## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Generic PLATSA Wardrobe. Please read this manual thoroughly before proceeding with assembly or use to ensure safe and correct handling of the product.

## 2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the PLATSA wardrobe requires careful attention to detail. It is recommended that two people assemble this unit. Ensure all components are present before beginning.

### 2.1 Unpacking and Inventory

- Carefully unpack all boxes and lay out components on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Refer to the included assembly diagram (not provided in this manual) to verify all parts and hardware are accounted for.
- Dispose of packaging materials responsibly.

### 2.2 Assembly Steps (General Guidelines)

2. Attach back panels to stabilize the structure.
3. Install shelves, hanging rails, and drawer runners as indicated in the assembly guide.
4. Assemble drawers and insert them into their designated slots.
5. Attach doors, ensuring they are properly aligned and operate smoothly.
6. **Important:** Secure the wardrobe to a wall using the provided anti-tip hardware to prevent tipping accidents. This is a critical safety step.

### 3. OPERATION

The PLATSA wardrobe is designed for flexible and efficient storage. Its modular nature allows for various configurations.

#### 3.1 Using Doors and Drawers

- Open and close doors gently to prevent wear on hinges.
- Pull drawers out smoothly using the handles. Avoid overloading drawers to ensure longevity of the runners.

#### 3.2 Adjusting Storage

The internal components, such as shelves and hanging rails, can be adjusted or rearranged to suit your storage needs. To adjust shelves, carefully remove them and reposition them into desired slots. Ensure shelves are securely seated before placing items on them.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

- Ensure the wardrobe remains securely anchored to the wall.
- Avoid placing excessively heavy items on shelves or in drawers to prevent structural damage.

<b>Problem</b>	<b>Possible Cause</b>	<b>Solution</b>
Doors do not close properly or are misaligned.	Loose hinges; uneven floor; incorrect assembly.	Tighten hinge screws. Adjust hinge settings if applicable. Ensure the wardrobe is on a level surface. Recheck assembly steps for door installation.
Drawers stick or are difficult to open/close.	Overloaded drawer; debris in runners; misaligned runners.	Reduce drawer contents. Clean drawer runners. Realign drawer runners according to assembly instructions.
Wardrobe feels unstable or wobbly.	Not properly secured to the wall; loose connections; uneven floor.	Ensure the anti-tip hardware is correctly installed and secured to a wall stud. Tighten all assembly screws. Use shims under the wardrobe if the floor is uneven.
