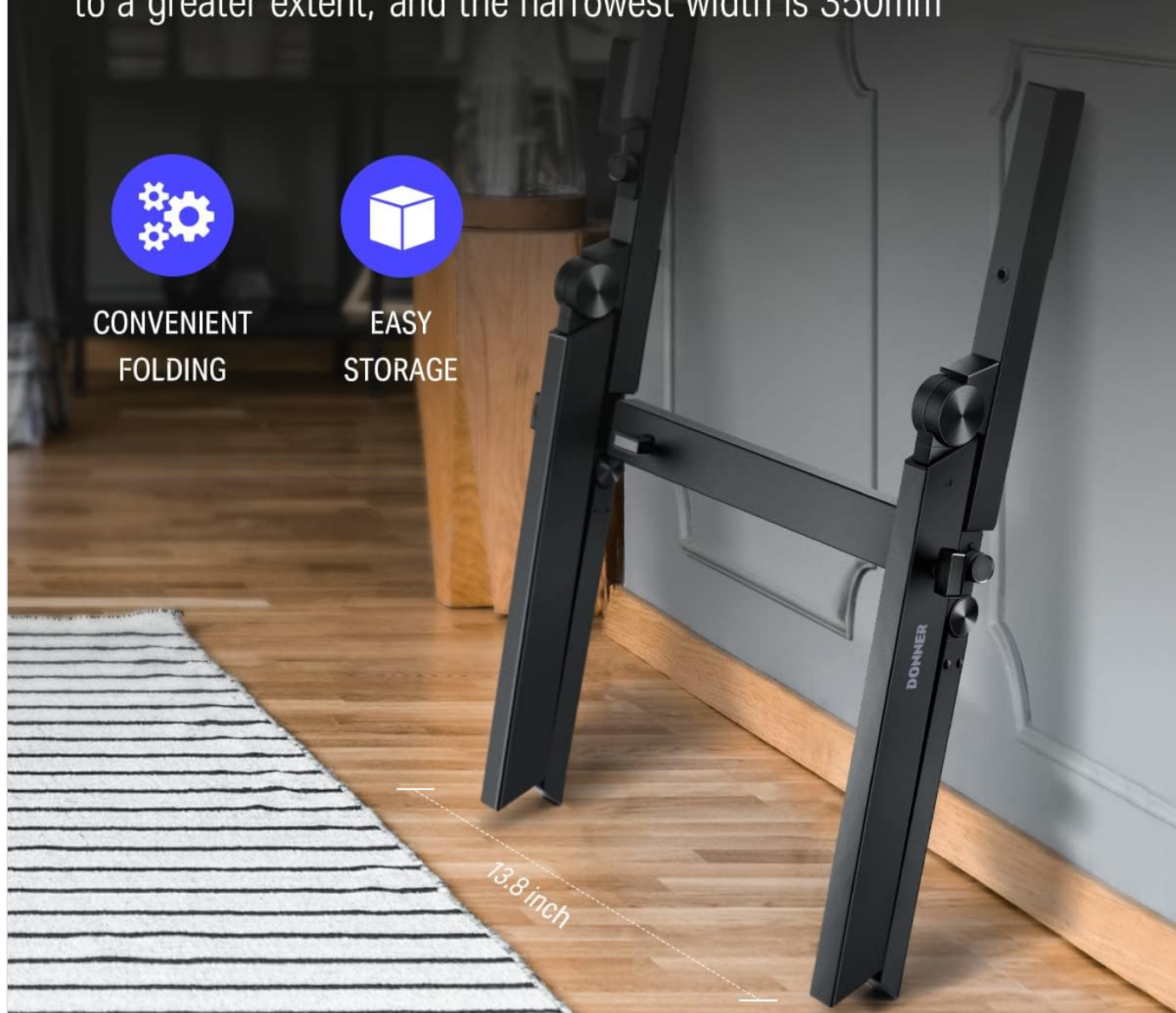


Image: The Z-style piano stand demonstrating its integrated folding design, highlighting its convenience for storage and portability. The narrowest width when folded is 350mm.

