RIKTIG Curtain Hook with Clip (24 Pack)

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the RIKTIG Curtain Hook with Clip. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your curtain hooks. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure curtain rods or wires are securely installed and can support the weight of your curtains and hooks.

- 24 x RIKTIG Curtain Hooks with Clips

SETUP

Follow these steps to properly set up your RIKTIG curtain hooks:

1. **Prepare your curtain:** Lay your curtain flat. Determine the desired spacing for the hooks along the top edge of the curtain.
2. **Attach the clip to the curtain:** Gently press the top ends of the clip together to open the jaws. Position the clip over the top edge of your curtain fabric, ensuring a secure grip. Release the clip to hold the fabric firmly. Repeat this for all desired hook positions.
3. **Hang the hook:** Once the clips are attached to the curtain, place the open end of the S-shaped hook over your curtain wire or rod. Ensure the hook is fully seated on the wire/rod for stability.

OPERATING

The RIKTIG curtain hooks are designed for simple operation:

- To adjust the curtain's position, simply slide the hooks along the curtain wire or rod.
- To remove or re-position a hook on the curtain, gently press the clip open, adjust the fabric, and release.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your curtain hooks:

- Wipe clean with a soft, damp cloth as needed.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these may damage the finish.

- Ensure hooks are dry after cleaning to prevent water spots.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Curtain slips from clip	Clip not fully closed or fabric too thick/slippery.	Ensure the clip is firmly closed on the fabric. Try gripping a different part of the fabric or folding it slightly to provide more material for the clip to hold.
Hook does not slide smoothly	Curtain wire/rod is dirty or uneven.	Clean the curtain wire or rod. Ensure the wire/rod is level and free of obstructions.