The iron pipe with thickened diameter is not easy to deform and damage. When the use is strong, there will be no shaking, and there is more room for leg extension



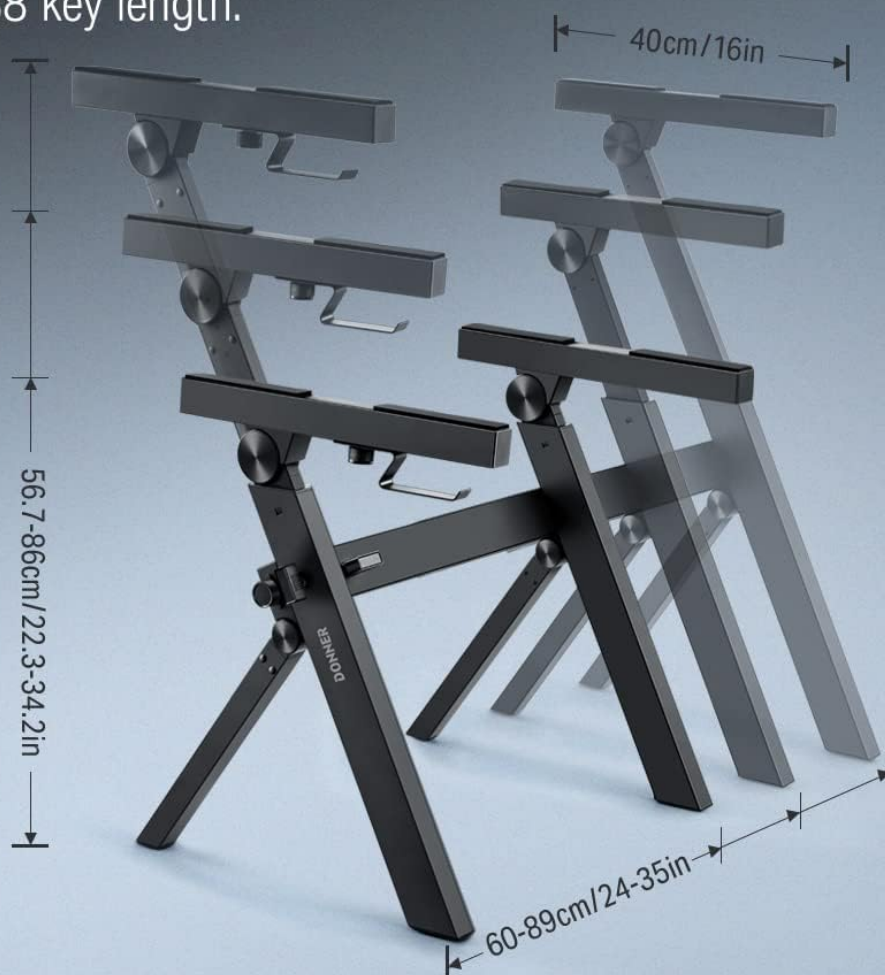

2. Setting up the DP-10 Keyboard

1. Unfold the DP-10 keyboard. It features an ultra-portable folding design.
2. Place the unfolded keyboard securely on the assembled Z-style stand.
3. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port on the keyboard and plug it into a power outlet.

4. Connect the sustain pedal to the designated pedal input.
5. Attach the music rest to the top of the keyboard if desired.

Powering On and Off

- Press the Power button to turn the keyboard on.
- Press and hold the Power button to turn the keyboard off.
- The DP-10 features an ultra-long battery life of up to 10 hours on a full charge. Charging time is approximately 4 hours. For the first use, charge for more than 6 hours.

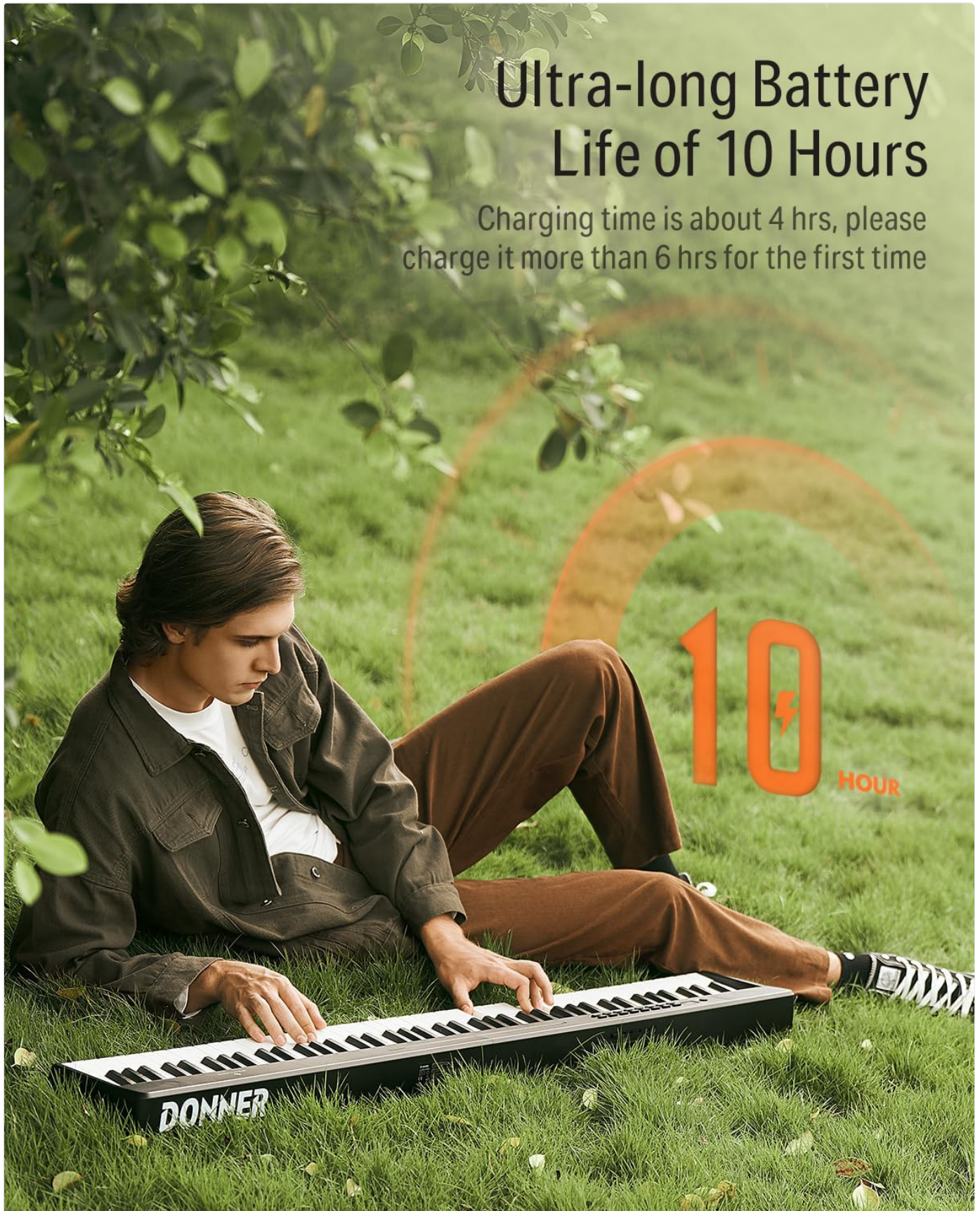

Basic Functions

- **Tones:** The DP-10 has 128 different tones. Refer to the included quick start guide or the keyboard's display for selecting specific tones.
- **Rhythms:** Explore 128 built-in rhythms to accompany your playing.
- **Demo Songs:** Enjoy 21 pre-loaded demo songs.
- **Metronome:** Use the metronome function for timing practice.
- **Auto-Chord:** Engage auto-chord for simplified accompaniment.
- **Split:** Divide the keyboard into two sections for different tones.
- **Record:** Record your performances directly on the keyboard.
- **Transpose:** Change the key of the keyboard.
- **Drum Kit:** Access various drum sounds.

Connectivity

- **Wireless Connection (Bluetooth):** The DP-10 supports wireless Bluetooth connection. This allows you to connect to mobile phones or iPads for learning apps or music editing software.
- **USB-MIDI Connection (Type-C):** Use the USB Type-C port to connect the keyboard to a computer or other MIDI devices. This enables the DP-10 to function as a MIDI controller for music production and editing software.

MAINTENANCE

- Clean the keyboard and stand with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid exposing the instrument to extreme temperatures or humidity.

- When not in use, store the keyboard in its carrying bag to protect it from dust and damage.
- Regularly check all connections and cables for wear and tear.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from the keyboard.	Volume too low; headphones connected; power issue.	Increase volume; disconnect headphones; ensure power adapter is connected and unit is charged.
Keyboard not connecting via Bluetooth/USB-MIDI.	Bluetooth not enabled; incorrect cable; driver issue (for USB-MIDI).	Ensure Bluetooth is on and paired; use correct Type-C USB cable; check computer's device manager for drivers.
Keys not responding or inconsistent touch.	Dust or debris under keys; internal issue.	Gently clean around keys; if problem persists, contact customer support.
Stand is wobbly.	Legs not fully extended or locked; uneven surface.	Ensure all stand adjustments are locked; place on a flat, stable surface.


